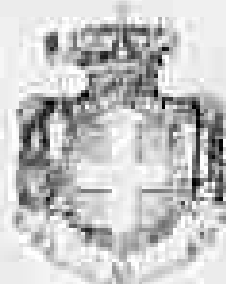

1. Reference your RS/507/22 of 6th December and my reply of 20th December, please let me know if

- (a) Cons. BUTRICO has arrived at Macerata from Aquila;
- (b) 1^o Seg. MORELLI has left Macerata for Ancona.

2. As to Cons. MESSO and the medical certificate and request for leave enclosed with your letter above-mentioned, this appears to be a genuine case of illness. I observe however that the certificate is dated 28th November so that the 40 days leave recommended by the doctor has about expired.

3. This man is wanted in Rome to undergo separation proceedings and it is important that he should be sent here as soon as he can travel and not allowed to evade this by magnifying his illness. 1. I refer to your letter R5/507/22 of 6 December. The reluctance of Italian Government officials to obey orders for their transfer to other posts is on the increase. The late Government crisis has intensified it. I am glad to note, however, the disposition on the part of the Ministry to take somewhat stronger measures. In one or two recent cases, they have formally notified the disobedient official that he would be dismissed from the service unless he obeyed orders at once.
2. Consigliere NUTRICO: This man is presumably back at Aquila, which is in your Region. Will you please cause him to be given the strictest orders to go to Macerata at once and use such methods as you may think fit to make sure he does so.
3. Primo Segretario BONELLI: I am quite certain this man is trying to avoid transfer to Perugia. As soon as the PC can contact him, may he please be given the strictest orders to do as he is told and will you use all available means to see he does so in this case also. If you could arrange for him to go from Macerata to Perugia direct I should be grateful.
4. Consigliere MESSO: In view of the medical certificate, I will let you know further about this man in due course.
5. Rag. VENTRIGLIA: This man is at the disposition of the Italian Government and if they do not want him at the moment, this HQ has no observations to make.
6. Vice Prefect PELLEGRINI: I should be grateful to know if he has yet left for Rome and the date.

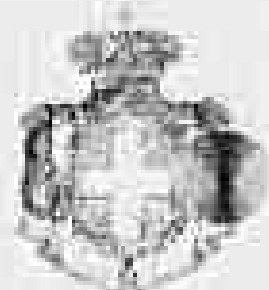

1. AMBROGIO Giovanni--Clerk, Macerata 4/1/67

I pointed out that this official has not reported as yet and the Personnel Division has informed us that they do not know his whereabouts. Since we agreed to wait only until today, I asked whether he would therefore please furnish us with the name of a substitute.

2. SERRA, Dott. Raffaele--VPI Pisa 4/1/68

I pointed out that we had received word from the Ministry that SERRA had been suspended for "marcia su Roma" and we were asked to direct that he report to the Ministry so that his case might be heard by the Expiration Committee. We had done this and consequently were surprised to receive a letter from the Ministry designating SERRA for VPI of Teramo, before we had received any indication from the Ministry as to what disposition was made of the expiration charges. I told Dott. CAMERA that we desired to know what the position was before we could indicate whether we approved or not. CAMERA, in turn, pointed out that although the Ministry sent the letter, he was suspended by AMG, and if the only charge was his possession of the honorary title "marcia su Roma", he still might be eligible for appointment someplace else. Dott. CAMERA asked if we could furnish him with any information that might be of interest in evaluating his case. I said we would make inquiries and in the meantime would he ascertain whether SERRA had reported to the Ministry, and if so what action had been taken.

3. Segretari Comunali MARINI and SANTONE (Province of Teramo) 4/1/77

I indicated that the Prefect of Teramo had expressed his concern about the restoration by order of the Minister to original positions of these two officials, who had been transferred because of Fascist connections in their towns. I told CAMERA that the Prefect was afraid there might be an uprising if they were restored and, furthermore, these two were amongst the 35 transfers that took place under AMG. 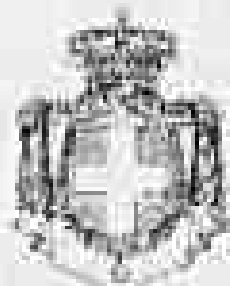

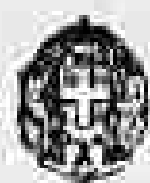

I have been in the past constantly persecuted by the fascist government for my liberal sentiments, and for this, it has passed twelve years without having a promotion even if having always covered employments of superior degree.

Now I must go away from Macerata, as I have desired, but I don't know the new residence: In the gone August I have made known to the Interior Ministry my desire to be appointed to lend my service at Naples, where I have been born and where I can find hospitality by relatives of mine, because I have lost all my furniture of the home I had at Potenza, with the bombardments and the sackage in that City.

I beg this Command to propose my transfer to Naples. If this isn't possible, I beg to propose me for the appointing of Prefect in one of the liberated Provinces.

1. Thank you for your letter P5/507/22 of 2 October, to which I have delayed my reply until I could receive and consider Capt. Williams' reports on his recent survey of these two Provinces. I enclose copies of those reports herewith.

2. I congratulate you and the FC on the good progress which has been made in the reorganisation of local government in both provinces. There are only a few points which need special mention,

3. Italian Officials for Ascoli :

I will obtain from the Ministry another Vice Prefect Vicario, instead of Dr. CONTINI and send him back to you. CONTINI should then be removed from office and ordered to Rome to report himself to the Ministry of Interior. Of the two Vice Prefect Inspectors, the Prefects prefers to keep RIGUCCI. PERCHINI should be ordered to Rome to report the Ministry of Interior, where he is required for another Province. The Consigliere Dr. CAPASSO, should be ordered to Rome likewise.

4. Italian Officials for Macerata :

The position is fully set out in Appendix B of Capt. Williams' report. I am taking the necessary action with the Ministry. Will you, on your part, arrange for (a) Consigliere BUIRICO to go from Ascoli to Macerata; (b) Reg. VENERIGLIA to be retired forthwith, and (c) for PERCHINI, MEMMO and BORELLI to be likewise removed as soon as their replacements arrive. When removed, each one of these three should be ordered to Rome to report to the Ministry of Interior.

1. I visited this province on 6 October and interviewed:—

Major Jackson — the outgoing PO
Major Denning — the incoming PO
Dr. PONTE — the Prefect

having seen the IC—Lt. Col. E.C.V. Rutter—previously at Ascoli.

2. Out of the 56 Communes in the province, 35 have their Sindaci and Giunta Comunale: the remainder, said the Prefect, would be settled in the course of the month. The Deputazione Provinciale has been appointed and met and has elected the citizen members of the C.P.A. Some difficulty had been met in one or two cases over appointing Sindaci due to the honorary nature of the office.

3. The Prefect is working well and is approved of by the PO and his POs. He is a little unpopular in certain political quarters in the province, but I feel this is because he stands up to the CIM. This body is not causing more trouble than usual, it seems, but the Patriots are. They have not surrendered all their arms and there have been one or two shooting cases.

4. The main question to be settled in this province related to the officials of the Prefecture. Apparently contradictory communications have been passing between the Prefect and the Ministry of the Interior. The position is set out in Appendix A.

1. With reference to your letter dated the 19th September, 1944, File No. R/5375, the SCHEDA PERSONALE of Dott. ADORNI Pompeo, formerly V. Prefetto Ispettore of this Province is attached.
2. The document does not reveal any outstanding Fascist tendencies, but the subject served in the above capacity during the whole time of the German occupation of the area, where his subservience to his extreme Republican Fascist Prefect ROTTOLI is well known and remembered by the population of the Province.
3. He has not served in his Office since the date of the occupation, because in the first few weeks he was ill, and when he might have resumed later he was not permitted to do so because of his previous record.
4. He is 62 years old, and should his services be required there is no objection to the security angle, but from information received in this Office and his actions during the Republican regime, it is considered that he is a very weak subject with little strength of character. His re-employment in his former office in this Province would most definitely be non acceptable to the general populace.

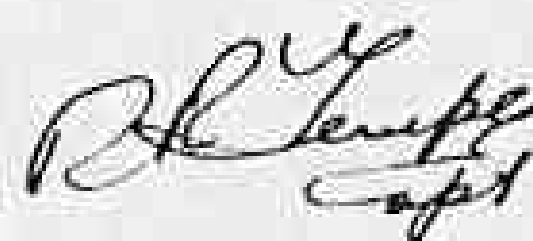

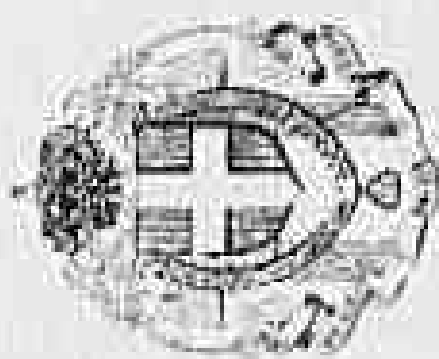

1. Reference your RH/714/2 of 30th July.
2. The screening of Dr. Ponte's valet cannot be undertaken at this Headquarters. There is no information here as to his name, address, identity card number, or as to other particulars required by Security Branch; neither can the personal interview (which is an essential part of the screening) be arranged here, seeing that the valet left for ALEXANDRIA with Dr. Ponte on 31 July and is no doubt there by now. It would seem that the only officer who can screen this individual is the DCO at ALEXANDRIA.
3. As to Petralito, Dr. Ponte approached this Sub-Commission in the matter when he was in Rome on a three day's leave last week. In the absence of authority either from the 8th Army or from the AMI for Petralito to cross the Army Rear Control Line, it was impossible to issue a pass.
4. Application however has been made to AMI for the requisite authority and if possible, Petralito will be forwarded to you at Anzola for passing forward to Alexandria.

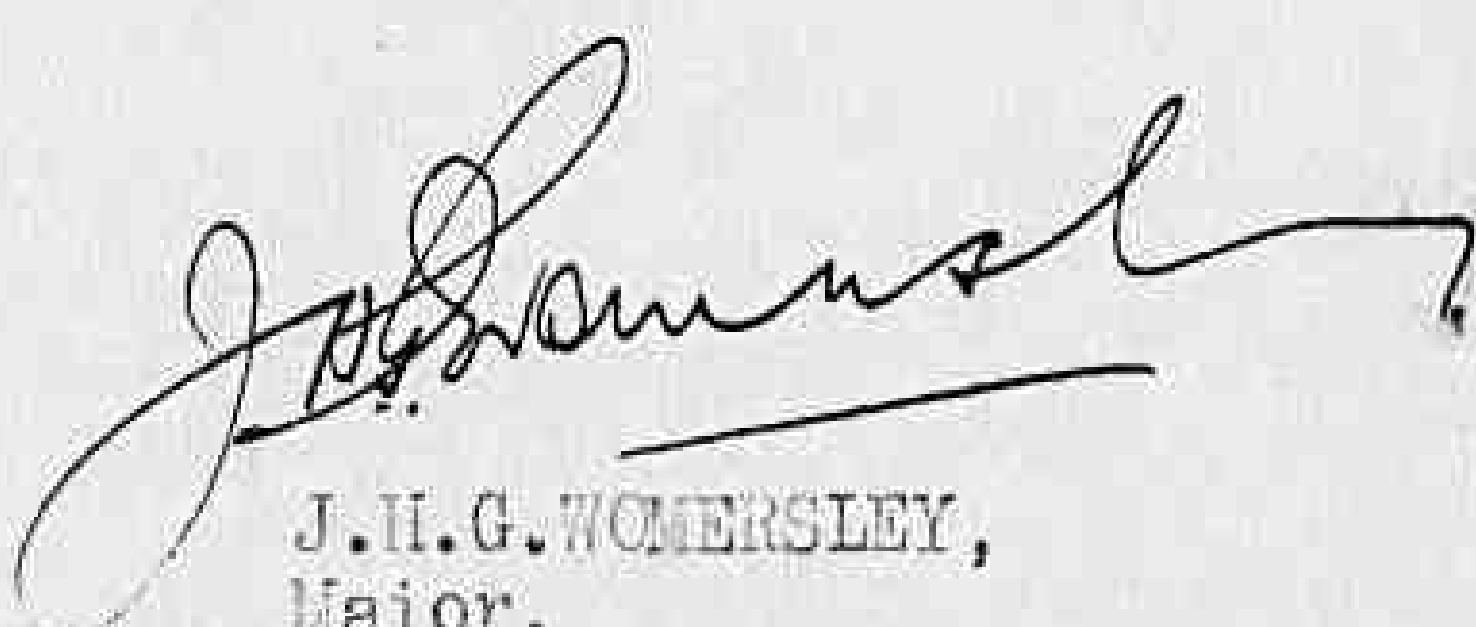

In addition to the list mentioned in 2 above from which the sub-commission has worked, I have learned that Berruti the representative here of the Ministry of Interior has prepared a further list of 19 suggested "candidates" for appointment of Prefect. This further list has recently been sent by Berruti to the Ministry of Interior at Salerno. They have not been screened or, as far as I know, ever been formally submitted to ACC.
4. I suggest you decide upon the Prefects to be earmarked as requested and inform me of your decisions. If the people agreed upon by you and the Ministry are in Rome, I will arrange for their screening here.
5. Please convey request concerning Intendente di Finanza to Finance,
6. Col Spicer already knows of para 2 of enclosure.
7. Please keep me informed of any developments, correspondence, etc.
