TO : The Minister of Interior

1. Reference is made to the Ministry's letters No. 1571/1 (Dir. Gen. Personale) dated 23 June and 5 September.
2. As Dr. SACCONI is serving in an Italian regiment and as the province of Pistoia is now under Italian jurisdiction this does not appear to be a case where the intervention of the Allied Commission is necessary. It is suggested that the Ministry should communicate direct with the Ministry of War as to release of Dr. SACCONI from the Army.
3. For your information, however, it may be noted that on 30 June the Land Forces Sub Commission of the Allied Commission sent a copy of your letter of 23 June to the Italian Ministry of War stating that this Headquarters supported the release of Dr. SACCONI.

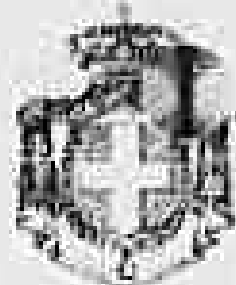

SUBJECT: Note of interview - Local Government S/O offices.

DATE : 28 May 1945

PRESENT: H. E. ALLES, Prefect of Pistoia
 Co. R. R. Cripps, Director

 Lt. D. MODIANO, interpreting

1. The Prefect called to pay his respects to Col. Cripps and inquired if there was any possibility of him being appointed to the position of Prefect of Venice. The reason for his application was that he knew those parts, and desired also to live in that area to obtain certain treatment for his physical condition.
2. Col. Cripps stated that he was not in a position to make any intimation to H. E. as he knew of no vacancy and further that the question of such an appointment involved AMG for that area, together with the CLM and the Italian Government.
3. H. E. stated that he had not yet approached the Ministry of the Interior as Pistoia was still under AMG administration, and was advised by Col. Cripps to mention the matter to the Ministry.
4. In answer to Col. Cripps' question, H. E. expressed the view that the provincial administration of Pistoia was in a fit condition for restoration to the jurisdiction of the Italian Government. He agreed that large numbers of Allied troops (he estimated 20,000) were expected in Montecatini, but he did not feel that this would present any substantial difficulties to his administration. He agreed that the presence of AMG in an area where troops were quartered was often a help in dealing with the matters and difficulties which such circumstances caused, e.g. requisitioning of property, etc., but was not at all worried as to the ability of the Italian administration in the province to deal with such affairs satisfactorily.
5. Only one commune in the northern area of the province had been fought in prior to the eventual German retreat.
6. Mine clearance was being satisfactorily dealt with.
7. Patriots presented no difficulty.

SUBJECT: Report on Prefects of Pistoia and Lucca.

7 February 1945

TO : Director, Local Government S/C.

FROM : Major C. G. R. Williams.

1. Please see at folio 64 extracts relating to Pistoia and Lucca from the Chief of Staff's notes of his recent tour of inspection in this area.
2. Pistoia: We were asked last June by 5 Army to have a Prefect and other personnel ready for Pistoia (see folio 1). On 24 September, 5 Army called for him urgently (see folio 9). The original nominee--POTI--proved to be much too feeble when interviewed. ALB3 was selected and sent down on 26 September.
3. I think quite well of ALB3, judging by Italian standards. He is a recently promoted Prefect, anxious to prove himself. I have interviewed him here and surveyed his province. I have observed before a tendency on the part of provincial officers to judge Italian officials by what they think they ought to be and not by the standard that actually exists.
4. There was nothing to prevent 5 Army appointing a local man last September if they had wished: and there is nothing to stop them now making a change if they like. I note, however, that the Chief of Staff states that no change is necessary at present.
5. I suggest we ask the EC (through SCAG) if they have any actual person in mind as the "local man who was a member of the CINAI without politics", and if so to send us particulars of him.
6. Lucca: CARIGNANI is a prominent lawyer in private practice in the city of Lucca. The Archbishop (in his private capacity) is one of his clients. Everyone in Lucca knows him and respects him. His value to AMG rests almost entirely on his local influence, which is exceptional. He would, therefore, be unsuitable in any other Prefecture: nor could he be expected to accept such an appointment.
7. As to administrative incompetence, I should not care to express an opinion on this without a lengthy day-to-day observation of his work. Naturally, he is not so well acquainted with the principles and details of Italian local administration as a career official would be. For that reason, we are endeavoring to squeeze out of the Ministry a reasonably competent Vice Prefect Vicario and Vice Prefect Inspector for Lucca.
8. Here again, there was nothing to prevent 5 Army asking this S/C for a career man in the first place instead of appointing CARIGNANI, and there is nothing to prevent them from making a change now if they desire.

The following notes and observations were made during the Chief of Staff's recent tour of inspection (Jan. 17-23) of AMG Fifth Army, Northern provinces of Toscana Region, and Perugia area. They are submitted to you for information and such action as may be appropriate.

- IV -

At Pistoia, 19 Jan. 45

a) Prefect. - The Prefect is a career man appointed by the Ministry of Interior and the Local Government Sub Commission, by name, ALES. The local people and Captain Dunn would have liked a local man who was a member of the CLNAI without politics. No change at present but Local Government Sub Commission should watch.

- V -

At Lucca, 19 Jan. 45

a) Prefect. - Saw Captain Valentine recently from Sardinia, Acting Provincial Commissioner, with the Executive Officer, an American lieutenant, and the Supply and Public Safety Officers. Here, as opposed to Pistoia, they have the President of the CLNAI as Prefect. He is a Christian Democrat and politically innocuous but administratively incompetent. They would like to have a career man appointed; Prefect's name is CARALIGNINI. It might be possible to bring the career Prefect from Pistoia and so please all parties.

b) Epuration Committee - The epuration Committee is headed by a Communist who seems to be working well. The senior judge appears to be under investigation and is in a concentration camp.

a) Prefect - The Prefect, a career man, is satisfactory. However, he is short two vice-prefects and two consiglieri. The carabinieri are far from satisfactory. They are all living at home and it is felt that they should be interchanged with the other provinces so that the carabinieri will be operating as units independent of personal connections with the commune and accordingly billeted, etc., at their own caserne.

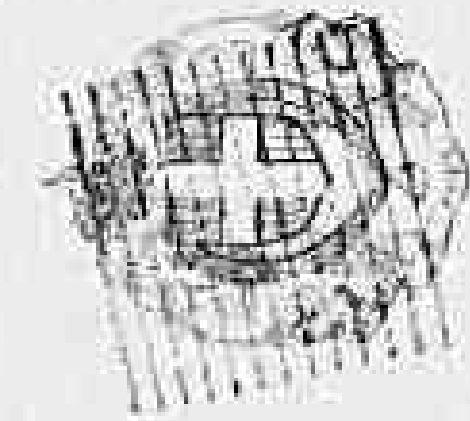

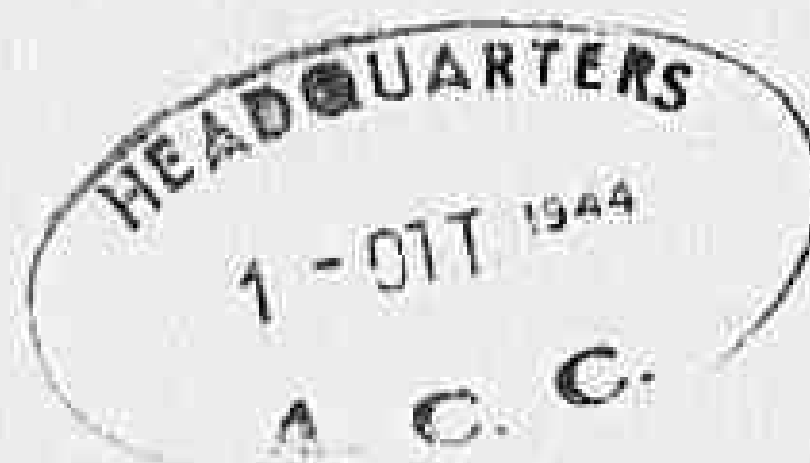

1. The Provincial Capital is in part badly damaged.
2. It appears that the administration as such has not functioned properly since June.
3. The Prefect fled to the north.
4. Large numbers of the inhabitants and the bulk of the Provincial officials have left the town.
5. Recently, certain officials had appeared and the addresses of others have become known.
6. The position regarding chief officials on the 23rd September was as follows:

Vice Prefect Vicario	Known, but doubtful whether he can be employed.
Vice Prefect Inspector	Unknown. Position believed vacant.

7. Since the above date the new Prefect ALBS has gone forward and the Provincial Commissioner was arranging to recall all officials to their posts in order that the Prefect can restart the working of the Administration.
8. The Provincial Commissioner was not yet in a position to say whether a Vice-Prefect Vicario would have to be sent up or whether a local man could act temporarily in that capacity. Although an official may not be needed it is requested that the Ministry should nominate someone who could go forward without delay if required. In making the nomination it is suggested that the special difficulties and condition of this Province should be borne in mind.

Your Excellency:

1. As has already been represented in a recent interview between Cav. Camera and Capt William, it is necessary to provide immediately for Vice-Prefects Vicario for the provinces of LUCCA and PIENZA and two Vice-prefects for the province of TERAMO.
2. The Vice-Prefect of LUCCA, Dr. Alpirolo FRANGI, has had to be dismissed on account of his relations with the Fascist Republicans. It is probable that the Vice-Prefect of PIENZA will be dismissed for similar reasons. Nominations for these two posts are therefore urgent.
3. As to TERAMO, both Vice-Prefects are in bad health and appear to be unable to discharge their duties. SCARABUCCI, Dott. Guido, the Vice-Prefect Vicario suffers from liver trouble: he has had one month's special leave and has just been granted a further two months on the report of two doctors. The acting Vice-Prefect Iapettore, DEBOSA, Dott. Mario is a Consigliere di 2^a classe appointed to exercise inspectorial functions by the Prefect. He suffers from eye disease and has been away ill in another commue. It is desired to substitute both these officials as soon as possible, so that the Prefetto Reggente may have adequate assistance.

1. This is to introduce Dr. Silvestro ALBI, who is the nominee of the Italian Government and this Headquarters for the post of Prefect of Pistoia. The candidate provisionally selected was FOTI: but in view of the report which Capt Lewis made by telephone on 24 September as to conditions in Pistoia, it has been thought better to send down one of the best men we have available at present in the person of Dr. ALBI, rather than Dr. FOTI.

2. I enclose copy of Dr. ALBI's record card.

3. The new Prefect at present holds the rank of Vice Prefetto Vicario (Grade V). He should, therefore, be appointed "Prefetto Reggente". A form of order for this purpose is enclosed. His name is however being submitted to the Council of Ministers today for promotion to rank of Prefect (Grade IV). As soon as I hear from the Ministry whether or not this promotion has been approved I will let you know.

4. I gather from Capt Lewis' telephone message that few, if any, officials are to be found in the Prefecture. I imagine therefore that you will be calling upon me soon for a skeleton team. If, however, there are any at the Prefecture whom you could keep, please let me have particulars on them all if and when you do call for any extra personnel. And please have the Prefect do this through the PC and not direct through the Minister of Interior, as so many have done recently, thereby causing confusion and delay as well as derogating from the authority of AMG.

5. Lt Zampaglione, who conducts the new Prefect to Pistoia, carries a copy of this letter and enclosure for the PC.

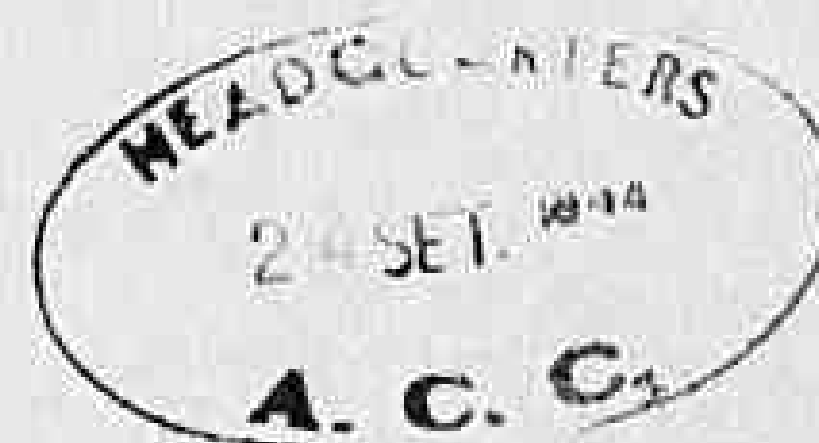

3. This information is drawn from the personnel records of the Ministry and there are two points to be noted about it:
 - a. as the "fascicoli personali" of all these officials were taken away by the Fascist Republicans, the Ministry have no information about the political behaviour of any of these. I must leave that to be enquired into and dealt with on the spot by AEC 5th Army or you.
 - b. For the same reason, the officials mentioned are those who were in office in 1943. We are without information as to what changes may have been made since then.
4. I hope in spite of these defects the information obtained will be of some practical value to you.

In reference to your request in the above-indicated letter, we are forwarding you the pertinent data of the officials of group A and the higher grades of group B working in the Prefecture of Florence Pistoia Lucca and Arezzina.

The information obtained from the documents with the General Direction of Personnel is insufficient in regard to the former political activities of the officials concerned, for the personnel record documents having been sent north. It is not possible to collect and supply more complete and detailed reports on the same.

We point out moreover that the above-mentioned General Direction has had to refer to the situation of the personnel during 1943 in each single Prefecture, having no way to obtaining information of the variations and modification taken place previously.

TO : His Excellency the Minister of the Interior

Your Excellency,

1. I write to confirm the conversation between Cap. William and Dr. Camera which took place at Salerno on 6 July.
2. The Sub-Commission has been warned by AMG to get ready to provide skeleton administration for the provinces of:-

SIENA	APUANIA
LIVORNO	LUCCA
PISA	PISTOIA

3. In view of a report that has just arrived I am writing you a separate letter about SIENA.
4. As to the remaining five provinces, recent experience shows that the possibility must be faced of have to organize complete new teams of senior officials for each of them. The Government is accordingly requested to nominate the required personnel now and to have them ready to proceed to any one of these provinces at 24 hours notice. It can be assumed that a new Prefect will be needed in every case. We must therefore be ready with nominees for all the provinces, from the point of view of the Allied Control Commission, there is no reason why the Prefects already nominated by you for TERNI, ASCOLI, TERAMO and PESCARA should not be considered as available for other provinces, since they have not so far been called upon for these provinces for which they were originally named. The basic idea of having such a list was that would constitute a "pool" from which could be drawn for whatever province might need one.
5. If you agree that Drs. BIANCOROSSO, DONADU, PONTE, and PATERNO are available for the five province now under consideration, I need only ask you for the names of four more Prefects - I say four in order to have some slight reserve for future cases. Otherwise it will be necessary to have eight more names.
6. As to other officials, I presume each team should consist of the following in accordance with your Ministry's advice on previous occasions:-
 - A Vice-Prefect Vicario - or a Consigliere to act as such
 - A Consigliere or Primo Segretario
 - A Ragioniere

Please confirm or otherwise.

7. You have already given me the names of three officials working at the Ministry - Drs. CAPPUCCIO and MUSILLO and Ragioniere GUCCIONE - who can, with a Prefect, form the first team. The necessary investigation are being made as to these. Please let me know as soon as they arrive in Rome and their private addresses in the capital.
8. I understand we should be ready as soon as possible with two other similar teams, consisting of officials actually living or working in Rome. We shall thus be ready to send parties to at least three of the five provinces in question as and when they are called for; and we shall thereby gain a little time in which to organize teams for the remaining two provinces in case of need.
9. Will you please therefore let me have as quickly as possible the names of the six officials required.
10. In all cases - Prefects and others - will you please supply short biographical details, as in previous cases.

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SUBJECT: Italian Provincial Officials
TO : HQ, AGO, Interior Sub-Commission.

1. If operations proceed at the pace which is at present anticipated the problem will very shortly arise of reorganising the Italian Provincial Administration of the thickly populated Provinces which lie ahead.

Attention is drawn to the fact that the four Provincial Capitals of Livorno, Pisa, Lucca and Pistoia, which all lie on approximately the same latitude, are likely to be occupied almost simultaneously, and that the Provincial centre of Aquania is likely to follow a few days later. The fall of Siena can be expected before the end of this month.

2. It is impossible to forecast at this stage how much of the former administration will be found in existence; in the case of Viterbo most officials were found present and to be satisfactory for temporary reappointment, whereas recent experience at Grosseto, where all Provincial Officials has fled, forces us to the conclusion that we must be prepared to face the possibility of having to organise a completely new team of Senior Provincial Officials for all these six Provinces.

3. It is there requested that the Italian Government be directed to nominate now, and have ready on call the necessary personnel, so that there may be the minimum possible delay in restarting the Italian Administration when the Provinces are occupied. We will keep our demands down to the minimum but it can be taken for granted that a new Prefect will be needed in every case.

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4. As has been done ~~hitherto~~, you will be sent information as soon as possible after occupation on the conditions found in the places mentioned above.
