2. Investigations at this Sub Commission have failed to disclose the reason for the return of GUERCIO but it is certain that he must have produced papers to satisfy the officer who issued the authority that it was in order for him to return to Forli'. Unfortunately the officer concerned has been posted to other duties and cannot be contacted for some time.

3. It is thought that he ~~may~~ ^{is} be in possession of a standard Movement Permit authorizing him to proceed to Sicily "on leave". Could this Sub-Commission please be informed what documents are in his possession and what documents he states he produced to the officer who arranged transport for him. *that he intended to his position as such.*

4. The action indicated in para 1 of the letter referred to gives rise to some concern. It is considered that if the evidence of the pro Fascist and pro Nazi connections of GUERCIO were not sufficient to warrant

3. It is thought that he ~~may~~ ^{will} be in possession of a standard Movement Permit authorizing him to proceed to Sicily "on leave". Could this Sub-Commission please be informed what documents are in his possession and what documents he states he produced to the officer who arranged transport for him. *that he is not to be trusted to bring papers from one country to another*

4. The action indicated in para 1 of the letter referred to gives ^{rise} to some concern. It is considered that if the evidence of the pro Fascist and pro Nazi connections of QUERCIO were not sufficient to warrant his arrest it would have been better to have had his case submitted to epuration in the regular way.

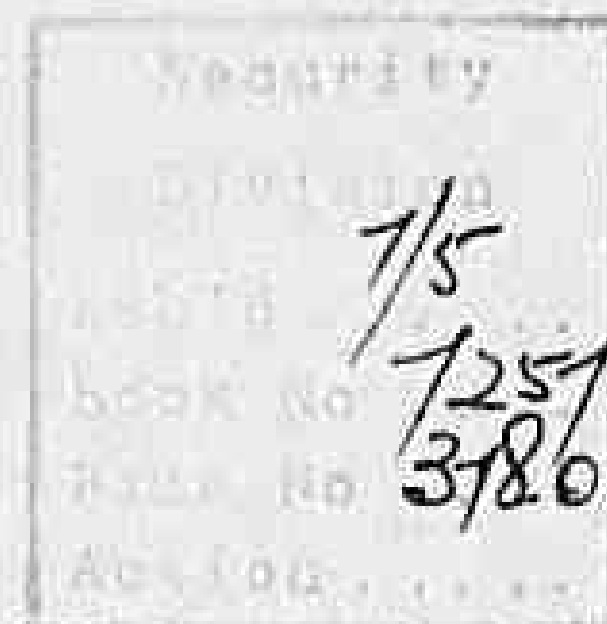

1. The Prefect of this province called to see me on 2 January, and I enclose for your information and that of the PG a copy of my note of interview.
2. You will observe that the Prefect asks for an additional councillor. On looking up my records, however, I observe that the Ministry of Interior has this month recommended for service at Forli, Consigliere MALINVERNO, Dr. Mario, recently discharged from the Army and now resident at Panano di Gradara in Forli province. I enclose copy of the biographical particulars supplied by the Ministry. MALINVERNO has been screened and passed by Security, and I have informed the Ministry that he is acceptable to this HQ.
3. I suggest that the Prefect make contact with Dr. MALINVERNO and direct him to assume service at the Prefecture.
4. It would appear that this appointment will satisfy the Prefect's request for an additional councillor. In any case, however, I should be grateful if I might have in due course a nominal roll of officials at the Prefecture mentioned in para 4 of the enclosed note of interview.

SUBJECT: Note of interview - H. E. TORRICI Antonio - Prefect of Forli. (20)

DATE : 2 January 1945 - 10:30 hours.

1. Col. Spicer being in conference when this Prefect called, he was interviewed by me.
2. The Prefect said he needed an official in Group A--a young Councillor. I asked him if he had mentioned it to the PC. He said no: he would do so in due course, but as he was here he thought he might mention it to us.
3. I said he was quite right and asked him what officials he had at the Prefecture. On the administrative side, he has three councillors (one of them acting as VFW) and one or two junior officials. On the accountancy side, he has a Rag. Capo and sufficient junior staff for present purposes. The inspective functions are discharged by ~~the~~ Rag. Capo.
4. I asked the Prefect to make a list of the staff in Groups A and B actually working at the Prefecture, giving names and rank (noting where they are discharging functions superior to their rank) and to submit this list to the PC with a request to be supplied with an additional councillor; to ask the PC to forward the request to us. In the meantime we would take occasion to mention the matter to the Ministry.
5. I asked what had happened to the former Prefect and Vice Prefect. The Prefect fled to the north. The VFW has been suffering from some form of paralysis for some time, and had retired from service some time before the Allies entered the Province. He thought the VPI had fled ~~also~~.
6. In answer to my questions, the Prefect said he had appointed Sindaci and Giunta Comunali in almost all the communes. The members of the Deputazione Provinciale had been chosen and he was about to sign the decree appointing them.
7. He said the CLN had been dissolved by the 8th Army as soon as they had entered the Province. But there had been people of good sense on it, notably the President, Comm. ANGELETTI, of the Party of Action. ANGELETTI still keeps in touch with the Prefect and has been very useful in the constitution of local bodies. While ANGELETTI has his own ideas, he is always ready to defer to the Prefect's decision.

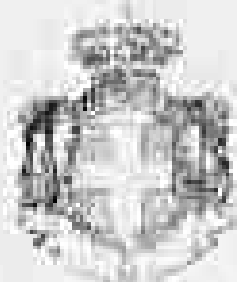

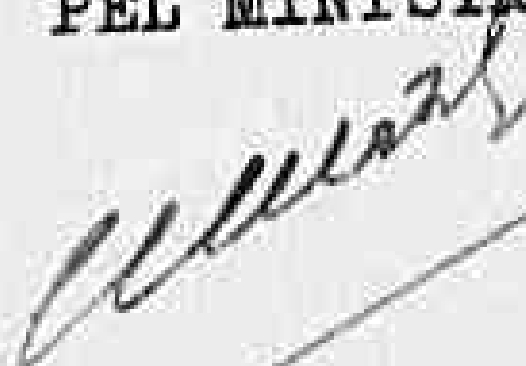

4. Dr. TORTORICI - this functionary is at present of the rank of Vice Prefect, and he should therefore be appointed "Prefetto Reggente" in accordance with form enclosed for him. He is being proposed to the next Council of Ministers for promotion to rank of full Prefect: when his promotion has gone through, I will let you know. A copy of his record card is also enclosed.

1. Reference is made to Interior Sub-Commission letter AOC/16/22/INT dated 9th Sep. 44.

2. It is noted that an official by the name of DE COYZUETA has been annotated for PESARO Province should he be required. This man is well known to the Provincial Commissioner, who considers that he is undoubtedly better than the man he had in mind for Prefetto Reggente, or anyone he is likely to find in the province. Under the circumstances may DE COYZUETA please be sent forward as Prefect of PESARO at the earliest possible opportunity. He should report to the Provincial Commissioner ANCONA/PESARO at ANCONA.

3. It is also noted that three Prefectural nominees have been made for the provinces of RAVENNA, BOLOGNA and FORLI. It is considered that although only a very small portion of FORLI Province has yet been occupied, considerable advantage might be gained if the Provincial Commissioner had the Prefect with him from the start, when visiting the occupied portion of the province, and helping to select Communal and Provincial officials etc. from the beginning. May TORTORICI therefore, please be sent forward to the Provincial Commissioner FORLI at SENAGALLIA (Near ANCONA).

4. If the arrangement for FORLI turns out to be satisfactory, it is probable that the Prefects nominated for RAVENNA and BOLOGNA will be asked for when the Armies reach the Provincial boundaries.

5. May this H.Q. also please be informed whether it is intended that these officials should be nominated as "Prefetto" or "Prefetto Reggente", if and when they take up duty.
