1. The Chief Inspector Dr. Mario Morani, has been dismissed from service by the Provincial Agricultural Inspectorate in Naples, depriving him of his salary as from the 1st of February 1944.

2. The provision has been adopted in accordance with the Prefectural circulars of the 21st and 25th of January 1944, because Dr. Morani had acted as Political Secretary of the Comune of Sessa Aurunca from July 1937 to December 1939.

3. The individual in question referring to the Legislative Decree (Luogotenenziale) of the 27.7.44 No. 159, has asked to be re-employed pending decisions which will be adopted concerning him by the Special Commission.

4. The Chief Provincial Inspector in Agriculture at Naples, having regard to the previous excellent professional and disciplinary qualities of Dr. Morani, declares himself in favour of the request. The Ministry follows suit in expressing approval of Dr. Leone's opinion as Inspector General.

5. The above is brought to notice, asking you to examine the possibility of getting the Prefect of Naples to revoke the provision adopted for the official in question.
