SUBJECT: Note of Interview - HQ Lazio-Umbria Region.

DATE : 26 January 1945

PARTIES: Lt. Col. Ames, Acting Regional Commissioner, Lazio-Umbria Region
Lt. Col. Bonham-Carter, Executive Officer " "
Major R. R. Temple, Chief Executive Officer, Local Government S/C.

1. Pursuant to directions of the VP, I paid an official call at the Regional HQ, Lazio-Umbria Region, and spoke with Lt. Col. Ames and Lt. Col. Bonham-Carter. They informed me that generally the situation so far as local government was concerned in their region was pretty good; that the prefects are all working out very well.

2. I mentioned to them the fact that the Decree dealing with the reorganization of Rome Comune had just been published and that I was sending them a copy of the English translation.

3. I left a copy of the translation of a letter appearing in the Civil Censorship papers sent to us, containing accusations of a lawyer against ZANFRANUNDO, Prefect. Lt. Col. Bonham-Carter said he would send it on to the Provincial Commissioner of Province for his observations.

4. They mentioned that the Prefect of Rome was still somewhat slow in the formation of Giunta Comunale and that they were trying to ginger him up a bit.

5. At Perugia, they were having some trouble with the Sindaco, but they hoped to have the situation ironed out soon. They have a new Provincial Commissioner there, a Lt. Col. Ramsey, (American) whom they regard very highly. They were hopeful that Lt. Col. Ramsey would straighten out the affairs in the province. They mentioned that after Col. Belser, the former AC, had received instructions to disband the Advisory Council on which all the Sindaci were appointed, he thereupon made all the Sindaci welfare officials and continued to have them paid.

6. Lt. Col. Ames stated that pursuant to a formal request from the Allied Commission, he had sent in a letter several weeks ago expressing his opinion as favoring local elections. Both he and Lt. Col. Bonham-Carter did not think there would be much trouble from the Public Safety angle.

7. They stated finally that there were no other matters they could think of to bring to my attention now, and thanked me very much for paying a call on them. I in turn thanked them for the opportunity of visiting them and assured them of our continued cooperation.

Request of Removal of the "Prefetto" of
Provincia and other officials accused
of Nazi-fascism

Prefect ZAMPARINDO, who, according to him, enjoys the unlimited trust and protection of the Allied Government, in the days of fascism and precisely in Aug. 1942, "in view of his high merit and spotless conduct was appointed Prefect of Reggio" after the 8th September... helped the Germans in the march for forced labour, with proclamations and threats, by urging the Sicilian population to cooperate with the "Byal ally" Germany, and singing praise to her fortunes. "The Ministry of the Interior recently appointed Dr. Angelo Mario CERCHIERI, from Matera and an official by career as general secretary to the provincial administration. This official, who should have taken the place of Comm. DE BLASIO assigned to Avelino, was unable to take over the office because first the former President and then Avv. MARZI resisted him "with the consent of the funny old ("pulcirella" - clown) Prefect."

"This is explained by the fact that Prefect LAMPARINDO, no longer under the guidance of his vice prefect CERCHIERI, recently transferred to Cagliari, threw himself body and soul into the arms of the Committee of National Liberation, the president of which is the ex-Sinnaco, avv. MARZI, today President of the Provincial Administration, and the vice President Eng. Giovanni CARASSI.

The Allied authorities cannot have overlooked ZAMPARINDO, whose removal from Piuggi is a matter of public order in the interests of the whole province.

The prefect's Head of Cabinet is Valfredo ZAFARINA "who considers the patriotism of the anti-fascists of Cagliari a crime."

Rag. Clino DE BELLIS declared ... "together with the Prefecture Councillor, Dr. Raffaele SGONNAMIGLI, working at present in the Prefecture of Littoria, with the head of the province, ROCCHI, and with the Secretary of the Republican Fascio, Dr. Sergio PEPOLI, the acts of confessed hostility W the reconstructive measures of the Republican government organized & assisted ROCCHI for having explicitly stated several times in public that he was waiting for the enemy liberators."

Rag. Clino DE BELLIS helped "by taking advantage of the imprisonment of Cav. STROCCHI, chief accountant of the Prefecture, and of ROCCHI, head of the Prefecture, to waste the Government money, without any restriction or control, in paying large sums of money from the funds of the Prefecture upon a few apparent orders written or otherwise, thus helping the political and military operations of the Nazi-fascists to whom he offered his devoted services, which he denies, for the purpose of delaying and hindering the allied victory..."

"He took the oath of loyalty to the pseudo-Fascist Republican Government."

"...In our opinion, DE BELLIS is guilty of the crime of helping the enemy, contemplated in art. 51 of the M.P.C. of war."

"In conclusion, in the Prefecture of Pluggi, there are authorities such as ZANFRANINDO, ZAFARINA, the TARTAGLINT, the DE HELLIS, who revindicate their services to the Germans during the occupation as if acts of heroism. These persons are hindering epuration and democracy in the country in every way and are frantically endeavoring to keep or replace the surest friends of fascism in the positions of command.

"Prefect ZANFRANINDO still has the greatest affection for the old fascist methods and under a mask of democracy, sabotages any initiative on the part of the government or the people aimed at reconstruction or bringing democracy to the country.

Having recently surrounded himself with such dishonest and uncompromising villains as the provincial inspector LEONE acting as Vice Prefect Vicar, and Reg. FRANCO, both sent away from the capital as undesirable elements and placed by him in the commanding and controlling positions, he endeavored in every way to repress all acts and manifestations against him or his dictatorial methods. His presence in Piuggi causes continual ill feeling and discontent among the workers, and the recent public manifestations in the communes of Portara, Liri, Pofi and Aragni and that fermenting at Acqua Fordata, go to prove what is thought of him, of the Allied Command which takes no action, and of his protectors.

1. Reference is made to your letter dated 5 June 1944, with
inclosure ACC/4/1/35/INT of 4 June 1944, regarding Subject.

2. The following extract has been taken from our records:-

"Prefect of Avellino Province. Born 30/7/1891 at Massafra, Italy. He has had 30 years' service with the Prefettura and has been Prefect of Avellino since 15 June 1943. Prior to that time, he served in Regusa, Sicily. He was made a Fascist by decree in May 1926, but never held any office in the Party. ZANFRAMUNDO is regarded as unpopular with a majority of the citizens both because he is strict and because of his 20 day absence from 14 September to 3 October 1943. The people feel he deserted them during the trying days of the bombardment."

1. This sub-commission has been asked urgently to form, in co-operation with the Italian Government, a team of key administrative officials for Trentino province.

2. Signor Alidio, Minister of Interior personally informed us today that he recommended Signor Bartolucci, present President of Belluno as that he wished to replace him by Signor Intorti, the present President of the Deputazione Provinciale of Belluno, to be styled "Reggente di Trentum".

3. I should be very glad to have your approval for this matter.

4. The Italian Government is extremely short of trained administrative officials and would have next Signor Intorti forward himself but ~~he~~ has pleaded to be excused on the grounds that he is far from young and it would be unfair to ask him to go to such a forward area under present circumstances.

5. His excellency, Signor Alidio recommends Intorti highly.

6. The matter is urgent as the team must be formed in order to go forward to Trentino within 10 days. I should be glad, therefore, for a telephonic reply. The number of this sub-commission is 785021.



1. It is noted in extract from Radio Monitoring Report No. 100 of 9 May, 1944, Paolo De Maria has been appointed Provincial Chief of Frosinone Province by Il Duce. Undoubtedly he is an ardent Fascist and in all probability his appointment was dictated by the Germans. Obviously he will be unacceptable as Prefect when the Province is occupied.
2. It is also noted from Q/72 HQ. A.M.G. Eighth Army dated 3 January, 1944, that a pool of Italian Civil Government Officials is being formed by the present Italian Government with approval of A.M.G. 15 Army Group.
3. It is suggested that consideration be given for a suitable person to replace De Maria. In any event, the Italian Government might be in a position to suggest a competent, suitable person, possibly a previous official.
4. If a suitable person is furnished by the Italian Government it would also be desirable that he be accompanied by an official capable of acting as Chief Accountant.
