2. Col. Kirkwood told me, after I discussed the matter with him, to drop the matter. He will use the peacetime Italian set-up, i.e. the sindaco of the towns on the island will report to the Prefect who in turn is under direction of the P.C. of Livorno.

3. The office held by MIGLIORINI - "Fiduciario regionale" in a provincial capital - is specified in List B annexed to Exec. Memo 67. The Exec. Memo is by no means clear; but it appears to indicate that if Grosinone Province was still AMG Territory, MIGLIORINI ought to be removed. But the Exec. Memo does not, of course, apply to Ital. Govt Territory.

4. In any case the fact that MIGLIORINI was a "fiduciario regionale" renders him, in my opinion, unacceptable for Elba or for any other office in Ital. Govt. Territory.

The Island together with the rest of the province of LIVORNO has recently been passed to the control of the Regional Commissioner, Region VIII and he will be satisfied to have ELBA administered as part of that province under the normal arrangements.

SUBJECT : Italian Official for the Island of Elba.TO : Vice-President, Administrative Section, Hq. A.C.C.

- 1 Relative to par. 4 under "INTERIOR" of DO 11, dated 14 Sep 44, it is stated therein that "the presence on the Island (Elba) of a direct representative of the Italian Government is necessary and arrangements have been made for the appointment and dispatch of an official." I note that it is contemplated appointing Dott. MIGLIORINI to this position.
- 2 Since the Island of Elba is to come under this Region tomorrow and since I had previously contemplated administering that Island as part of the Province of Livorno, which is the normal arrangement, I would like to be informed more in detail as to the status of Dott. MIGLIORINI.
- 3 If Dott. MIGLIORINI is to be a direct representative of the Italian Government and not under the Prefect of Livorno Province, Hq. ACC. is, in effect, setting up a new Province. This, I do not approve. I have no objection to using Dott. MIGLIORINI, or any competent Italian official, to administer the Island of Elba, provided he is subordinate to the Prefect of Livorno.
- 4 To set up the Island of Elba as an independent entity, separated from the Province of Livorno, introduces problems of administration which can only complicate matters without corresponding benefit. It is not a question of a chief administrative officer only; an independent administration involves a great deal more than that because, if this Italian administrative officer is to be independent of the Prefect, he must have many officials under him such as a Prefect has. He may not need all of them, but he will need many of them.
- 5 I request that the status of the Island of Elba be made clear; and again recommended, as I have in a previous communication to the Executive Commissioner, that this Island be administered as it is normally; that is, as part of the Province of Livorno.

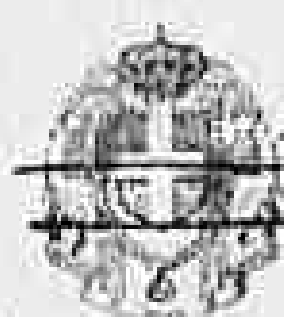

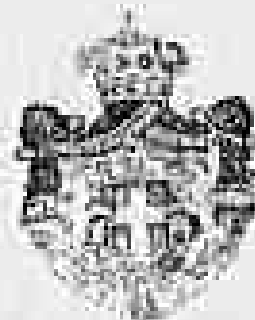

SUBJECT: Transfer of Dr. Migliorini from Frosinone.

TO : Regional Commissioner, Region IV, A.C.C.

1. An unofficial report has reached me that the Italian government is considering the transfer of Dr. Stanislao MIGLIORINI, now Vice Prefetto in Frosinone, to a post in Littoria Province.

2. Inquiry reveals that Dr. MIGLIORINI is not well liked here. Apparently in the months before the end of Fascism, he was a Fiduciario del Gruppo Rionale Fascista "Canelli" in Littoria city. It is probable that it would be a great mistake to transfer him here again and I suggest that a representation be made to A.C.C. and the Italian government to that effect.

PRESENT:

H.E. Comm. 68 ZANFRANCO, Prefect of Grosinone
Col R. G. B. Spicer, Director, Interior
Capt C. G. R. Williams, Asst Executive Officer, Interior
MAG V. Board, Interpreter.

1. Comm. ZANFRANCO called to present his compliments to Colonel Spicer, who complimented him on his administration of the province and the rapidity with which he was reorganising local government. After referring to difficulties which some Prefects were having with the Commissions of Liberation, Colonel Spicer left for the Vice President's Conference at 1600 hours.

2. Captain Williams then consulted H.E. as to the proposal to transfer Dr. Raffaele BOGHIANIGLIO from Grosinone to Viterbo.

3. H.E. said that BOGHIANIGLIO had acted as Capo Gabinetto to ROCHI, who was Prefect of Grosinone under the Fascist-Republican Government; and H.E. thought his position and effectiveness in the province was compromised by that fact. He held nothing against BOGHIANIGLIO personally. The man was definitely not of Fascist leanings or H.E. would have taken stronger actions than merely to have asked his transfer. He is a good and honest official and an excellent worker of whom one ought to be made - but in some other province.

4. H.E. said he made a similar application with regard to his Vice-Prefect Inspector Dott. MIGLIORINI and for similar reasons.

5. Captain Williams said no proposal had been made to the Sub-Commission for Dott. MIGLIORINI, to which H.E. replied that the Ministry had said this morning they had written proposing MIGLIORINI's transfer to Litteria. Evidently the letter has not got through to us yet.

6. With respect to MIGLIORINI, H.E. said that Prefect ROCHI had had disagreements with the Germans and was removed by them. DE MARIA was appointed in his place but he spent most of his time in Rome. The post of Vice-Prefect Vicario was vacant. Therefore the Vice-Prefect Inspector MIGLIORINI had to substitute for the Prefect, thus incurring the odium and responsibility of carrying out German and Fascist Republican orders.

7. H.E. says MIGLIORINI certainly is not a fascist in any way and is an intelligent, hard-working, and efficient functionary. It is simply that in the circumstances he would be better employed in another province.

8. Before leaving, H.E. asked Captain Williams to tell Colonel Spicer that should there be need of a Prefect to rule one of the northern provinces
