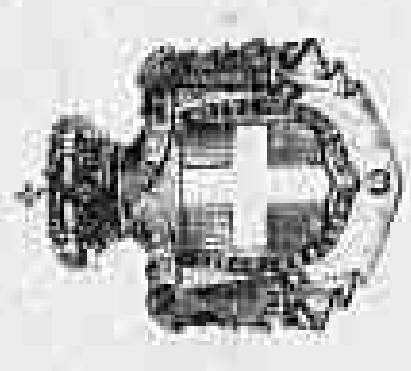

He was for some time a member, and afterwards head, of the Information Bureau of Partito d'Azione, in which capacity he has given valuable help and assistance to F.B.S.

According to our information he has just been called up for Military service.

SUBJECT : Italian Officials.

TO : All PC's.

1. The practice of Prefects writing direct to the Ministry of the Interior upon questions relating to the appointment, dismissal or release of, or the granting of leave to Italian Officials is becoming increasingly prevalent.

2. A further practice which has developed recently is that of Italian Officials ordered by HQ, AC to take up appointments in A.M.G., territory suddenly being overcome by acute illnesses either before or soon after they have taken up their appointments.

3. There is a great shortage of Italian Officials and both the Ministry of the Interior and Local Government Sub-Commission, HQ, AC are experiencing the greatest of difficulty in meeting the demands made upon them.

4. You will, therefore, instruct the Prefect of your Province that under no circumstances whatsoever will they write direct to the Ministry of the Interior upon questions relating to the appointment, dismissal or release of, or granting of leave to Italian Officials. Such communications will be submitted to your HQ, and, if after examination you concur in the contents, they will be transmitted to this HQ, with your recommendations. After further scrutiny by this HQ, such communications may, if it is considered desirable, be represented to HQ, AC.

5. In regard to para 2 above. All officials sent by HQ, AC to appointments in A.M.G. territory are sent with the knowledge that they are capable of working satisfactorily. In the event, therefore, of any official sent to you by HQ, AC complaining of being unable, owing to ill health, to carry out his duties, you will insist on a medical examination by an Army Doctor at the nearest Italian Military Hospital. No request for relief of such officials will be considered at this HQ unless it is supported by a medical certificate signed by an Italian Army Doctor.

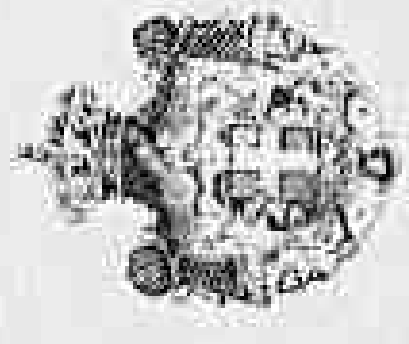

SUBJECT: Cons. MORRICA Dott. Manlio--recently at Pisa. 22 February 1945

TO : His Excellency the Minister of the Interior.

Your Excellency:

1. I enclose herewith for the Ministry's information copy of letter No. 471 Gab. dated 10 February addressed by the Prefect of Pisa to the Ministry, which the Regional Commissioner of Toscana Region has requested me to forward.
2. It will be observed that what the Prefect says in this letter does not agree with what is stated in the Ministry's letter to this Sub Commission, No. 5000 (Dir. Gen. Personale) dated 5 February. In that letter, the Ministry indicate that MORRICA's services are no longer needed at Pisa, and this was clarified and confirmed in an interview between the Director General of Personnel and Major Williams on 7 February.
3. The Marchese BALENTI was good enough to call and see Major Williams this afternoon and inform him that the Ministry were submitting Dott. MORRICA to a medical examination by Army doctors; and that if the doctors reported that MORRICA was not capable of giving service, another official would be nominated for Arezzo. On the other hand, if the doctors reported otherwise, the Ministry would direct MORRICA to report himself here in order to go to Arezzo under pain of disciplinary measures.
4. It is evident, however, from what the Prefect now says in his letter of 10 February that he does need a councillor at Pisa. I feel that the Prefect did not examine with sufficient strictness Dott. MORRICA's plea of illness and was too ready to release him, and I have so informed the Regional Commissioner for Toscana Region. I have also drawn his attention to the confusion which has arisen in this case due to the Prefect first communicating with the Ministry direct and then on the tenth of February sending another communication through the organs of the Allied Commission.
5. I feel that Dott. MORRICA's plea of illness to the Prefect was largely an excuse to get out of serving at Pisa. If, therefore, the report of the Army doctors states that MORRICA is capable of giving service, I suggest that it would be better, and in the interests of good discipline, to order him back to Pisa and not send him to Arezzo.

6. If this suggestion is adopted, a new nomination will be needed for Arezzo and I shall be glad to receive this.

1. Reference folio 92 and your minute 33 above. I mentioned this matter to Dr. MICALI, Dir. Gen. of Personnel on 7 Feb. He says he thinks it is quite correct that MORRICA has a duodenal ulcer, but that it is not bad enough to prevent him from working, and there is no reason why he should not go to Arezzo straightway. I said in that case why did not the Prefect of Pisa release him?
2. MICALI replied that the Prefect did not need his services at Pisa any more. MICALI agreed that there is no real pressing need to send anyone down to Pisa to take MORRICA's place. He would order MORRICA to report to us at once so that we could send him down to Arezzo.
3. I think we can and should accept the official advice of the Ministry on this subject. Letter to the Ministry confirming conversation herewith for signature, please.
4. Although the normal practice is to send officials to Regional HQ I think in this case, we should attempt to send MORRICA to Arezzo direct if transport is available. It does not seem sensible to send him all the way down to Montecatini and then to send him back to Arezzo.

SUBJECT: Cons. MORRICA Dott. Mario--recently at Pisa. 20 February 1945

TO : RG Toscana Region (with copy for RG Pisa)

1. I refer to your XVIII/68/1A/186 dated 16 February, and the enclosed letter dated 10 February addressed by the Prefect of Pisa to the Ministry of the Interior.
2. What the Prefect now says is a little surprising. The Ministry of the Interior wrote to me on 5 February that the Prefect had informed them some time ago that he had released ("messo in liberta") MORRICA because of his duodenal ulcer, and that as his services did not seem necessary at Pisa, the Ministry proposed him for Arezzo. This was discussed personally with the Director General of Personnel at the Ministry three days later. The Director General said it was true that MORRICA suffered from a duodenal ulcer, but it was not so acute as to prevent him from doing any work at all. He stated quite definitely that there was no reason why MORRICA should not go and perform his functions at Arezzo. In reply to an inquiry as to why in these circumstances the Prefect of Pisa had released him, the Director General replied that the reason was that Pisa did not need him. Accordingly, MORRICA's destination to Arezzo was agreed and he has been ordered to present himself here for travel orders. He has not yet appeared and is evidently trying to evade this assignment.
3. It is evident that before writing his letter of 10 February, the Prefect had communicated direct with the Ministry on the subject. On that occasion, he either told the Ministry a different story from what he now writes, or the Ministry have not repeated accurately to me what he said. This is an excellent example of the confusion and unnecessary work which arises if Prefects will persist in communicating upon appointments, releases and dismissals of officials with the Ministry direct, instead of through AC channels.
4. In my opinion, the Prefect should never have released MORRICA. ~~Not~~ The Ministry of the Interior and this Sub Commission are doing everything possible to cope with the attacks of illness which suddenly overcome every Italian official on being ordered to AIC Territory. We now insist on examination by Army doctors of the nearest Italian military hospital. If Prefects do not examine with equal strictness the excuses made by officials who have just been sent down to them, we can hardly fulfill our task of keeping the Prefectures supplied. (b) that the Ministry and this Sub Commission do not send officials down to a Prefecture unless they are satisfied that they are capable of working there, and that excuses on the ground of sickness must be strictly examined.

5. In the extreme shortage of officials here, which is becoming weekly more acute, I doubt if I shall be able to find a replacement for Dr. MORRICA. Would you be good enough to ascertain from the PC whether a replacement is absolutely essential, in which case I will do what I can to find one.

1. At the end of Major Temple's discussion with H. E. on operation matters, I mentioned the following personnel movements:
2. VPI Pisa:--We could not agree to SPARACIO. The Ministry have now nominated GRASSI (see file 4/1/131), but we did not have good reports of him and would have to reject him, too. We were writing to the Ministry to that effect today. Could we please have another nomination quickly, as this is a front-line and much damaged province which has been without an Inspector for a long time, and it is urgent.
3. We said we realized there was great difficulty in finding suitable Vice Prefects. We referred to the Italian practice of confiding the inspective functions to a Rag. Capo as an alternative to appointing a VPI. If it would assist the Ministry, we said we would be quite willing to consider a Rag. Capo for the inspective functions at Pisa, if they could find us an energetic and competent man. MICALI said he appreciated our suggestion but a VPI was really the better thing and he would try to get us one. We agreed but wished H. E. to understand that in other cases, he was always at liberty to suggest a Rag. Capo as an alternative.
4. VPI Lucca:--Where is Dr. SARNO? He was accepted on 28 December and the Ministry telegraphed him on 9 January to come up from Bari. Was he sick or dodging? MICALI said no, SARNO had reported saying that he would come as soon as he could find some means of travel. I pointed out that it was 13 days since the Ministry had cabled and asked MICALI to keep an eye on the case and telegraph SARNO again.
5. VPI Grosseto:--Where is APICELLA who has been ordered up from Rieti for this post? MICALI said they believed he was ill and were awaiting the report of the Medico Provinciale who had been out of the province for a few days, which was why it had been delayed.
6. VPI Florence:--MICALI himself brought this up and referred to our rejection of PARISI on account of age. He said PARISI was really a competent and hard-working official. He had been VP at Palermo, which was comparable to Florence, and had done very well there. He then urged us to see PARISI and form our own opinion.

7. We pointed out that the Prefect of Florence himself had expressed a poor opinion of PARISI and said he didn't want him. MICALI said the Prefect (PATERNO) was very keen to retain the present VPV GIGLI and for this purpose he would naturally depreciate any alternative candidate. He said he was sure that was the reason for PATERNO's objection. We asked MICALI if, assuming we did send PARISI, he and PATERNO would get on together. H. E. looked somewhat doubtful but said he thought they would.

8. We said that since MICALI pressed it, we would see PARISI and let him know our impression. MICALI would arrange for him to call tomorrow, Tuesday, 23 January, at 10:00 hours

2. It is appreciated that the vacant post is that of Vice Prefect Inspector and Dr. SPARACIO was proposed by the Ministry for that post.
3. On the question of his employment at Pisa, I am very glad to have the views of the EC, to which I of course give fullest weight. I think, however, that as a matter of general principle, it is undesirable to re-appoint an official who has been suspended (or whose suspension has been confirmed, as in this case, by AEC on the grounds of his Fascist past, until that official's case has been considered by the Epuration Commission of the Ministry of the Interior. The case against SPARACIO may not be a serious one, as the Ministry have in fact themselves suggested. If that is in fact the case, then a speedy favourable decision from the Epuration Commission can be expected and all concerned--the official himself and the Ministry as well as the Allied Commission--are clear.
4. I have, therefore, written to the Ministry of the Interior requesting that this be done. At the same time, I have stated that unless the case can be heard by the Epuration Commission within a week, another nomination must be made for Pisa, as the need in that province is urgent.

Ministry of Interior.

DATE: 29 November 1944

Signorina T. CAZZANI interpreting.

1. AMBROGIO Giovanni--Clerk, Macerata

I pointed out that this official has not reported as yet and the Personnel Division has informed us that they do not know his whereabouts. Since we agreed to wait only until today, I asked whether he would therefore please furnish us with the name of a substitute.

2. CAMERA, Dott. Raffaele--VFI Pisa

I pointed out that we had received word from the Ministry that CAMERA had been suspended for "marcia su Roma" and we were asked to direct that he report to the Ministry so that his case might be heard by the Separation Committee. We had done this and consequently were surprised to receive a letter from the Ministry designating CAMERA for VFI of Lerasio, before we had received any indication from the Ministry as to what disposition was made of the separation charges. I told Dott. CAMERA that we desired to know what the position was before we could indicate whether we approved or not. CAMERA, in turn, pointed out that although the Ministry sent the letter, he was suspended by AMG, and if the only charge was his possession of the honorary title "Marcia su Roma", he still might be eligible for appointment someplace else. Dott. CAMERA asked if we could furnish him with any information that might be of interest in evaluating his case. I said we would make inquiries and in the meantime could he ascertain whether CAMERA had reported to the Ministry, and if so what action had been taken.

3. Segretari Generali MASSIMO and SANTORI (Province of Lerasio)

I indicated that the Prefect of Lerasio had expressed his concern about the restoration by order of the Minister to original positions of these two officials, who had been transferred because of Fascist connections in their towns. I told CAMERA that the Prefect was afraid there might be an uprising if they were restored and, furthermore, these two were amongst the 35 transfers that took place under AMG. I said I would appreciate receiving his observations on this matter, and he said he would inform us as to what the position was.

4. SINDACO OF NAPLES

I asked CAMERA whether there had been any further developments in the attempt on the part of the Government to get the written withdrawal of CAMERA as a candidate for the position of Sindaco of Naples. CAMERA stated there had

been no change; that because of the crisis little had been done, and that very likely a lot would depend upon whether FALENO was to be retained as Under Secretary of War or not. He would inform us as soon as the position was clarified.

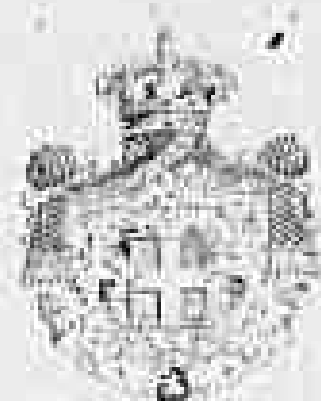

Reference your indorsement 225/1 of 18 November on FC, Pisa's letter to you 5275/PS of 11 November and to the enclosed copy of letter from the Prefect to the Ministry of the Interior stressing the urgency of the provision of certain officials. Civil Affairs Section have passed this correspondence to this Sub Commission for action.

2. The Prefect's very full report on the staff position at the Prefettura dated 26 September, which we received on 4 October with your covering letter 225/1 of 2 October, was at once referred to the Ministry for consideration and report, as well as to the other Sub Commissions concerned--Public Health and Finance. We have exercised continual pressure ever since on the Ministry to get them to produce ^{an official} ~~an~~ ^{one}. They have at last nominated:

(a) A Consigliere, Dr. Mario MORRICA--this will be the "functionary of Group A" for whom the Prefect now asks:

(b) 1^o Rag. Giuseppe GUCCIONE, who will meet the request for such an official in the Prefect's last letter. *identity card N° 9*

3. They have been cleared and we will send them down just as soon as we can arrange transport. In fact, they were ordered to report here some ten days ago: they have not turned up and so far the Ministry cannot find them.

4. The Medico and Veterinario Provinciali are being handled by Public Health Sub Commission. I will obtain an Archivista from the Ministry as quickly as I can.

5. This covers all the officials mentioned in the Prefect's letter of 9 November. I notice, however, he does not mention the need for a Vice Prefect to replace SERENA. I presume he is still required. There are less Vice Prefects available than any other class of administrative official, but I will get one for Pisa somehow.

6. You may rely on this Sub Commission to supply the very reasonable needs now indicated by the Prefect as quickly as possible. The incompetence

Otherwise I would use as inspector one of the consiglieri attached to this Prefecture since long time ago and whom I have already experimented.

Became a member of Republican Fascist Party upon extreme pressure from the then prefect. This is the one thing against him, he has the reputation of being an able man.

I am retaining him in office until a substitute has been appointed.

PROVINCIAL VETERINARY/ Coppi, di Renzo, age 33. Was a member of P N F. Joined 1934 but held no office. A member of M.V.S.N. (Voluntary) Joined Republican Fascist Party.

Will be retained in office until a substitute has been appointed, from Rome.

HEAD ARCHIVIST/ Reo Domenico. Further details as to career, etc unknown as the man is ill. He is however suitable for retention.

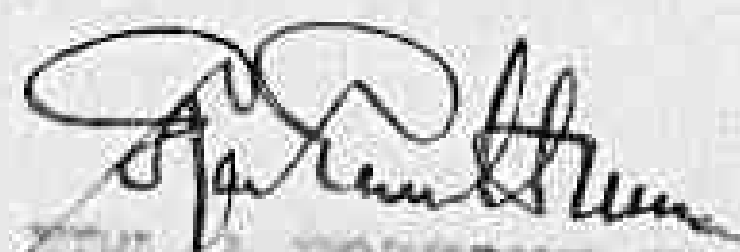

1. This is to introduce my Italian Liaison Officer, 2nd Lt Gerardo ZAMPAGLIONE who is accompanying the Prefect designate of PISA, Dr. Vincenzo PERRUZZO. His instructions are to call at your HQ and present Dr. PERRUZZO and then to take him on to Provincial HQ.
2. I enclose for your information a copy of my record as to the new Prefect. He has the rank of a substantive Prefect: ~~in his~~ appointment therefore, the word "reggente" should not be used. I enclose form of appointment accordingly.
3. Dr. PERRUZZO is accompanied by:
 - a. BICATTINI, Giuseppe, an Agente di P.S., as the Prefect's personal attendant
 - b. COLONCHI, Dott. Tito, a Consigliere who accompanies the Prefect to assist him to set up his office.

It has not been possible in the time available to have these two ~~personally~~ screened, and in the case of the Agente, you could possibly have that done locally. Dr. COLONCHI however, is not a permanent assignment for PISA, and will only be required for a day or two.
4. As I mentioned to Col Mayne when he called to see me on 4 September I am sending you the Prefect first so that he could look around and advise you as to what other officials he needs at the Prefettura; and if you will let me know in due course what posts it is necessary to fill, I will send the requisite officials down as soon as possible. In my experience however, Prefects usually ask for more than they really need and I would counsel some caution in receiving the Prefect's views on this head.
5. 2nd Lt ZAMPAGLIONE bears an extra copy of this letter and enclosures in case you should wish him to deliver them to PC PISA.

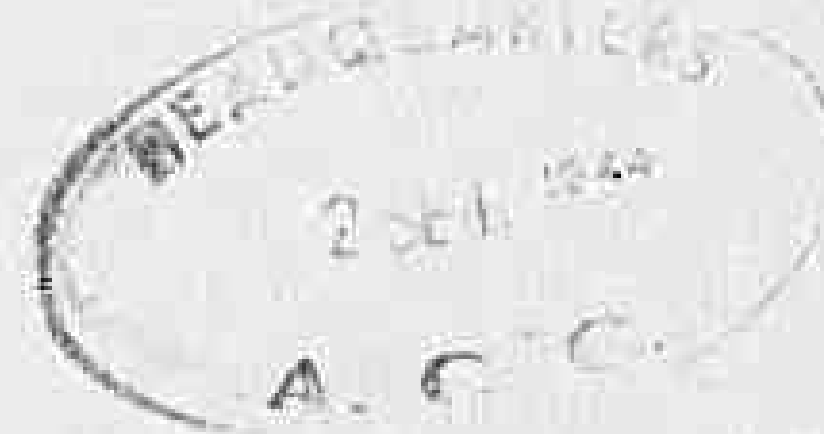

1. With reference to the attached letter ACC/4/1/68/Int the true facts of Avv Sbarba's visit to Rome are as follows.

2. At the end of July, soon after I had received notification that Sbarba, a former Cabinet Minister, should be contacted for advice on Defascistization in Pisa, he attended my office, stated that he had returned from Sienna to his house in Volterra, and that he desired to go to Rome to see Bonomi, an old friend and colleague of his. According to his story Bonomi had sent word by his nephew that he would like to see him, and he therefore requested me to give him transport to Rome, either by military or civilian vehicle, this, of course, I refused.

During the interview Sbarba emphasized that he was not seeking any office, he had been a Cabinet Minister but felt that he was too old to take a post now. He further stated that many persons from Pisa had suggested that he be Prefect of the Province, but he would refuse that office as it was a lower one than Cabinet Minister.

3. About a fortnight ago, he again approached me about going to Rome, being able to go in the car of a friend of his, which carried a permit. In view of the fact that he undoubtedly was a friend and collaborator of Bonomi, and apparently enjoys the confidence of the ACC RC & MG Section I issued him with a travel permit.

4. Sbarba did not ask me for petrol, he was not supplied by me or by any of my officers, not so far as I can ascertain, was any authority given to C I P for the issue of petrol for the trip.

5. Upon his return he told me that Bonomi had persuaded

him to be Prefect of the Province, much to my surprise because I knew that prior to my first interview with Sbarba, the SCAO AMG 5th Army had asked for a Prefect and a skeleton Provincial Administration to be ready in Rome to move up at short notice.

6. I must emphasize that Sbarba did not go to Rome at my suggestion; the only facility given to him was a travel permit and I certainly did not send him there with the idea that he should become Prefect as para 5 of the letter quoted suggests. If I had wanted him as Prefect I should have proposed him through the proper channels some weeks ago.

7. Avv Sbarba is an old man, anti-fascist he may be but his anti-communist views are even more pronounced, in fact, Communism is an obsession with him and he is continually trying to get AMG to act against a local Communist propagandist-Frattini.

Were he nominated as Prefect, he would be acceptable to me as a temporary expedient, but I consider him to be too politically minded for a permanent official.

8. I suggest that Dott. Peruzzo Vincenzo be appointed Prefect of the Province and that he be held ready to move at very short notice.

1. Herewith copies of reports of Captain R. R. Temple, who, with your co-operation, made Local Government surveys in the areas referred to.

2. This Sub-Commission is appreciative of the courtesy extended to him.

3. I concur with the advice given in the reports.

4. I must, however, draw your attention to para 7 of the report on Pisa Province (Report No. 103).

5. The Ministry informs us that Avv. SPARSA motored down to Rome with the authority of the PG, with a permit supplied by him plus petrol for his car and spent the best part of two days in the Ministry trying to talk himself into the appointment of Prefect. This does not seem to agree with the para as quoted. Moreover, if, as Avv. SPARSA states, it was done with the full permission and help of the PG, it seems to me that every chance of our liaison and channelization with the Italian Government is being broken.

6. The Italian Government have a selected Prefect waiting for Pisa Province whom they have nominated at our request (following the PG's request to Capt Temple - see para 2 of Report No. 103). He is a career official - Dott. PERUZZO Vincenzo - which SPARSA is not, and the Ministry wherever possible are anxious to see career officials in these posts. I am enclosing a brief biographical sketch of PERUZZO who incidentally has been passed by Security Branch.

7. Please advise us as to the present position and your wishes.

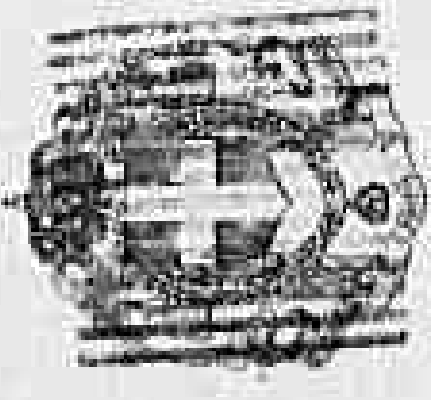

3. Giuseppe Aloï - Chief Acct.

I have found these three to be acceptable from a security standpoint.

Following the request of Colonel Spicer, I have already informed him of my finding by telephone.

As these officials are urgently needed, the fourth member of the Pisa team, Umberto Prosperi, has not been screened yet, as I have not yet received the particulars from the Interior Sub-Commission.

I suggest however that he will be sent on with the rest of the team and should he later be found not acceptable, he could then be changed.

I again would like to ask for at least a three days advance notice as that is the minimum time absolutely necessary for such an investigation.

1. As of today front line troops are in the suburbs of Pisa. It is not known how soon the city will be occupied but it may be very soon. As the greater part of the Province is already occupied it is essential that an Italian Administration be started at the earliest possible moment.

It is therefore requested that a skeleton team of officials be held in readiness to move forward at very short notice if required.

With regard to Livorno, the city has been evacuated of most of the population and it is not yet known how many of the officials can be found, though it is thought that very few are left. Fuller information should be forthcoming in another two or three days: in the meantime it is requested that for here also a skeleton team be held in readiness to move up immediately when called for.

Your Excellency,

1. I write to confirm the conversation between Cap. William and Dr. Camera which took place at Salerno on 6 July.
2. The Sub-Commission has been warned by AMG to get ready to provide skeleton administration for the provinces of:-

SIENA
LIVORNO
PISA

APUANIA
LUCCA
PISTOIA

3. In view of a report that has just arrived I am writing you a separate letter about SIENA.
4. As to the remaining five provinces, recent experience shows that the possibility must be faced of have to organize complete new teams of senior officials for each of them. The Government is accordingly requested to nominate the required personnel now and to have them ready to proceed to any one of these provinces at 24 hours notice. It can be assumed that a new Prefect will be needed in every case. We must therefore be ready with nominees for all the provinces. From the point of view of the Allied Control Commission, there is no reason why the Prefects already nominated by you for PERUGIA, ASCOLI, TERAMO and PESCARA should not be considered as available for other provinces, since they have not so far been called upon for these provinces for which they were originally named. The basic idea of having such a list was that would constitute a "pool" from which could be drawn for whatever province might need one.
5. If you agree that Drs. BIANCONOSSO, DONADU, PONTE, and PATERNÒ are available for the five provinces now under consideration, I need only ask you for the names of four more Prefects - I say four in order to have some slight reserve for future cases. Otherwise it will be necessary to have eight more names.
6. As to other officials, I presume each team should consist of the following in accordance with your Ministry's advice on previous occasions:-
A Vice-Prefect Vicario - or a Consigliere to act as such
A Consigliere or Primo Segretario
A Ragioniere

7. You have already given me the names of three officials working at the Ministry - Drs. CAPPUCCIO and MUSILLO and Regioniere GUCCIONE - who can, with a Prefect, form the first team. The necessary investigation are being made as to these. Please let me know as soon as they arrive in Rome and their private addresses in the capital.

8. I understand we should be ready as soon as possible with two other similar teams, consisting of officials actually living or working in Rome. We shall thus be ready to send parties to at least three of the five provinces in question as and when they are called for; and we shall thereby gain a little time in which to organize teams for the remaining two provinces in case of need.

9. Will you please therefore let me have as quickly as possible the names of the six officials required.

10. In all cases - Prefects and others - will you please supply short biographical details, as in previous cases.

SUBJECT: Italian Provincial Officials
 TO : HQ, AMO, Interior Sub-Commission.

1. If operations proceed at the pace which is at present anticipated the problem will very shortly arise of reorganising the Italian Provincial Administration of the thickly populated Provinces which lie ahead.

Attention is drawn to the fact that the four Provincial Capitals of Livorno, Pisa, Lucca and Pistoia, which all lie on approximately the same latitude, are likely to be occupied almost simultaneously, and that the Provincial centre of Arezzo is likely to follow a few days later. The fall of Sienna can be expected before the end of this month.

2. It is impossible to forecast at this stage how much of the former administration will be found in existence; in the case of Viterbo most officials were found present and to be satisfactory for temporary reappointment, whereas recent experience at Grosseto, where all Provincial Officials had fled, forces us to the conclusion that we must be prepared to face the possibility of having to organise a completely new team of Senior Provincial Officials for all these six Provinces.

3. It is therefore requested that the Italian Government be directed to nominate now and have ready on call the necessary personnel, so that there may be the minimum possible delay in restarting the Italian Administration when the Provinces are occupied. We will keep our demands down to the minimum but it can be taken for granted that a new Prefect will be needed in every case.

4. As has been done ~~hitherto~~, you will be sent information as soon as possible after occupation on the conditions found in the places mentioned above.
