Subject: Mr. Vincenzo Panaro, living in Bari - Via Melo 144, claims for the intervention of the A.C.C in order to obtain the re-admission in his former job (he was employed at the Municipality of Bari) , from which he was dismissed during his absence, although the said absence was due to military service.

At the date of the Armistice he was Officer of the Italian Army in Anzio. He deserted his post in order to join the Italian partisans with whom he collaborated until Florence was taken by the Allied Forces. After 12 months of a wandering life, returning to his country and wishing to put himself again at work he was unpleasantly astonished to hear that he had been dismissed since September 1944.

1. Thank you for your letter of the 2nd July enclosing a list of proposed appointments and transfers of Professors which it is understood is submitted to the Allied Control Commission for their approval in accordance with the arrangements made between us for that purpose.
2. It is observed that the list accompanying your letter varies slightly from the list Excellency Merrill handed to Lieutenant Kevin on the 21st July. These differences have been noted. Kindly notify us of the Council's views regarding possible in due course.
3. With regard to Dr. Verbi, it will be recalled that he was removed from office on account of his "having indecent and seditious conduct behaviour". I would like to refer Your Excellency to the letter of the then Minister of Internal Affairs of May, a copy of which I am enclosing, from which I clearly understand that no intention of suspending Dr. Verbi.
4. Your Excellency may wish to re-examine the position in the light of the circumstances of the case involving the previous appointment and I would advise that we do so in order to reach a conclusion on the qualifications for Dr. Verbi and if so the reasons for so doing.
5. In view of what I said above, the positions are being examined by the Allied Control Commission and I have to convey to Your Excellency to you to enable these appointments to be filled as soon as possible.

1. Reference is made to letter (ACC/42/32/Int) dated 2 May 1944 from the Director of the Interior Sub-Commission, Rear Headquarters, A.C.C.

2. So far, it has been impossible to contact Dr. CRAVERI, son-in-law of Benedetto CROCE. However, I am told on good authority (by someone who knows the whole family very well) that Dr. CRAVERI is somewhat loth to impart any information. I am, however, endeavoring to contact him through an intermediary and thus allay any suspicions he might have if approached directly.

3. Meanwhile, I have discussed the LI VOTI case with Major ROBBITSON of P.M.B., who was for a considerable period in Bari. He confirms his extremely anti-Allied attitude. He showed me some notes he had made on various dates (November - January, approximately), the sum total of which indicates:-

a. Interference and intervention by LI VOTI when German Consul was about to be arrested in Bari,

b. Maintenance of Fascist elements within his own office,- for example, DI SALVIA, Questore,

c. Discussion at one time with the Giunta Executiva in which he inveighed against the British,

d. Non-cooperation at the time of the Bari Congress,

e. Non-cooperation at a time when pro-Fascist speeches were being made by elements in the Bari area,

f. General unpopularity with local population,

g. Discrimination against refugees.

4. Major ROBBITSON gave me to understand that a very full report would be obtainable from Captain PERKINS, Commanding Officer, 315 F.S.S.

Referred to grave shortage of qualified personnel and repeated Italian Government's desire not to appoint an official associated with any particular political party and their policy of appointing only career officials.

Minister suggested a Vice Prefect should be promoted and said he would submit his proposal. Lt Col Spicer hoped that he would not submit name of Vice prefect of Bari, Bellisario or Micholy, neither of whom would be acceptable.

Minister said Li Voti will be removed but owing to shortage of officials, asked if Li Voti could be employed elsewhere in the Administration - not as a prefect.

Lt Col Spicer indicated first requirement was to remove Li Voti. Whilst he sympathizes with Aldisio's difficulty, he would have to submit proposed fresh employment to Chief Commissioner.

Minister then said that he had in mind to appoint Lucifero, present Prefect of Catanzaro. He would formally submit proposal.

2. Royal Decree

Lt Col Spicer asked if this was proceeding and when it would be published.

Minister said he had no chance to discuss matter with Reale, but understood it had been approved. Promised to ascertain position.

I shall be greatly obliged therefore if Your Excellency would regard the investigation of this case as one of urgency and will keep me informed of the action which Your Excellency takes in this matter.

I have also to inform Your Excellency that neither of the Vice Prefects Signor Bellissario nor Comm. Lot. Giuseppe Nicholy will be acceptable as Prefect.

1. In accordance with your request of 16 Mar (Refs: ACC/42/17/Int and ACC/42/3/Int), I am sending to you attached the information obtained regarding the Prefects of Brindisi and Bari. I understand that the Prefect of Brindisi has been transferred to Catanzaro, and from the report of Major Somerville, it would appear that he is about as good as we could expect.
2. The report on the Prefect of Bari, however, is such that I would like to record my objection to his continuing as Prefect anywhere, let alone being transferred to another post in this Region, or left in such an important place as Bari.
3. I regret the time which has passed, but I think that you will see from the nature of the information collected by Col. Vining that it required some careful digging to gather the facts.

As far as it is possible to obtain the biographical sketch of the prefect, Bari, it is as follows:

The prefect's name is LI VOTI and not MICHOLI as mentioned in your letter A/35/40 of 19 March '44. LI VOTI started his political career in 1921 as Vice Prefetto at Gallipoli where he functioned under the care of the famous leader of the Fascist Party, one Starace, whose birthplace is Gallipoli.

In July 1943 when the Mussolini regime fell, LI VOTI was the prefect at ASTI and retained his appointment owing to his friendship with Marshal Giudoglio whose birthplace is ASTI.

In July 1943 LI VOTI came to Bari as prefect.

There is evidence to show that LI VOTI was definitely anti Allies, and he showed it in different ways, as for instance on the 8th September (Armistice Day) four Italians, risking reprisals by the Germans, approached LI VOTI. These four Italians (civilians) were Altomare Marullo, Loffriore Girolamo, Sonnella Eugenio and Cifarelli Michele, and they requested LI VOTI to incite to them in what way they could organize the army and civilians to act contrary to German interests.

Along with the prefect LI VOTI, was a Colonel Giarovazzo of the Garubinieri, who was the individual responsible for the massacre of 16000 Ethiopians following an attempt on the life of Graziani at Addis Ababa.

The Prefect Livoti & Colonel Giacovazzo (so the report states) which is from a reliable source), laughed at the request made by the four Italians, and remarked that they were fools if they thought it was of any use resisting the Germans who were the only people capable of winning the war, and the four Italians were sent out of the room.

Livoti is a Sicilian & therefore a record of his past is not easily obtainable here, but there is a Doctor Gravari, who is at present in Naples, and he is in a position to give information about this prefect.

Dr. Gravari is the son-in-law of Benedetto Grose, who is a well known leader in Naples.

The Vice prefect, Bardi, is a Sig. Bellissario who is a very ardent Fascist & Squadrrist and acts as an advisor to Livoti.

Sig. Bellissario is also reported to be acting as liaison between Livoti and a Sig. L. DiAddario, Federale, who was Mayor of Bari town until August 1943.

In the Gazzetta del Mezzogiorno of July 1943, sig. D'Addario published an article advocating strong resistance to the Allied Forces, he was subsequently arrested at Trani, but after a few days was released.

It is reported that he is in hiding in Bari and through Sig. Bellisario, gives directives to Livoti.

The Questore Disselvie is involved with these people and I am sending in a separate report about him as I am satisfied he is by no means pro the Allied interests.

Now as regards my own experience of the prefect Livoti, I am convinced that he is not working in the interests of the Allied and is not co-operative.

He has always shown me the greatest respect and shown willingness to do all that is asked of him, and yet I have had reports from Allied Military Officials which endorses the opinion I have formed of him, that Livoti is not in sympathy with Allied interests and I strongly urge that he be removed from his office here as Prefect of Bari. I am quite satisfied in my own mind that he is working contra to our own interests and has therefore a bad influence over other officials, and his administration is not efficient.
