Acting Director:

1. I mentioned this matter to BERRUTI and CAMERA yesterday evening. I directed attention to the fact that the charges against CIMAGLIA of being "Marcin su Roma" ~~or~~ "squadrista" originated with the CC.RR--see No. 9 on file. We therefore felt that before CIMAGLIA was considered for any post, these charges should be formally disposed of, through the regular channels of epuration proceedings.

2. BERRUTI took the line that it was for the Ministry first to establish whether there was any substance into these charges and to decide whether or not to refer them to the High Commissioner for sanctions against Fascism. Since last writing to us, further inquiries led them to believe there was no substance to the allegations. The Ministry proposed to continue inquiries in order to establish whether there was a case to refer to the High Commissioner.

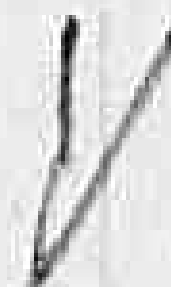

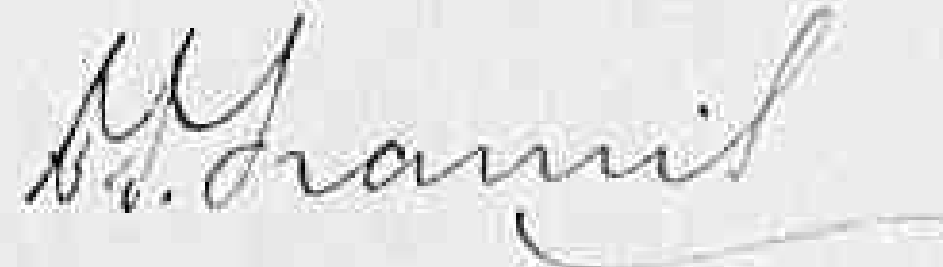

1. I refer to your letter R/3029 of 11 September, particularly to what is said in para 2 thereof as to the above-named.
2. The Minister of the Interior has made inquiries into the allegation that CIMAGLIA held the distinctions of "Marcia su Roma" and "Squadrista" and now writes to state definitely that this official never held these two titles or those of "antemarcia" or "sciarpa littorio".
3. As to his having been a Lieutenant in the DICAT i.e. the Anti-aircraft Militia, this has been referred to the High Commissariat for Sanctions against Fascism. That office has ruled that this does not constitute a ground for commencing epuration proceedings. Indeed, membership of the anti-aircraft Militia, is not, in the absence of special circumstances, regarded by this HQ. as an absolute bar to public employment.
4. In these circumstances the Minister has renewed his request for the approval of this HQ. to the promotion of CIMAGLIA to the rank of Prefect with a view to his appointment to some office. There appears to be no reason now for resisting this on the ground of his fascist past : but I should like to know if you have any further observation on this point.
5. I have also to consider however CIMAGLIA's personal suitability for the office of Prefect. He is not personally known to this Sub-Commission. Would you please institute inquiries and let me have the fullest report you can on this aspect.

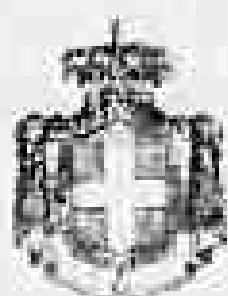

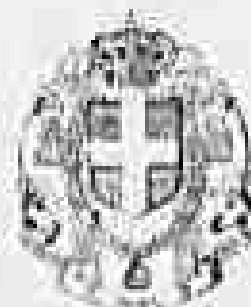

1. Thank you for your letter 1/2004 of 14 August 1944 and the enclosed copy letter dated 10 August from PO Naples.

2. I have noted what the Prefect of Naples has said about the proposed transfer of the above, but what I would like to have is your views, and those of your PO.

3. The movement of personnel is decided by the Minister and it is the Italian practice to handle such matters in a more peremptory fashion than is our custom. Where a Prefect has strong views about a transfer he can, and sometimes does, make representations to the Minister, but this is not usual. You will see at once, I am sure, that I cannot make representation to the Minister against the transfer merely on the basis of the views of one of the Minister's own subordinates the Prefect.

4. Naturally the Prefect would be averse to parting with VARELLI, especially if, as the PO says, he is extremely capable and diligent. And I have no reason to suppose the Minister does not intend to provide a successor for him.

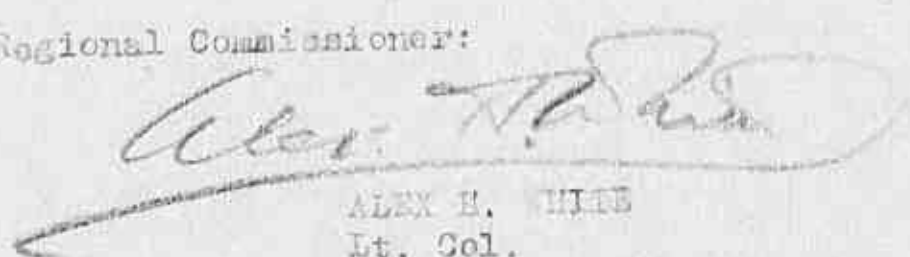
