SUBJECT: Interview with Dr. ^{Antonio} Mascolo, Inspector General, Ministry of Interior

DATE : 12 October 1944

1. Dr. MASCOLO informed me that he had had several conversations with Dr. Innocenti, concerning the work which he is undertaking. He indicated that Dr. Innocenti had suggested that he start first with the provinces in Puglia. He said that he understood that his job would be to see that Royal Decree No. 111 was carried out; he would inspect the provincial and communal administrations and report thereon.
2. He said that he would be under the direct control of the Ministry of Interior, and would not be working under Dr. Innocenti; that as a matter of fact he had the same title as the latter. Dr. MASCOLO said that he was 49 years of age and was born in Naples. On September 29 of this year he was raised to the rank of Prefect. Immediately theretofore, he was Vice-Capo di Gabinetto under Berutti. He has been the Chief of Cabinet in many provinces and said he was thoroughly familiar with provincial and communal administration. During World War I, he was an officer and was taken as a prisoner by the Germans. He has many relatives in the United States.
3. Dr. MASCOLO indicated that he was familiar with the contents and spirit of Royal Decree No. 111, and is quite desirous of re-introducing the democratic institutions provided by that Decree. He impressed me as an intelligent person, interested in the job that he is doing, and anxious to carry out the provisions of the Decree. He presents a good, affable appearance.
