1. Please see # 31A + 31. Draft reply dealing with Lt. Col. Martini's suggestion is at # 32 for your consideration.
2. You will observe I have not dealt in my letter with Lt. Col. Barham - Carter's second + third paras. - see # 31.
3. It is not clear what the phrase "certain intentions regarding 'Littoria' means: but I think it refers to the idea, mooted in June or July, that Littoria + Frosinone should be joined to Rome province, of which they at one time formed part.
4. As to that: - (a) it is essentially a question for the Italians; (b) our view ~~stands~~, if any, should be that this is not the time to go in for elaborate alterations of local govt. (c) we should therefore do nothing to borderlines raise the question with the Govt.
- (d) in any case, it would be putting the cart before the horse to raise this boundary question merely for the sake of eliminating PISCOPO.
5. As to PISCOPO, Lt.-Col. Barham-Carter merely says he is "not strong enough". Most Prefects aren't. This is Ital. Govt. Territory. It would require a much stronger case - Fascism or anti-Ally behaviour - to justify this S/C in approaching the Govt. for his removal.
6. As I do not recommend taking up the basic suggestion, made in Lt.-Col. Martini's letter at # 31A, it is not necessary to deal with the consequential points in Lt.-Col. Barham-Carter's letter. *Agreed*

SUBJECT: Prefect of Litteria

TO : RO, Iloilo-Ubrian Region

1. It has been agreed with the Italian Government that the present Prefect of this Province, Gen. Ernesto FERRARIO, should be relieved of his office and that Dr. Giuseppe CIRACIO should be appointed Prefect in his stead.
2. It will be remembered that Gen. FERRARIO is in fact a Judge by profession, and he was nominated by the last Minister of Interior to be Prefect Regent at a time when there were hardly any career Prefects available. He has not been altogether happy in this office. Moreover, the Minister of Justice has made a request for his services to be made available to the Judiciary again.
3. I enclose a copy of my record card as to Dr. CIRACIO, from which you will see that he was formerly Vice Prefect at Catania. He has just been promoted to the rank of Prefect by the Italian Government.
4. This change has been mentioned over the telephone (Captain Lewis—Lt. Col. Arnold) to the RO.

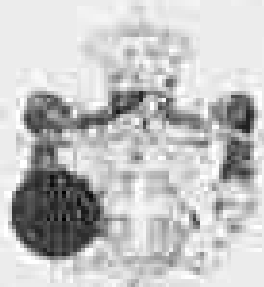

1. I regard my present task as one chiefly of preparing to leave Littoria in competent hands on the departure of A.C.C. from the province. With Italy practically ruined, morally as well as physically, Government will have a tremendous task to win the confidence of the people. Not only will the chief Italian provincial officials have to suffer from their own shortcomings; they will also be blamed for lack of food and other things for which they are not really to blame. The Prefetto Reggente here is already disliked by the people, not especially for real weaknesses, but because he is blamed for lack of olive oil, salt, pasta, meat, soap, and other things for which he has little if any responsibility.

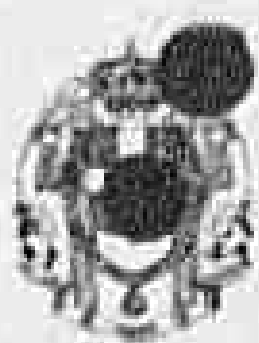

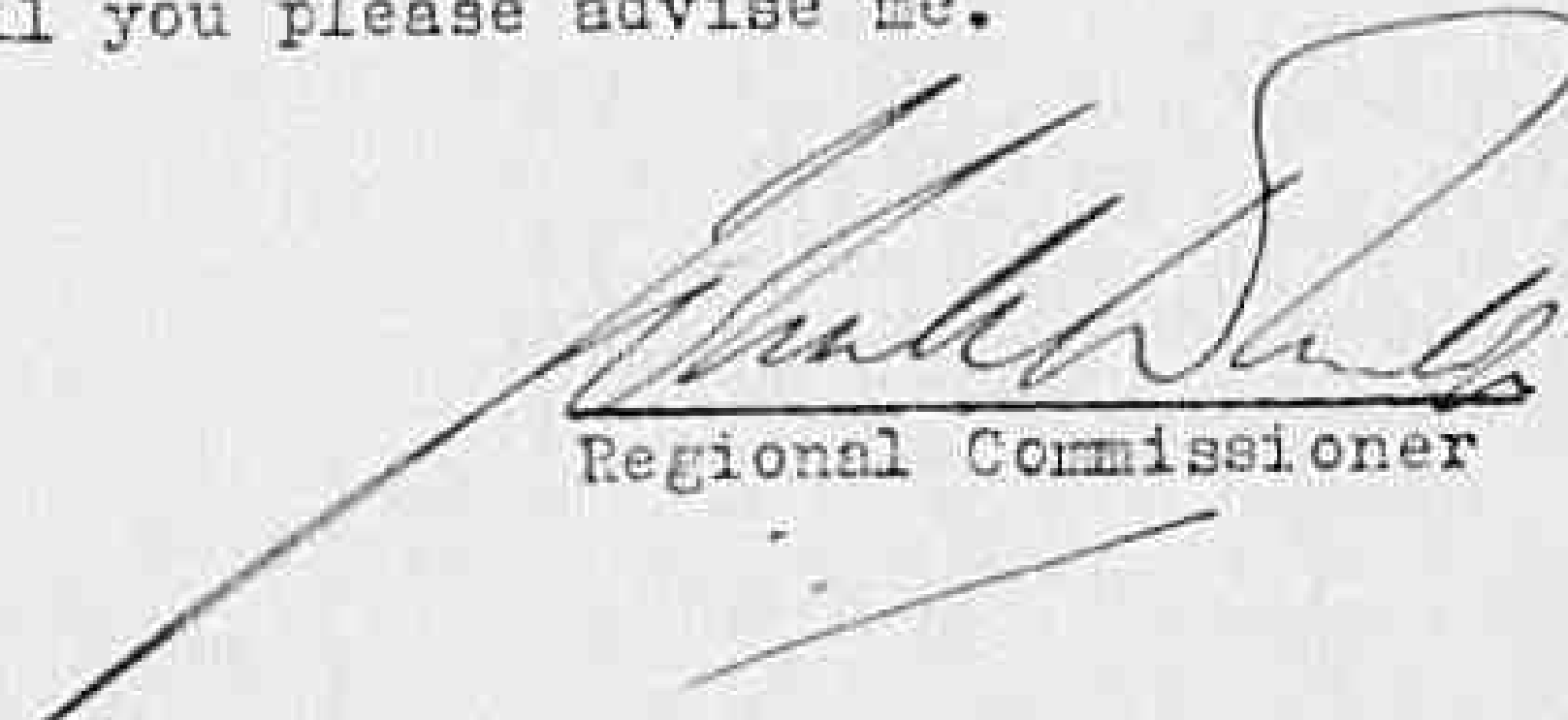

(Now serving in the Ispettorato Agrario di Salerno)

TO : Colonel R. G. B. Spicer, Director.

1. Arrangements were made by Captain Williams of Interior Sub-Commission through Captain Cerulli to have Dott. Colangelo meet Captain Williams in the lobby of the Palace of Justice, Salerno at 1345 hours on Sunday, June 4, 1944, in order that Colangelo be taken by courier to Naples.

Further arrangements had been made to have Dott. Colangelo leave Naples with two other Italian Officials (and accompanied by Captain Williams) for Littoria.

2. Dott. Colangelo failed to make an appearance at the appointed place and time in Salerno.

3. Captain Williams and Captain Temple, Interior Sub-Commission, made every possible effort to locate Dott. Colangelo by telephoning the Italian Government and by personally going to the Carabinieri, whose assistance was enlisted. There were no officials present at any of the Ministries - including the Ministry of Finance and the Ministry of Interior. The Carabinieri, although given Dott. Colangelo's firearms Permit Number, were unable to ascertain his address, records being in a confused state.

4. Courier transport was directed to leave at 2:30 PM, but the automobile placed at the disposal of Interior Sub-Commission was kept waiting until 5:30 PM, at which time Captain Williams left for Naples, in order to carry out the rest of his mission.

5. Captain Temple telephoned Captain Cerulli Monday morning and informed him of the non-appearance of Dott. Colangelo.

6. Lt Grotinelli thereafter telephoned at 9:45 Monday morning and transmitted the following information which he had received from Captain Cerulli:-

He had been informed that Dott. Colangelo was ill and consequently unable to keep his appointment with Captain Williams. The Minister of Interior received the news of Colangelo's illness late yesterday afternoon, and did not have time to communicate with us. Lt. Grotinelli said that the Minister would make inquiries as to how long Dott. Colangelo would be ill, and if it were for a long period of time, he would attempt to get another official for the job earmarked for Dott. Colangelo.

Captain Temple told Lt. Grotinelli that he would report this information to Colonel Spicer.

SUBJECT: Italian Officials.

TO : HQ, ACC, Interior Sub-Commission.

1. It is anticipated that in a few days the Provincial Capital of Littoria will be occupied and it will then be necessary to reorganise the Italian Provincial administration.

2. It is not yet known what will be the condition of the Provincial administration or how many of the present senior officials will be available or suitable to continue in office.

3. It is therefore requested that enquiries be now made of the Italian Government to find out whether they have any officials available for appointment to the position of Prefect and other senior positions in case they are required.

4. You will be notified as soon as possible of the condition of the Provincial administration and of the exact requirements of officials who cannot be located in the area.

In the meantime it is desirable that the Italian Government should have one or two senior officials earmarked in case they are required.
