1. Ref. your ACC/4/1/29/Int of 5 May, Granato Francesco was removed from the post of Sindaco of Miglierina on 12 July, and Ciccio Giacomo appointed Commissario Prefettizio in his stead. Dott. Ciccio is a vice-secretary in the Catanzaro Prefettura.

2. Action was taken by the Prefect; but his enquiries and those of the Public Safety Officer did not confirm another complaint that a large sum of money was missing from the comunal funds.

3. Liperati Bruno, who was suggested by the writer, as suitable for taking Granato's place, is a young man of 26 who was appointed Secretary of the comune in Sept. '43. Various allegations have been made against him, and although none of them has been substantiated, he is not too highly thought of and I agree with the Prefect in the choice of Dr. Ciccio.
