SUBJECT: VOLPES, Vice Prefect, Cosenza

TO : RC, Southern Region

1. Reference your letter R/1054 of 30 September, it would seem to me that our letter ACC/4/1/72/Int of 25 August addressed to RC Region VII has not reached you.
2. As this letter shows, our records contain the following report by Lt Col Nichols, RC Cosenza, stated "Volpes is a weasling and of no use at all. He would not make a satisfactory Prefect." As we base our actions in this Sub-Commission (and indeed our recommendations) very largely on the reports of the PCs and RCs, you will agree that I am placed in a quandary.
3. I have, I think, in my letter of 25 August, of which I am enclosing a copy, more or less reopened the earlier decision, and I should be glad therefore to hear from you as a result of your further consideration.
4. The first para of your letter of 30 September is based on wrong information, since our objection was based not on the state of local government, but on Volpes' personal qualifications arising out of Col Nichols' reports.

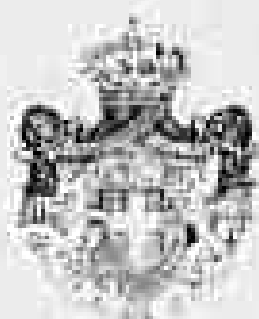

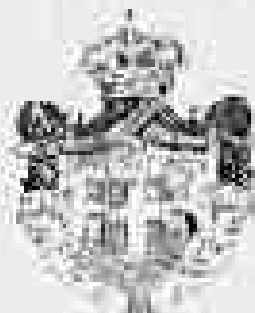

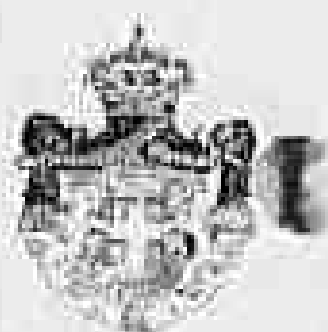

VICE-PREFECT DR. SILONE NAITANA

21 August 1944

In August 1942, Vice-prefect Dr. Simone Naitana was sent on a mission to Nuoro from Messina, where his house was half destroyed by a bomb.

He decided to take his family to Nuoro, after he had found a furnished apartment owned by a Captain who leased it until his discharge.

Said Captain was discharged from service on January last, at the time Dr. Naitana was appointed regent of the Prefecture; therefore he returned the apartment to the owner and occupied the lodging of the Prefecture.

Dr. Naitana at the time the new prefect Dr. Palmanara was appointed, was without lodging and absolutely unable to find another, since, besides the furniture, he needs linen and pottery.

Dr. Naitana would meet the same difficulties should he be transferred to another city as vice-prefect.

We would appreciate if Dr. Naitana is appointed regent of a Prefecture until communications can be established with the city of Savona, where his wife's relatives are living and his other household goods are kept, and where he may certainly find the proper lodging.

SUBJECT: VOLPES - Vice Prefect Cosenza

NO : PC, Region VII

1. Some time ago the Italian Government submitted for approval a number of proposed appointments, transfers and removals of Prefects.
2. The list included the above-named who was proposed for promotion to the rank of Prefect with a view to appointment to Ragusa.
3. In April last the then PC of Cosenza reported VOLPES "to be a weakling and of no use at all", who, he considered, would not make a satisfactory Prefect.
4. I accordingly intimated to the Ministry that I would be unable to recommend approval to the suggested appointment particularly bearing in mind the present difficulties of Sicilian appointments and the necessity for having outstanding administrators there.
5. Another nominee was subsequently submitted and approved for Ragusa.
6. The Minister has recently enquired whether, if a formal application is made, approval would be given to VOLPES's promotion to Prefect with a view to being employed in an Inspectorial capacity working from the Ministry in Rome. They pointed out that he has been long in the service and is due for promotion. Apparently his duties, if promoted, would involve visiting Provinces, inspecting and reporting on matters affecting the Prefectural Administration. Although he would not be a Prefect of a Province, I enquired if his position would not in fact place him in a superior position to the Prefects whose Provinces he visited and apparently this would be the case.
7. I was not prepared to intimate that AOC's approval would be given to such an application, but undertook to reconsider the matter in the light of the present proposal.
8. After all our efforts to assist the Government in building up and strengthening the administration, I do not consider it in their interests

to approve the appointment to senior office of proven weaklings although I am not unkind of the Ministry's shortage of personnel to which they frequently refer.

9. The PO's report however was in April last since when VOLPE has been acting as Prefect following MANCINI's departure. This may have given a further opportunity for you and your officers to assess his capacity and I shall be glad to have your views upon him and his suggested appointment in the before-mentioned capacity.

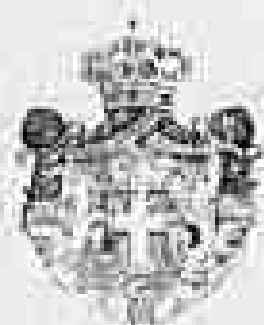

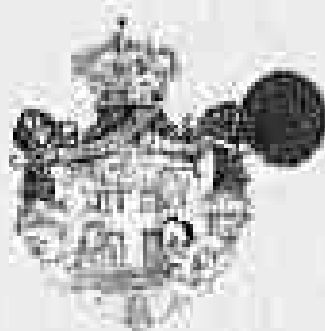

SCIORILLI=BORELLI - I mentioned what is said in the Security report (see file *Port of Prefects*) about the reasons for his dismissal by the Fascists. There seems to be nothing in this, really. Berutti says it was not a banquet: it was a "trebbiatura" - or "harvest bean feast" which was held annually on the property of some landowner near Taranto where S-B was Prefect at the time. It was not especially given for S-B, but he was invited. Then some one wrote an anonymous letter to Mussolini's Cabinet - where S-B had a personal enemy. The result was he was dismissed with every circumstance of publicity as an "example".

Berutti says everybody in Italy knows the story of SCIORILLI=BORELLI's "banquet".

He was afterwards Prefect of CATTARO where resisted the orders of the Germans and was dismissed by them and threatened with the concentration camp. He escaped with great difficulties with the help of his bishop.

Berutti agreed he is a man of marked and somewhat difficult character as stated in the Security report.

He was put in retirement in 1943 because of a scandalous luxurious banquet deemed very out of place in war time.

He is said to have a difficult character, he has not too good a name with his colleagues and dependants.

However he has not carried any fascist honours and never actively participated in the fascist party. He would therefore be acceptable from a security stand-points.

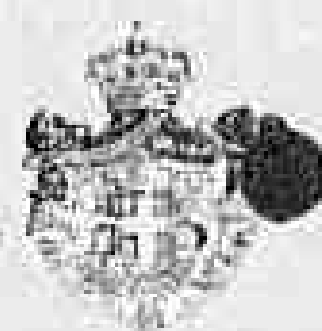

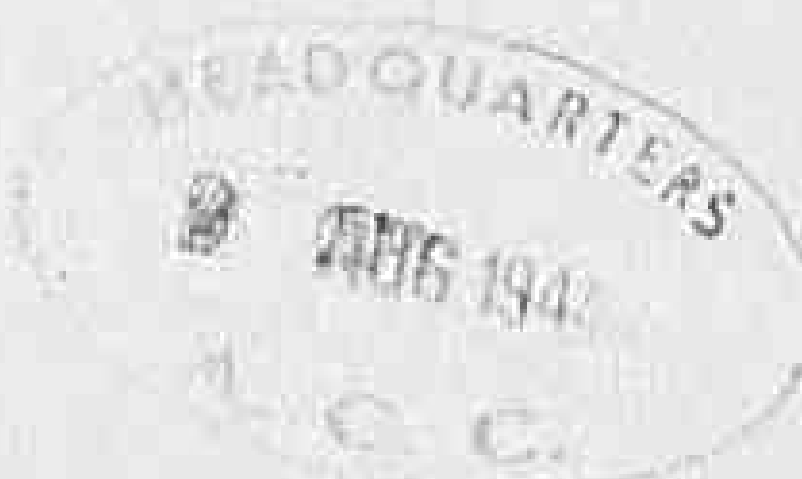

1. I said that letters had been written and were on their way giving ACC approval to appointments of three Directors-General (MANDAMONE, Vicedomini, and VOSSE) and nine Prefects (MOCCI - COZZA - SACCHETTI - ANTONUCCI - MIRAGLIA, Costantino - PALAMARA - GULOTTA - DE SANTIS - and CATENACCI).
2. We then went through all the rest of the Prefect who remained in the pool.
3. Of these there are two included in the list of movement of Prefects submitted for ACC confirmation, see file ACC/4/172/Int at No. 2d - who are supposed to be "collocati a disposizioni in attesa di destinazione" or in other words, to be relieved of their present appointments - whatever they may be - and held temporarily at the Ministry without a job. The two in question are MICALI and PERUZZO.
4. The point at once arises as to why these two names were submitted to ACC for approval at all. It emerged in the conversation that Berutti and Camera considered the Padoglio-MacFarlane correspondence to apply not only to appointments to a post but also to promotions to a rank or grade. I said I could express no opinion about this without instructions and without a careful re-examination of the correspondence; but I would look into the matter on return to my office.
5. In fact the Italian Government went to have MICALI as Secretary-General to the High Commissioner for Refugees. This they have not yet put officially; but I gather the appointment has not yet formally passed the Council of Ministers. The other man, PERUZZO, stands nominated for ARIZZA, a forward province under ALB. They are both Vice-Prefects and for either posts their promotions would be necessary. It is for this reason that they were included in the list of movements.

SCIORILLI-BORILLI - I mentioned what is said in the Security report (see file Fascists. There seems to be nothing in this, really. Barutti says it was not a banquet; it was a "trebbinatura" - or "harvest bean feast" which was held annually on the property of some landowner near Taranto where S-B was Prefect at the time.

It was not especially given for S-B, but he was invited. Then some one wrote an anonymous letter to ~~the~~ Mussolini Cabinet - where S-B had a personal enemy. The result was he was dismissed with every circumstance of publicity as an "example".

8. Berutti says everybody in Italy knows the story of SCIORILLI-ORRILLI's "banquet".

9. He was afterwards Prefect of CATTARO where he resisted the orders of the Germans and was dismissed by them and threatened with the concentration camp. He escaped with great difficulties with the help of the bishop.

10. Berutti agreed he is a man of marked and somewhat difficult character as stated in the Security report.

11. The result is we have hardly anyone left in the pool. It was finally agreed:

a. to have PERUZZO for FISA, as that is the most urgent province.

b. additional names for the pool will become available in a day or two.

12. Berutti said they were going to put forward a number of proposals for promoting Vice-Prefect; and to avoid the VOLPI and RIVELA difficulty, they are going to put them forward and get AGC officers before promotions are decided on by the Council of Ministers.

Notes of interview between Col. M. M. Loria, and Minister of Interior, 20 July 1944.

Minister of Interior, 20 July 1944.

1. Background - Col. Loria explained the interest of the Interior Ministry in this subject which was limited to the problems which arose in dealing with persons after the Allied Forces had passed through liberated areas. Such problems included the following, namely, their absorption into civilian life, arrangements for certain persons to join the regular Italian army or, if required, to continue guerrilla warfare and also the return of others who wanted to go back to their own localities. He stated that these persons must first be dealt with in the areas and by the citizens with representatives of the Guardia Nazionale (or local residents) and representatives of the partisans. He thought the provisions to be issued to return to their own former localities would only be by a/a.

Col. Loria explained that it would be necessary for instructions to be issued to prefects to acquaint them of the arrangements, in order that they could, where necessary, take part therein in the matter in which he explained.

is the document containing such arrangements was issued, he was unable to find the document, but would do so as soon as possible.

Col. Loria explained the view that the problem would be settled gradually for instance, by joining the army or working under the allies as the provisions were liberalized. Col. Loria stated that the plan must be made now.

Col. Loria stated that the arrangements to enable the Ministry to give appropriate instructions to prefects.

He referred to the difficulty of return to agricultural work owing to extremely scarce areas. He inquired if instructions could be issued with instructions to teach them so. Col. Loria said this was to be dealt with by the military authorities.

Col Spiller said he had no objection to that as a rule and was merely concerned with assisting in the execution of the Ministry's policy. He pointed out, however, that in fact Carrozzini's views opposed to those of De Michelis, and De Michelis's and suggested that it would be in the interests of the Government if a close cut policy could be agreed upon.

TO : His Excellency the Minister of Interior

Your Excellency:

1. Thank you for your letter of the 22nd July enclosing a list of proposed appointments and transfers of Prefects which it is understood is submitted to the Allied Control Commission for their approval in accordance with the arrangements made between us for that purpose.
2. It is observed that the list accompanying your letter varies slightly from the list Eccellenza Berruti handed to Lieutenant Lewis on the 21st July. These alterations have been noted. Kindly notify me of the Council's views regarding Speciale in due course.
3. With regard to Li Voti, it will be recalled that he was removed from office on account of his Fascist record and active anti-Ally behavior. I would particularly refer Your Excellency to the letter of the then Minister of Interior dated 16 May, a copy of which I am enclosing, from which I clearly understood that the Ministry had no intention of employing Li Voti.
4. Perhaps ^{therefore} ~~perhaps~~ Your Excellency may wish to reconsider the matter in the light of all the circumstances of the case including the previous correspondence and I shall be glad if you will state whether it is desired to proceed with the application for Li Voti and if so the reasons for so doing.
5. Subject to 3 and 4 above, the nominations are being considered by the Allied Control Commission and I hope to convey an early decision to you to enable these appointments to be filled as soon as possible.

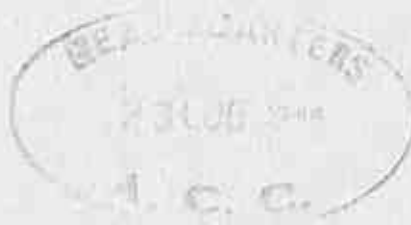
