Dear Dr. Tasca:

You will recall that Signor Mitti, whom you were kind enough to bring to my office, in the course of his conversation stated that within the past month or two a Prefect for Turin had been nominated by the Italian Government but on his arrival in Turin he was informed by the local CLN that they would not recognize his appointment, that he was told to leave the city without delay, and that he complied.

I took steps to have this report very thoroughly investigated and it is absolutely untrue. The Italian Government has never nominated a candidate for this position and the present acting Prefect was installed by ANG originally.

Unhappily, this type of report, which is clearly based on rumor and not fact, is all too common, as you know, in Italy, but I am disturbed that a man of Signor Mitti's position should assist in circulating such reports without first checking their accuracy.

SUBJECT : Prefect of Turin
TO : Civil Affairs Section

1. Reference is made to Executive Commissioner's office memo. 2802/79/BC of 24 September forwarding Chief Commissioner's memo. of 21 September in which Admiral Stone states that he had been informed the previous day that a Prefect for Turin, nominated within the past month or two by the Italian Government, had been told by the local CLM that they would not recognise his appointment and that he must leave the city at once and that the Prefect complied.
2. The Chief Commissioner directed investigations and this Sub Commission has accordingly made inquiries.
3. The Ministry of the Interior state they have not nominated any Prefect for Turin and remind this Sub Commission that they would not take any initiative of this kind unless requested by this Headquarters.
4. The Provincial Commissioner has no knowledge of such an occurrence; he has interrogated the present Prefect-Agent, the CLM and several Government officials, none of whom have any knowledge of the matter.
5. On 16 September the Ministry of the Interior dispatched at the request of Finance Sub Commission an accounting inspector to investigate the accounts of Turin Prefecture. PO Turin reports that this official received very little co-operation from the Prefecture. It is within the bounds of possibility that this may be the origin of the statements made to the Chief Commissioner.
6. By the above report please be forwarded.

TO : The Minister of the Interior

1. Reference is made to the Ministry's letter No. 5463-1 (Dir. Gen. Personale) of 5 September 1945.

2. ¹² The Regional Commissioner of Piemonte has been consulted and he states that the Prefect of Turin Province objects to loss of any personnel and states that it would be practically impossible to perform the necessary functions with any diminishment of staff. The Regional Commissioner, while agreeing with the Prefect that present circumstances throw a burden on the Prefecture which requires more than the normal personnel, is also in agreement with the Ministry and this Sub Commission in considering that 8 Consiglieri is an excessive number. He considers that the transfer to another seat of at least 2 Consiglieri would be warranted.

3. In letter AC/14/1/114/13 of today's date relating to the excessive number of Consiglieri for Venice Prefecture, this Sub Commission suggested that the Ministry should make the necessary arrangements for the transfer of the excess in correspondence with the Prefect, such correspondence being transmitted through the medium of Allied Military Government and this Headquarters. The Ministry are requested to proceed in the same way with regard to the excessive personnel of Turin Prefecture.

4. It is suggested to the Ministry that such personnel might with advantage be used to fill vacancies in Prefectures not far from Turin, especially Aosta and Asti which are in the same Region.

5. The Regional Commissioner states that at least 2 Consiglieri can be spared, which indicates that it might be possible to arrange for a third to be utilized elsewhere. As the Ministry know, there is a vacancy for a Consigliere in the not far distant Province of Imperia. It is suggested that the Ministry should bear this vacancy particularly in mind in endeavoring to arrange for the necessary transfers.

b. The Accountancy Inspector referred to did come to Turin and stayed about five days. It is reported that he received very little cooperation from the Prefecture as to his inquiries.

SUBJECT: Turin Province--Alleged treatment of Italian official.

TO : RC Piemonte Region (with copy for FC Turin Province).

1. Herewith copy of memorandum addressed by the Chief Commissioner to the Executive Commissioner on 21 September. This Sub-Commission has been directed to investigate the report which the Chief Commissioner mentions.
2. As far as this Sub-Commission is aware, the Prefect of Turin is still Mag. PANSCHI, the GMI nominee. The Italian Government have never, to our knowledge, nominated a candidate for this office.
3. Inquiries have been made of the Chief of Cabinet of the Ministry of the Interior, but he has been unable to throw any light upon the report. He confirms that the Italian Government have never taken and are not now taking any initiative to nominate a Prefect for this province.
4. The Chief of Cabinet did mention, however, that Finance Sub-Commission wrote to the Ministry on 5 September requesting the dispatch of an Accountancy Inspector of the Ministry to investigate the accounts of Turin Prefecture, that Mag. AIRIANO was assigned to this task by the Ministry and that he left for Turin on 18 September. The Chief of Cabinet did not think it likely that this was the official to whom the Chief Commissioner's memorandum refers, as there is a great difference between a Prefect and a simple Ragioniere, but the possibility cannot be excluded.
5. May the report please be investigated locally and your observations furnished to this Sub-Commission as soon as possible.

The report shows that said Prefecture has 2 Vice-Prefects Vicari 10 ff Vice-Prefect Inspector 8 counsellors and 6 secretaries.

This number of officials is exaggerated compared with the actual exigencies of that office. We therefore beg to call your attention back to our letter of the 29th August for we think that the criteria suggested in that letter may be applied also to the Prefecture of Turin, which presents a situation similar to that of the prefecture of Venice.

1. The interview took place at the Prefettura on 21 June. The Provincial Commissioner stated that the CLM was still forming small committees in industries and factories. There was no interference by AMI as it concerned private firms. It was the Provincial Commissioner's opinion that the majority of the people in the province would vote Christian-Democrat if there were a free election held tomorrow. The Communists, however, are the most strongly organized.

2. Although the chairman of the CLM is a member of another party, the Provincial Commissioner says that the Communist member of the CLM is the real leader. The PC made the observation that the Prefect PASSONI, who by profession is an accountant, is anti-Fascist and a very hard worker. He is a member of the Socialist Party and prevented a joiner of the Socialists with the Communists, principally because he is afraid of the Mayor of Torino who is a Communist. The CLM does not control him. He is a capable administrator, but knows little about Italian administrative procedure. The VVF, MARCACINI, is a career official who had been kicked out of office by the Fascists. The VFI is also a career official, while the Capo di Gabinetto is not. Lt. Col. Fiore thought it would be a desirable thing to have an official with VP rank make an economic study of the effective sequestration of private firms on our employment.

3. There is no need for officials to be sent from Rome now as there are sufficiently trained office-holders on the staff of the Prefecture. There is no Deputazione Provinciale established as yet. The Prefect expects to have names submitted by the CLM in a week. I impressed upon him and the PC the necessity of creating this body immediately. Obviously, the four citizen members of the CPA have not been appointed yet. The official members of the CPA are performing the work of that body.

4. The Giunta in the 179 Communes are presently being re-organized on a

Obviously, the four citizen members of the CRA have not been appointed yet. The official members of the CIA are performing the work of that body.

4. The Giunte in the 179 Communes are presently being re-organized on a politically representative basis and should all be approved formally shortly. They are being reduced to the size provided by law.

5. When AMG came into the province, all the Mayors they found in office were Communists and Socialists put in by the CIM. They are being replaced slowly on the advice of the CIM.

6. Career Communal Secretaries are lacking in the province, but all Communes have either a career or non-career person acting in the capacity of Communal Secretary. **35-4**

7. I discussed the organization of local government as provided in ROM 111 and explained the general procedure with regard to the compilation of electoral lists. It was estimated that it might take from 7 to 10 days to distribute the electoral material to all Communes in the province.

8. Conclusion. Although the Provincial Commissioner and the Prefect were confident that there would be no difficulty in having adequate administration, I am not too certain about this myself. While the Prefect knows little about administrative procedure, he is very energetic and seems willing to learn. Further check on this province may be desirable in the future.



1. Reference my conversation with Lt Col Landsill, I have been in touch with the Ministry of Interior regarding the notes on Torino Province and the suggested nominations for official positions.
2. The notes have received the personal attention of H.E. Bonomi, and I enclose a letter over his signature which I have since received.
3. It will be observed that certain alterations have been made to some of the names and the offices for which they were suggested and also that additional names are proposed.
4. In answer to my enquiry, the Ministry state that such alterations or omissions of names is not intended to infer criticism of the persons concerned, of some of whom they have no information. The suggestions the Ministry make are based on knowledge they happen to have of the persons in question and the nominations are made with a view to advising what in Bonomi's opinion would be the best results - both administratively and politically.
5. In any event it will of course be necessary for you to satisfy yourself upon these persons and the enclosure will provide some assistance. If you decide to use the nominees or any of them, you can do so with the knowledge that they are approved by the Italian Government.
