TO : The Ministry of the Interior

1. Reference your 1564/1 dated 15th November 1945, this Sub Commission has certain observations to make concerning the proposed transfer of Dott. SAMPORINI.

2. Whilst it is agreed that the Province of Como has too many officials, it is pointed out that certain officials are still required in AMG territory. It seems appropriate, therefore, that officials who are considered surplus in one area of AMG territory should be used to fill vacancies in neighbouring areas of AMG territory - always provided of course that the officials are considered suitable for these vacancies.

3. Moreover, it is noted that Dott. SAMPORINI is responsible, amongst other things, for the electoral service. This fact is stated in the Prefect's report dated 30 October, a copy of which was sent to you with our letter AC/4/1/175/LG dated 20 October last. In view of the particularly heavy commitments of the electoral service at the present time, it would appear that some other official should be selected for transfer.

4. Accordingly we are returning herewith your letter of instructions to the Prefect of Como, and we shall be glad to have your observations on the above.

TO : The Minister of the Interior.

1. Reference is made to the Ministry's letter No. 5000/1 (Dir. Gen. Personale) of 9 August, pointing out that there are six Councillors in office at this Prefecture, which is in excess of the number required to meet the exigencies of the service. For the Ministry's information, there is forwarded herewith a copy of the English translation of a letter addressed to the Provincial Commissioner of Como by the Prefect on 3 October. This Sub Commission is unable to forward the Italian version as only the English translation has been sent.

2. It will be noted that only four of the six Councillors are in effective service at Como, the other 2 being as to one of them on leave and as to the other sick. Nevertheless, it would appear that the remaining four are in excess of the number considered proper at the present time.

3. The Ministry are requested to carry the matter further by direct correspondence with the Prefect of Como, passing such correspondence through Allied Military Government and this Headquarters in the same way as has been suggested in this Sub Commission's letter AC/4/1/111/IG of today's date as to excess personnel at Venice Prefecture.

SUBJECT: Officials of Como Prefecture.

TO : TO Lombardia Region (with copy for IC Como).

1. Reference is made to your R/0522 of 13 October, enclosing a copy in English of the Prefect of Como's letter to the IC of 3 October.

2. The reasons put forward by the Prefect would no doubt have had force before the war, but at the present time they are not apt. It is true that the pre-war organization of a Prefecture provided, as the Prefect states, for a Consigliere and a Secretary at the head of each administrative Division, of which there are normally four.

3. The rule at the present time, however, is as stated in para 6 of this Sub Commission's letter AC/4/1/118/LG of 21 September.

4. It is not reasonable for Como to enjoy a number of Consiglieri in excess of the normal number of 2 when there are other Prefectures which have none at all.

5. Where vacancies exist for officials of the rank of Consigliere and below, the practice is for the Ministry of the Interior to provide for filling these by direct correspondence with the Prefects, such correspondence being passed through AE/AC channels--see CA Section circular AC/4/30/LG of 1 April 1945. It has been decided that the same practice should be applied with respect to the transfer of surplus Consiglieri from one Prefecture to another where there is a vacancy. The Ministry of the Interior have therefore been requested to take the matter up further with the Prefect of Como in this manner. The passage of correspondence through channels gives an opportunity for IC and PC to express any views they may have.

6. It is noted, however, from the Prefect's letter of 3 October to the IC that one of the six Councillors at Como is sick and one other is on leave. A copy of the Prefect's letter has therefore been forwarded to the Ministry so that they may know the actual situation and allow for it.

Upon return from Switzerland, after over a year, Dott. Pizzolo has asked and obtained to leave for his native country down in Sicily, where he will be able to take care of his health. It is considered that he will not return before February next year.

The organization plan of the Prefettura contemplates a councillor and a secretary for each administrative division.

There are no secretaries at all at this Prefettura, except Dott. Fulvio, who is Chief Cabinet. At present, duty councillors are Dott. Rodolfo Saporiti, who, in addition to being in charge of Division 2/2[^] (public welfare and assistance), also follows and directs the very delicate electoral service and military allowances; Dott. Pasquale Cantore, an old official who should retire on account of his age, is in charge of Division 2[^] (Communes); Dott. Concetto Squadrito is in charge of two Divisions (1[^] and 3[^]) and Dott. Giuseppe Salerno supervises the Communal Secretaries' service and Division 4[^] and he is also Commissario Prefettizio at Campione d'Italia.

In view of the above, you will certainly appreciate that the transfer of a councillor to another Prefettura would be detrimental to our service.

1. Reference is made to Regional HQ letter of 17 September and enclosures which are returned herewith.

2. The Prefect's report to the RC of 8 September does not deal with the question raised in this Sub Commission's letter of 15 August and merely confuses the situation.

3. The Ministry of the Interior, in their letter of 9 August (copy to you with this Sub Commission's letter above-mentioned), refer only to Councillors of Prefecture. As you know, these are permanent civil servants belonging to the administrative branch of the Ministry of the Interior, and can be either First Class Councillors (Grade VII) or Second Class Councillors (Grade VIII). Councillors of one or other of these grades are stated by the Ministry to be now serving at Como Prefecture as follows:--

4. This statement agrees entirely with the names of the Councillors given in the table of Prefectural officials forwarded to this Sub Commission through you by the Deputy RC on 8 August.

5. In his report of 8 September, the Prefect says nothing about any of the above-named officials and indeed does not refer to Councillors of Prefecture at all. Instead he refers to 6 judicial officials with whom this Sub Commission is not concerned and as to whom no question was raised.

6. On the face of it, it appears evident that Como is over-staffed with Councillors of Prefecture and that at least 3, if not 4, of them should be transferred to other provinces which are under-staffed. The long-standing agreement between this HQ and the Italian Government is that no province (except a few of the very largest) can be permitted more than 2 Councillors at the present time, in view of the extreme shortage of this class of official. Before any decision is taken, however, it is naturally desired to know whether AG know of any special

I would point out that the transfer of councillors, who are in office at the Local Judiciary Offices, to Judiciary Offices of other Towns is a matter which does not concern the Prefettura but the Ministry of Grace and Justice.

Actually, there are only three councillors (Messrs. Giordano, Moe' and Vasquez) who have been attached to the local Questura to assist in expediting the numerous cases still pending. One of these councillors (Moe') is on the point of returning to his own office.

Having requested the Questura if they were in a position of releasing said councillors, the reply was that it is absolutely necessary that the councillors remain with the Questura where they are performing their duties with the required capability and speediness.

Other three councillors of the Pretura and Court (Messrs. Massarelli, Grassella, Di Nunno) have been assigned to the local Court of Assise and I believe that they cannot be released from their work there.

Though it is not up to me to express an opinion in this matter, it is my impression, however, that the requested transfer to Imperia it not possible.

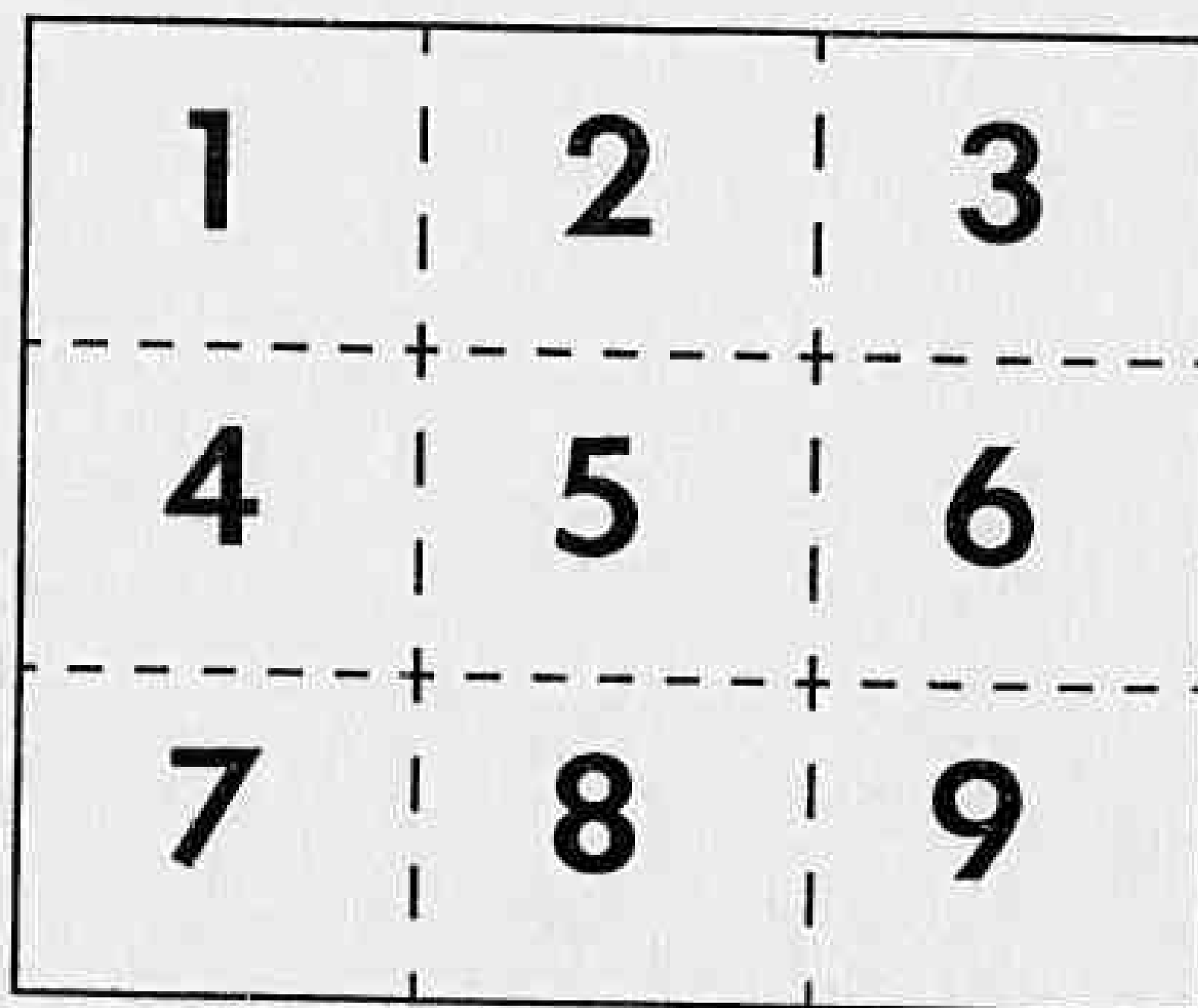
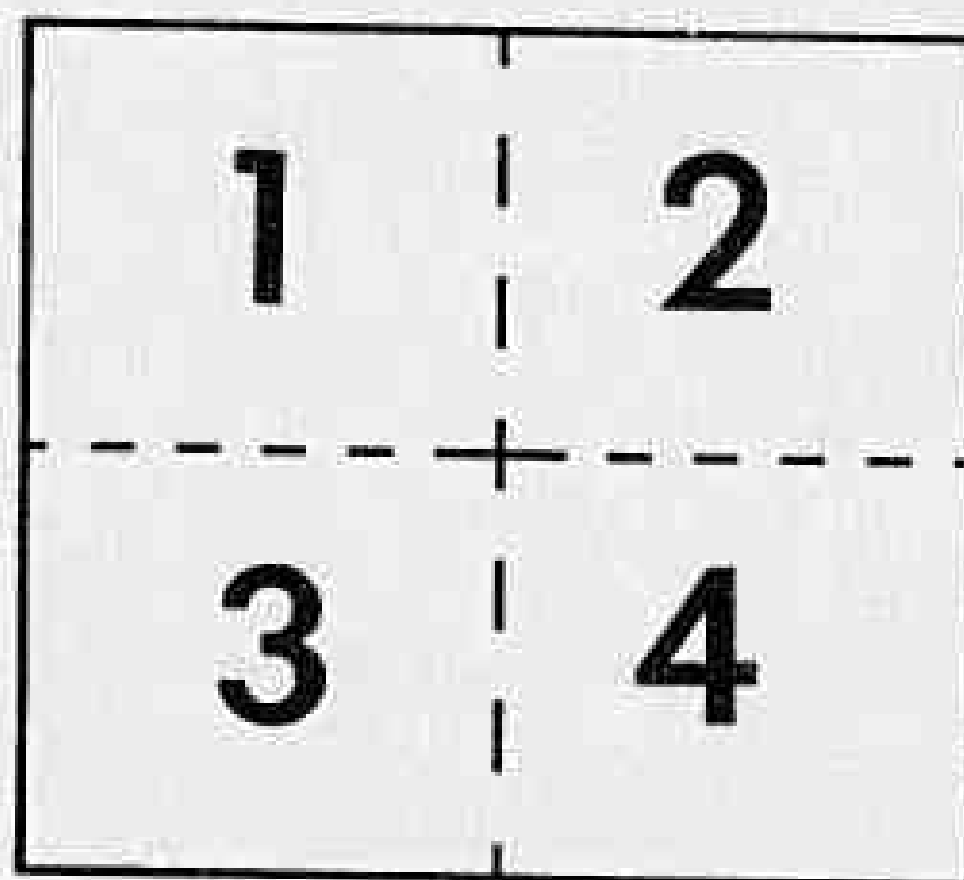
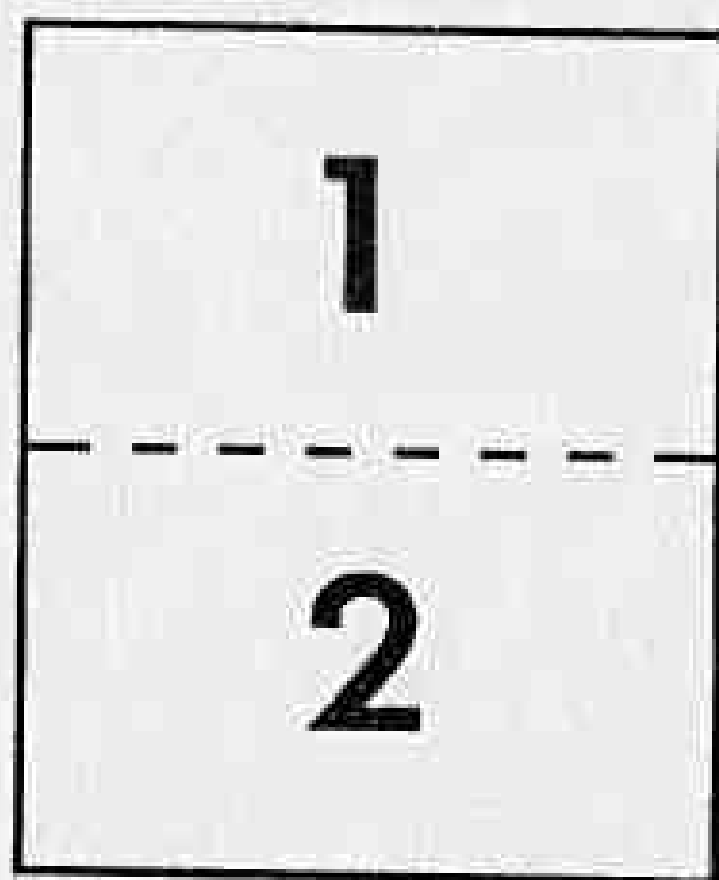
