We have the honour of forwarding to Your office a further statement of Sig. Vincenzo D'AMELIO GUACCI, father of Dr. Alfonso D'AMELIO GUACCI, formerly attached to the Prefecture of Viterbo and at present interned in the concentration camp of Fudula.

We also transcribe the information furnished to the Direction General of P.S. by the Prefecture of Viterbo with letter n. 1348 of the 27th April 1945.

With reference to the above mentioned Ministerial letter we beg to inform You that Dr. D'AMELIO GUACCI Alfonso, born in S. Angelo dei LOMBARDI on the 9th June 1899, has uninterruptedly served with the Prefecture of Viterbo since May 1930 date of his admission to the career.

A veteran of the war of 1915-18 he entered the fascist party on the 22nd May 1922 and obtained the qualification of "squadrista".

After the 8th of September 1943, the Chief of the Province intrusted him with the liaison between the Province and the German Commands.

This task was by Dr. D'AMELIO enthusiastically accepted and of course he thus earned the qualification of collaborator of the Germans and generated a very hostile feeling against him in the population, especially owing to the requisitions made by the local police in favour of the German troops.

Dr. D'AMELIO, however, in displaying his activity has often interceded with the Germans in favour of numerous fellow-countrymen of his in order to avoid that the latter should suffer from requisitions or whatever damages to their houses or persons.

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We hereto attach copies of 27 declarations drawn by partisans and other people, stating that Dr. D'AMENIO has tried to mitigate the measures taken by the German Commands.

Dr. D'AMENIO though being a fascist and with pro-German feelings seems not to have given rise to any complaints for bad ways.

He has also taken his oath for the fascist republican government, though not being a member of the fascist republican party.

At the arrival of the Allies he was arrested by the M.P. and interned in the concentration camp of Padula where he actually is.

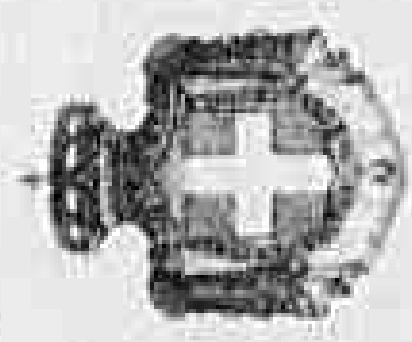

MEMORANDUM

To H.E. The Minister of the Interior
ROME

I, the undersigned, Vincenzo d'Amel o Garaci, residing at present in Civita Castellana, at N. 34 Via Roma, wish to submit the following to your Excellency:

I am the father of Dr. Alessandro Alessi, formerly holding office as Councillor at the R. Prefecture of Viterbo.

The aforesaid son of mine, having been arrested on the 14th of July last, was shortly after sent to the concentration camp of Padula (Salerno) where he is still confined notwithstanding the fact that he is perfectly innocent.

I wish to state that no serious charges or grounded accusation can be brought against my son. Indeed, considering the accuracy and zeal with which he was performing his duties, nothing can be said against him, as is shown by the high commendations received every year by his superiors and by the fact that he was holding office at Viterbo for fourteen years.

Also, as regards fascism, my son Alfonso, though a member of the Party like all the other employees, never committed anything that might justify institution of an action against him. He never held any office in the party; always refrained from any propaganda activity in favor of the party and never got any benefit either in the way of an advancement or otherwise.

Unfortunately, a few days after 8th of September 1943, he was entrusted by the Prefect appointed by Badoglio (De Dominicis) with the ungrateful task of serving as liaison officer between the Prefecture and the local German Command, a task which unfortunately was confirmed and imposed on him by the other Prefects who succeeded to De Dominicis. My son had to carry out this mission because he was compelled, and because he was aware of the necessity of being very active in order to reduce and confine to a minimum all possible consequences of the brutality and reprisals of the Germans. As a matter of fact, my son never helped the invader, but undergoing an ungrateful and extenuating work, he saw to it that requisitions and robberies would be reduced to a minimum and that, when that was impossible, the citizens would be indemnified for the damages incurred.

This was the purpose set out for himself by my son during the time when, by order received and by duty of his office, he was in contact with the Germans. Indeed, following denunciations of requisitions, of robberies and plundering by the invaders, he succeeded by his persuasive and energetic actions to obtain the issuance of orders

Also, as regards fascism, my son Alfonso, though a member of the party, never committed anything that might justify institution of an action against him. Also through the Board set up for the payment of damages and indemnifications, my son with the support of the General Attorney, of the Chief Accountant of the Prefecture, of the Veterinary and other officials, succeeded in obtaining for those persons who substantiated damages the best reasonable settlement. The following persons can testify as to this (above): a) Giannelli Alberto, owner of a cafe and residing in Piazza del Gesù; b) Cav. Rinaldo Palezzo of the Insurance Company; c) Rocco Zoppie, of the jail; d) Mag. Metallini of the Comune of Viterbo.

The activities of my son were not confined to the above, because as I learned a few months ago, he has always been in favor of the partisan movement, he helped members of this movement, as well as British prisoners roaming through the country of Viterbo province, and, as far as possible, he presented them with cigarettes, some clothing and other things. Having knowledge of meetings of patriots, of acts of sabotage and of localities where arms and ammunition were hidden, he kept the closest secrecy on what he knew; he encouraged those who were taking risks and promised assistance and protection, which as a matter of fact he efficiently gave. Besides, taking advantage of the acquaintances he had among the Germans on account of his office, he succeeded to obtain the release from jail of: 1) Ing. Beneditto Iamoni Sebastiano of Piacenza; 2) Ottavio Settalo (a German); 3) the son of Ottavio Gagli; 4) Ing. Borgognoni of Firenze; 5) Balistreri Massimo from Viterbo (for whom Mrs. Quarta of Pescara can testify as Mr. Balistreri did). All the aforementioned had been arrested by the Germans on account of political charges deemed to be very serious.

Moreover, my son, following the calling-up to arms ordered by General Preziant, advised the young men not to present themselves to the Military District and to be on the look-out and ready to go into hiding, if necessary.

Finally by means of opportune and timely advices and warnings he enabled several motorcar owner to hide their cars and so save them from requisition and delivery to the Germans.

On the strength of what I had the honor to state above, I beg to ask the valid support of Your Excellency to let justice triumph and to give to a poor anti-fascist father the peace and tranquillity lost as a result of the grave and unlimited step taken against my son.

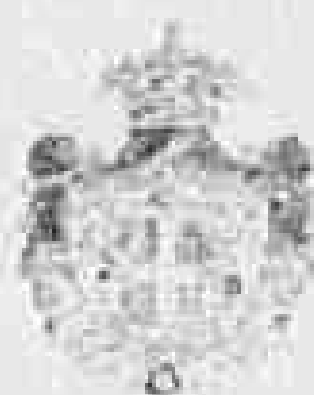

1. Following para. 3 of #77 on this file, the Director saw SPECIALE, Rosario on 29 Sept. At the end of the interview S. said he had to have a hernia operation. The Director said he could not send a sick man to Viterbo. S. then began to say he could have the operation later & so on. The Director was very dissatisfied with his attitude — see comments on Speciale's record card.
2. On the Director's instructions I saw Beronti & Camera the same morning on the whole question. The upshot was:
 - (a) I said the Director would not send SPECIALE Rosario to Viterbo in any event.
 - (b) I did not know if Col. Spicer would consider him for any other province but would consult the Director.
 - (c) SPECIALE, Girolamo was nominated for Viterbo in place of Rosario.
 - (d) Girolamo to see Col. Spicer at 1130 hours on 30 Sept.
3. The Director saw Girolamo accordingly & was not dissatisfied. On his instructions I telephoned Beronti & clinched the nomination.
4. I then telephoned Lt.-Col. Bamham-Carter (Executive Officer (Arms) Lazio Region) & arranged for Girolamo to call & see him at 1030 hours on 1 Oct. Girolamo Speciale being still in the office filling up his record form, he was instructed accordingly & to be ready to go to Viterbo on 2 Oct., if required: he agreed to that.

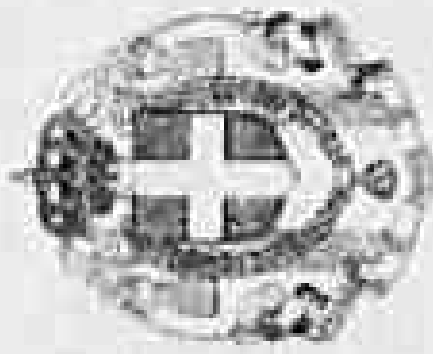

Your Excellency :

1. You will recollect the arrangement made between your Chief of Cabinet and myself that Dr. FORNI should be recalled from this province to Rome, in order to be available for BOLOGNA or some other forward province and that Dr. PASCUCCI should take his place at VITERBO. On my instructions the Ministry was requested on 26 September to put this agreement into effect and accordingly to arrange for Dr. PASCUCCI to report to Lt.- Col. Bonham-Carter at LAZIO Region H/Q as soon as possible.
2. This morning the Ministry telephoned that Dr. PASCUCCI had made representations against going to VITERBO. I understand that he has stated that he has two sons fighting with the Patriots in the BOLOGNA neighbourhood, that he is very worried about them, that this has affected his health and that consequently he does not feel able to discharge the duties of Prefect of VITERBO. The view of the Ministry is I understand that in these circumstances it would be inadvisable to send him.
3. In his place Dr. Rosario SPICER, I understand, suggested. He is accepted : and he should please report to Regional H/Q to-morrow without fail.
4. I feel it my duty to state to Your Excellency that the attitude of Dr. PASCUCCI to the call of duty in time of war leaves much to be desired. I trust that you will be able to take suitable measures with regard to him.
5. I hope moreover that he will not be proposed by the Italian Government for any post with which the Allied Control Commission is concerned. He would not be acceptable for any such appointment.

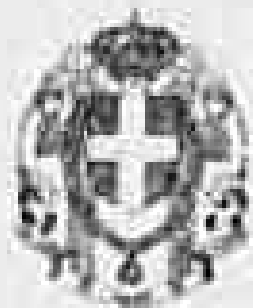

1. Comm. ZANFRANCO called to present his compliments to Colonel Spicer, who complimented him on his administration of the province and the rapidity with which he was reorganising local government. After referring to difficulties which some Prefects were having with the Commissions of Liberation, Colonel Spicer left for the Vice President's Conference at 1600 hours.
2. Captain Williams then consulted H.E. as to the proposal to transfer Dr. Raffaele BOGHAMIGLIO from Frosinone to Viterbo.
3. H.E. said that BOGHAMIGLIO had acted as Capo Gabinetto to ROCCI, who was Prefect of Frosinone under the Fascist-Republican Government; and H.E. thought his position and effectiveness in the province was compromised by that fact. He held nothing against BOGHAMIGLIO personally. The man was definitely not of fascist leanings or H.E. would have taken stronger actions than merely to have asked his transfer. He is a good and honest official and an excellent worker of whom one ought to be made - but in some other province.
4. H.E. said he made a similar application with regard to his Vice-Prefect Inspector Dott. MICLICHINI and for similar reasons.
5. Captain Williams said no proposal had been made to the Sub-Commission for Dott. MICLICHINI, to which H.E. replied that the Ministry had said this morning they had written proposing MICLICHINI's transfer to Litteria. Evidently the letter has not got through to us yet.
6. With respect to MICLICHINI, H.E. said that Prefect ROCCI had had disagreements with the Germans and was removed by them. DE MARIA was appointed in his place but he spent most of his time in Rome. The post of Vice-Prefect Claudio was vacant. Therefore the Vice-Prefect Inspector MICLICHINI had to substitute for the Prefect, thus incurring the odium and responsibility of carrying out German and Fascist Republican orders.
7. H.E. says MICLICHINI certainly is not a fascist in any way and is an intelligent, hard-working, and efficient functionary. It is simply that in the circumstances he would be better employed in another province.
8. Before leaving, H.E. asked Captain Williams to tell Colonel ~~56~~ 6070 that should there be need of a Prefect to rule one of the northern provinces

as the armies advance, H.E. will be happy to serve his country in that way.

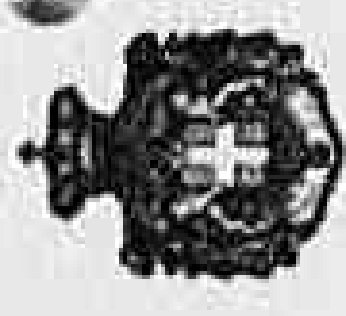

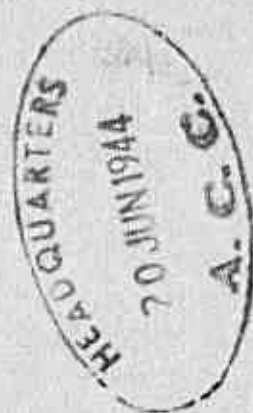

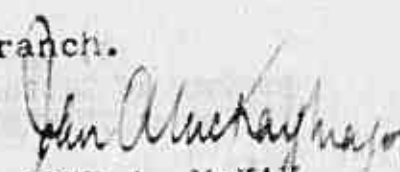

SUBJECT: Prefect of VIETNAM

TO : AD & AG Section

1. It is understood that a new Prefect may be required for the Province of VIETNAM almost at once.
2. The Minister of the Interior has suggested the following for this post:-

Avv. LACIA, Ivo
Via Pompeo Magno 10A, Rome.

LACIA is stated to have taken part in the underground patriot movement and consequently to have been imprisoned by the Germans. He is now free and resident as above.

3. The next steps to be taken are:-
 - (a) to interview LACIA and ascertain that he is willing to accept the post. It is our experience that a little persuasion and appeal to the candidate's patriotism has to be employed in some cases;
 - (b) to "screen" him from the security point of view;
 - (c) to inform AD 5th Army that LACIA is available when required;
 - (d) to send him forward when the AGO calls for him.
4. As LACIA is in Rome, the steps can best be taken by the AGO authority on the spot. This would appear to be either AD Rome Sub-Region or Region IV Rear HQ which I understood was to be set up in Rome at the beginning of this week.
5. Could the appropriate AGO authority in Rome please be requested to act in this sense?
6. May this Sub-Commission please be kept informed of the position as to LACIA and more especially as to
 - (a) whether he is willing to serve
 - (b) the result of screening.
7. This letter is sent in duplicate with a view to facilitating transmission to Rome.

1. Captain Temple and I saw Dr. Aldisio, Minister of Interior, and Dr. Camera, Chief of Cabinet this morning at 1000 hours on another matter.
2. At the end of the discussion, we informed H.E. that we had been called upon to be ready with a Prefect for Rieti, Terni, Aquila and Viterbo as soon as possible; and in the near future, Prefects would be required for Pescara, Teramo, Ascoli, and Perugia.
3. As to the four urgent provinces, we had already received the Minister's suggestions for Terni, Rieti and Aquila. It remained, therefore, to have a name for Viterbo.
4. The Minister promptly gave us the following name:
