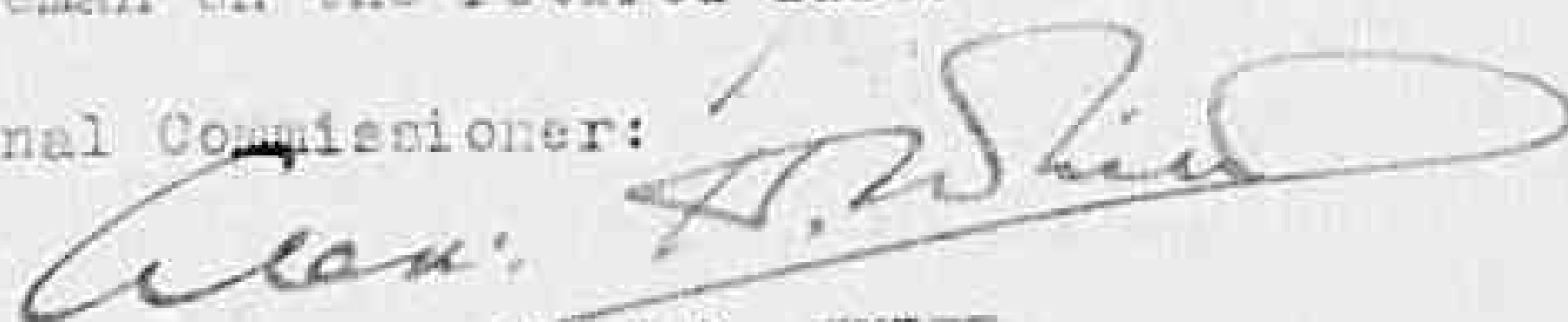

✓ 2. CIOFFI, who is 64 years of age, with 37 years service, is a man who is looked upon as an undesirable in the service for the following reasons:-

- (a) He was a member of the Fascist Party from 1919 onwards.
- (b) He is considered to have received advancement in the service unjustifiably as the result of his membership with the party.
- (c) He is not considered impartial in his administration, showing favoritism in his decisions.
- (d) He creates discord and antagonizes his official contacts at the Prefettura and in those communes to which he has been sent to act as a Commissioner. In one instance, in the Commune of FRASSO TELESINO he had to be recalled as he created more discord than existed before he arrived. ✓

3. He served at Benevento from 1929 to 1932, and from March this year to date.

4. His transfer would be welcomed.

1. I would refer you to your Ministry's letter of the 5th April, No. 5/30106 and particularly to the above case referred to therein.
2. It will be recalled that various transfers were agreed between us but that it was not possible to approve the suggested move of Dott. BOCCINO.
3. It has since been reported to us that Dott. BOCCINO feels this refusal by Allied Control Commission may have been taken as an objection to him personally and that his career may be prejudiced as a result.
4. In fairness to him I therefore wish to make it clear that the decision was taken in the best interests of Administration and was not on account of anything being known against him personally or his professional qualifications.

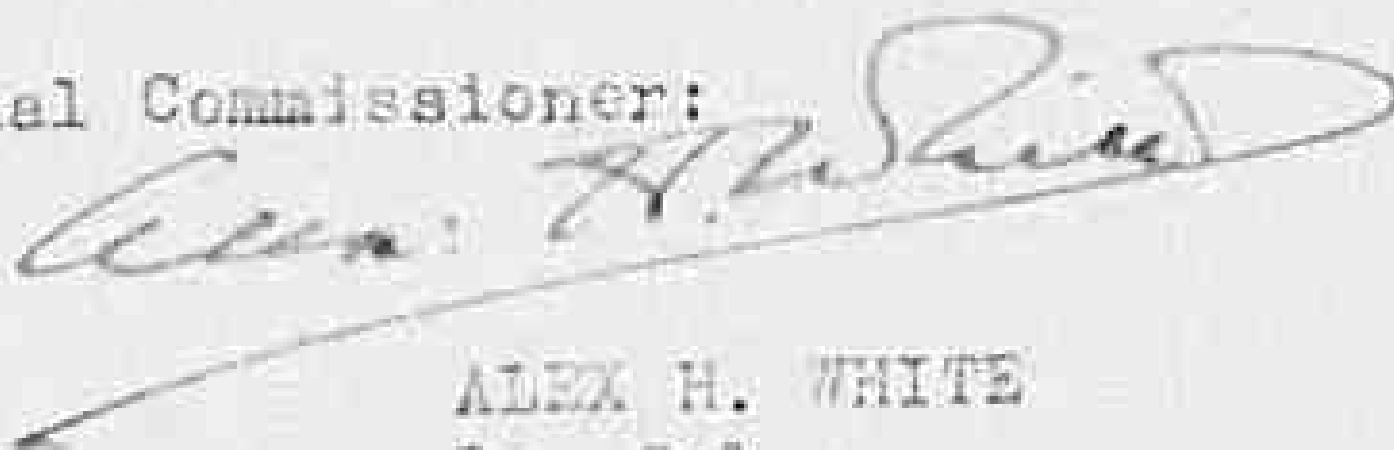

TO : Headquarters Region 3, ACC. P9

1. On 23 April 1944, I reported (Ref No OL/82/BF) upon proposed transfers of Italian Officials of Prefettura as contained in a letter from the Ministry of the Interior dated 5 April 44 to the A.C.C. P5

2. I opposed the transfer of Dr. BOCCHINI Ciriaco, 1^o Segretario (Gruppo A - Grado 9^o) of the Prefecture of Rome to Benevento on the grounds that he was the nephew of the late General BOCCHINI, Chief of Police under Mussolini, who was a native of this Province.

3. Dott. BOCCHINI has called to see me and explained that, since his transfer to Benevento was refused by ACC without stating any grounds, he feels that his career may be prejudiced thereby as his superiors may take the view that, on personal grounds, his transfer was unacceptable to the A.C.C.

4. As I explained in my report of the 23 April I had no reason to object to Dr. BOCCHINI other than on the grounds stated.

5. In the circumstance, in order that any misunderstanding which may have arisen in this matter may be cleared up, it may be considered desirable to inform the Ministry of the Interior that objection to the transfer of Dott. BOCCHINI was in the interests of the service and not on account of anything being known against him.

SUBJECT: Transfer of Prefectural Officials.

TO : Headquarters, Region 3, ACC.

1. With reference to your letter, No. GP/MR/jjf of 19 April, and enclosure, I have discussed the proposed transfers with the Prefect as directed.

2. There is no objection to any of the proposed transfers affecting this Province with the exception of the transfer of Dr. BOCCHINO Ciriaco, 1° Segretario (Gruppo A, Grado 9°) formerly of the Prefettura of Rome, to the Prefettura of Benevento.

3. Dr. BOCCHINO is a nephew of the late General Bocchino, Chief of Italian Police, and his father lives at San Giorgio Del Sannio, Benevento Province. He, Dr. Bocchino's father, was at one time Podesta of the Communes of San Giorgio del Sannio, San Nazaro, and San Martino, but was removed from office on account of his dictatorial manner. He was unpopular.

4. In my opinion it is neither in the interests of Dr. BOCCHINO, nor of the public service, to transfer him to the Prefettura at Benevento, on account of his relationship with the late General Bocchino, and his presence here would be unacceptable to the majority of the people of the Province, would indeed be looked upon with suspicion. With these views the Prefect concurs.

5. I desire to make it clear that these opinions are not in any way intended to reflect upon the character of Dr. BOCCHINO who is unknown to me.

6. Perhaps Dr. ROSSI Giuseppe, Vice-Secretary, who it is proposed to transfer to Avellino from Benevento, could be allowed to remain here, and Dr. BOCCHINO transferred to Avellino instead.

The Prefect approves of this suggestion.

TO :- Headquarters Region 3, ACC.

1. With reference to your letter, No. CP/MN/jjf of 19 April, and enclosure, I have discussed the proposed transfers with the Prefect as directed.

2. There is no objection to any of the proposed transfers affecting this Province with the exception of the transfer of Dr. BOCCHINO Ciriaco, 1° Segretario (Gruppo A, Grado 9°) formerly of the Prefettura of Rome, to the Prefettura of Benevento.

3. Dr. BOCCHINO is a nephew of the late General Bocchino, Chief of Italian Police, and his father lives at San Giorgio del Sannio, Benevento Province. He, Dr. Bocchino's father, was at one time Podestà of the Communes of San Giorgio del Sannio, San Nazaro, and San Martino, but was removed from office on account of his dictatorial manner. He was unpopular.

4. In my opinion it is neither in the interests of Dr. BOCCHINO, nor of the Public service, to transfer him to the Prefettura at Benevento, on account of his relationship with the late General Bocchino, and his presence here would be unacceptable to the majority of the people of the Province, - would indeed be looked upon with suspicion. With these views the Prefect concurs.

5. I desire to make it clear that these opinions are not in any way intended to reflect upon the character of Dr. BOCCHINO who is unknown to me.

6. Perhaps Dr. Rossi Giuseppe, Vice-Secretary, 5882 who it is proposed to transfer to Avellino from Benevento, could be allowed to remain here, and Dr. BOCCHINO transferred to Avellino instead.

The Prefect approves of this suggestion.
