2. In June last, Dott. GALATA was nominated by the Italian Government and after being screened was appointed by AMG to the vacant position of Prefect of Rieti.
3. He has worked efficiently and energetically and to the complete satisfaction in all respects of AMG. The PC states that the smooth working of the Provincial Administration is in no small measure due to the Prefect's efforts.
4. Recently the Prefect with the PC has been working on the arrangements connected with the establishing in Rieti Province of the RAC T.D with approximately 2000 troops.
5. The Italian Government now intimate in letter 51 that GALATA is to be epurated and they desire to put him "at disposition" (in effect to suspend him) pending the Commission's decision. They further propose to appoint another Prefect in GALATA's place (one VILLASANTA who has been screened). For GALATA's answer see 55.
6. The PC thinks highly of GALATA and is of the opinion that the introduction of a new man with no local knowledge would adversely affect the smooth working of the Administration and in particular the pending and future arrangements with the Military.
7. The situation involves two settled policies, viz:--
 - (a) That epuration and its procedure is entirely a matter for the Italian Government.
 - (b) That no AMG appointed official may be removed without AC consent.
8. If AC cannot question the procedure they will have to consent (actually or tacitly) to suspension for that purpose though they would not agree to removal on grounds of personal record and capabilities.

NOTE OF INTERVIEW - for information - DIRECTOR.

1. Major Crippen Acting PC. of Rieti and GALATA called at this Office.
2. The former stated that GALATA has recently been at the Ministry of Interior where he was informed that he was to be the subject of Spuration proceedings and that the Ministry has applied to ACC with a view to his suspension from office pending the hearing.
3. Major Crippen stated that according to GALATA no reasons for the intended proceedings were given to him and after consideration GALATA was only able to recall one incident occurring in 1937 which might constitute the grounds of the complaint against him. (A note of the incident prepared by GALATA is on this file).
4. Major Crippen recalled that GALATA was nominated by the I. G. and appointed by AMG in June. He reported on GALATA as follows:
 - (a) He has been working energetically, loyally and to the complete satisfaction in all respects of AMG with whom he has cooperated wholeheartedly, (NOTE. - This confirms the good report this Prefect has always received from AMG.)
 - (b) Largely as a result of GALATA's efforts the Provincial administration was running smoothly and was taken over by the I.G. in that state.
 - (c) The R.A.C., T.D., comprising upwards of 2000 troops ^{was} shortly moving in to the Province. The necessary arrangements eg. billeting, requisitioning, firing ranges, price control, evacuation, etc. has already been started by the Prefect in collaboration with ACC. Much more work remained to be done (and continuing).
5. Major Crippen came with the knowledge of Reg. IV. He appreciated the position regarding Spuration where it was necessary and did not desire to disturb proper proceedings. He wished however to state above facts and to express the view that a change of Prefects now and the appointment of a man with no

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5. Major Crippen came with the knowledge of Reg. IV. He appreciated the position regarding Evacuation where it was necessary and did not desire to disturb proper proceedings. He wished however to state above facts and to express the view that a change of Prefects now and the appointment of a man with no local knowledge would impair the efficiency of the administration, particularly with regard to the many arrangements connected with the arrival of the Military.

6. He asked that either

(i) GALATA be not suspended but be permitted to continue until the actual proceedings, or

(ii) the hearing be expedited.

7. Major Crippen was told :

(i) that the removal of an AMG appointee requires ACC's consent and the facts he reported would be borne in mind by ACC when dealing with that aspect of the matter.

(ii) Evacuation was the business of the I.G.

The Commission observes that dott. Agostino GALATA, prefect of career, has been committed to the Commission by the High Commissioner for the application of the disciplinary sanction of exoneration from office, for having had the qualification of officer of the "Milizia".

The Commission considers that the dependence of dott. Galta is absolutely proved, but that, as he did not give any proofs of fascistness, sectarianism or of fascist intemperateness, has decided to take against him a sanction of minor gravity. -

The Commission has decided to apply to dott. Galata Agostino the sanction of censorship. -

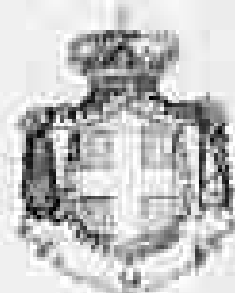

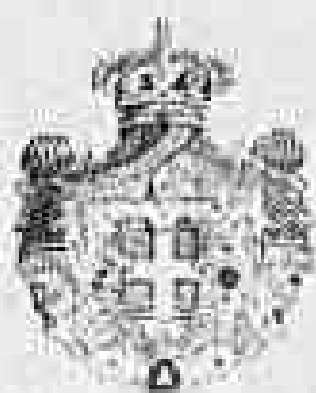

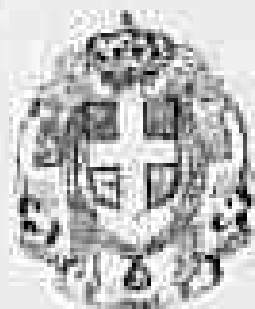

SUBJECT: Prefects for VITERBO, RIETI, TERNI AND PERUGIA

TO : RC, Region IV

1. Capt. C.G.B. Williams has reported upon his conference with you at your advance HQ on the morning of Tuesday, 13 June.
2. I understood you wish this Sub-Commission to be prepared to send forward Prefects for the above-named four provinces and to treat those provinces in the order of priority in which they are named above.
3. Arrangements are being made accordingly with all possible speed. There is, however, great difficulty in arranging transport. The difficulty increases as the army advances, and it will not, in my judgment, be possible to guarantee to move the new Prefects from Naples or Salerno to the HQ of the respective Provincial Commissioners in one day.
4. With the approval of the Executive Commissioners special arrangements have been made for transporting these officials as far as HQ, which I understand from Captain Williams you are establishing in Rome. From Rome onward to the respective Provincial capitals, the Prefects should be moved in transport and available by you (in accordance with Executive Memorandum n. 12 June 12, 1944).
5. I should suggest for your consideration the desirability of making some preparation in advance for lodging the new Prefects in Rome as they will probably arrive in the city too late to be passed on to the Provincial Commissioner's HQ the same day.
6. The new Prefect will be moved forward until receipt of a signal from you or the SCAO that he is actually required. On receipt of such a signal, I will in turn signal to you and the SCAO the date of the new Prefect's arrival in Rome.

1. Captain Temple and I saw Dr. Aldisio Minister of Interior, and Dr. Camera, Chief of Cabinet this morning at 1000 hours on another matter.
