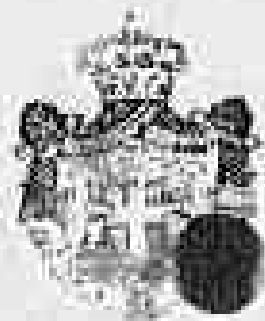

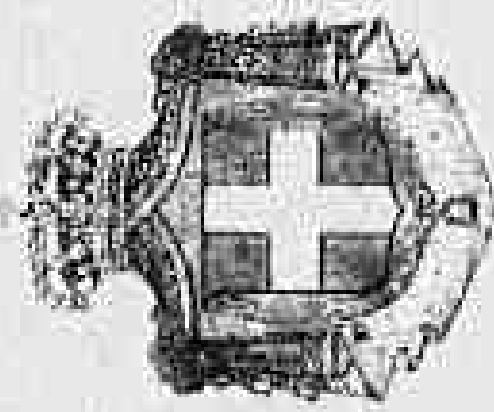

1. Reference is made to your 2 letters RXII/025.111 of 10 and 12 September. For your information, there are enclosed 2 copies of the note of an interview which took place yesterday on this subject between this Sub Commission and the Vice Chief of Cabinet, Ministry of the Interior. In intimating to the Vice Chief of Cabinet that AMG could not possibly in the circumstances reinstate Dott. PUXEDDU, it is thought that your views have been correctly interpreted: would you please concur?

2. With reference to the third paragraph of your letter of 12 September, you will observe from the interview note that the facts as to the specific case of PUXEDDU have been brought to the attention of the Ministry. As to the general question of CHI-dominated Prefects, this point is covered by Civil Affairs Section letter to you, reference AC/4/7/IG, dated 6 September.

PRESENT: Dott. PINI, Vice Chief of Cabinet, Ministry of the Interior
Major C. G. R. Williams, Executive Officer, Local Government S/C
Sig. Arrigo NICE, interpreting.

1. Dott. PINI said that he had been directed by the Minister of the Interior, Professor PAPPI, to see the S/C with regard to our recent request that the Ministry have ready the name of a career Prefect to replace PUXEDDU at Rovigo.
2. Dott. PINI said the Minister had already heard that PUXEDDU had been suspended and he had understood that it was due to some irregularities in connection with food supplies. The Minister thought, however, that a ~~suspension~~ short would be a sufficient punishment and he would like us to consider the reinstatement of PUXEDDU as Prefect of Rovigo.
3. Major Williams stated he would like Dott. PINI to be informed of what the RC had reported about this Prefect. RC has stated that PUXEDDU had "shown himself quite incapable of appreciating the responsibility of his high rank". Major Williams also quoted the specific instances of irregularities and direct disobedience to AMG orders, which are specified in RCs letters of 10 and 12 September, folios 25 and 26.
4. Major Williams pointed out that it was evident from RC's letters that these were not isolated instances. This sort of conduct had been going on for some time: the RC and RC had been very patient, but they had now concluded that it was impossible for the province to be properly administered with PUXEDDU as Prefect.
5. Major Williams also pointed out that AMG was not interested in punishing the Italian official. Discipline was a matter for the Italian Government. This has always been the attitude taken by AC. What AMG was interested in was the efficient administration of the province and in having officials who could be trusted to obey orders.
6. In these circumstances, Major Williams did not see how this HQ could request the RC to reinstate the Prefect.
7. Dott. PINI said that the Minister was not aware of the full story which had just been told him. He would report back to the Minister, after which he would telephone this office as to the position.

1. On the 10th September under reference RXII/025.111 I wrote to you reporting my decision in respect of the Prefect of Rovigo. Since then I have received a deputation from the Comitato Liberazione Nazionale of Rovigo who have handed me a promemoria, copy of which I attach. — No attachment Rec'd m/c

2. In my view the promemoria is an accurate reflection of the whole system of thought which lead up to the dismissal of the Prefect. Dott. Puxeddu, being a locally appointed man and a practicing lawyer whose livelihood depends on his retaining the goodwill of the neighborhood, was unable to resist pressure from fellow members of the C.L.N. and from the countryside. Therefore, he sought local popularity at the expense of the good of Italy as a whole. In at least one incident, the sale of 200 quintals of damaged sugar to a clothing firm in Ferrara, he connived at even worse irregularities. It is clear that we are confronted with one of the obvious difficulties arising out of local C.L.N. nominations.

3. In view of the near approach of the end of A.M.G. rule, I would be glad if you would bring these matters to the attention of the Italian Government. My own view point, which I explained quite clearly to the C.L.N., was that I did not consider it consistent with my duty to pass on to the Italian Government a Prefect in whom I have lost confidence. 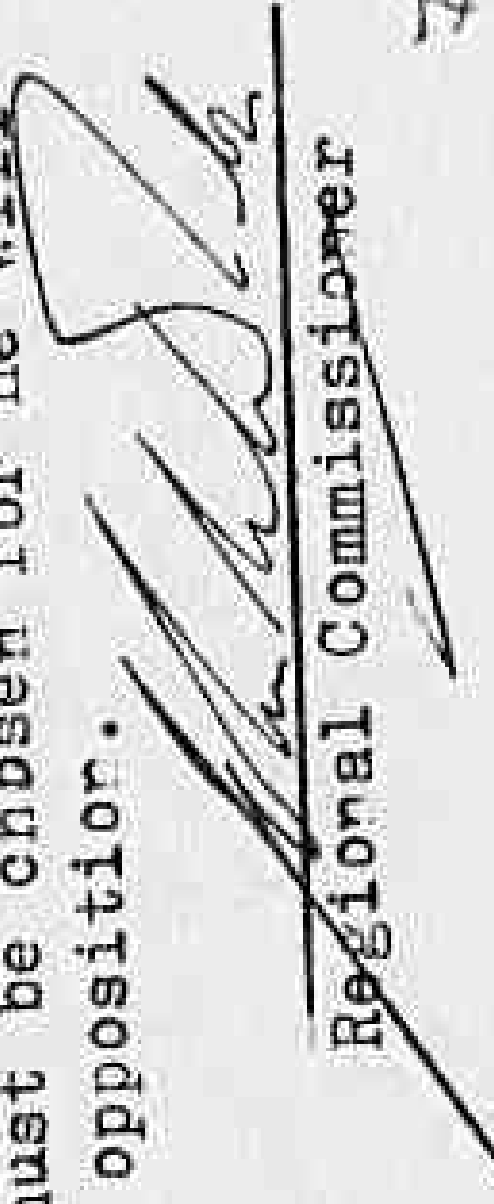
3. In view of the near approach of the end of A.M.G. rule, I would be glad if you would bring these matters to the attention of the Italian Government. I added that it would have been quite easy for me to have shut my eyes to the state of affairs in Rovigo and to have allowed the Italian Government to wrestle with the problem. I did not, however, propose to take that course.

4. I believe it to be the intention of the C.L.N. to acquiesce in some temporary appointment with a view to securing the reappointment of Dott. Puxeddu after the termination of A.M.G.

5. In my opinion if the Italian Government in Rome wishes to avert the chaos which would be caused by Provincial autonomy, they must be prepared to take steps in extreme cases like this present.

6. While I have said to the members of the C.L.N. that I would be prepared to consider another local nominee, I believe it would be much better if we could put in a career Prefect, but this must be done and the Prefect must be installed before 30 September. Moreover, a strong man must be chosen for he will undoubtedly have to deal with local opposition.

1. I regret to inform you that I have considered it necessary to suspend from the appointment of Prefect, Dottore Foxeddu Luigi Francesco, the Prefect Regent of Rovigo. This official has shown himself quite incapable of appreciating the responsibility of his high rank. It is likely that you have already received reports of his arbitrary action in refusing to allow produce to leave Rovigo without bartered goods in exchange. The Provincial Commissioner for Rovigo, Lt. Col. Graham, has done his best to keep Dott. Foxeddu on the right lines. The final piece of irresponsibility was the distribution by the Prefect of 1250 grams of sugar per head of population within the Province of Rovigo in direct contravention of instructions from this Headquarters and from the Provincial Commissioner and to the serious prejudice of Allied Commission plans for equitable distribution in northern Italy.

2. I have instructed the Provincial Commissioner to examine the possibility of finding a good local candidate. If this is not possible I shall recommend to you to apply to the Italian Government for the nomination of a career Prefect. The present Vice-Prefect, Dott. Crecleni, Amato, is a very capable official with 34 years experience and can well carry on as a temporary measure. The fact that he served as Vice-Prefect during the Republican Fascist Regime renders him unpopular locally.

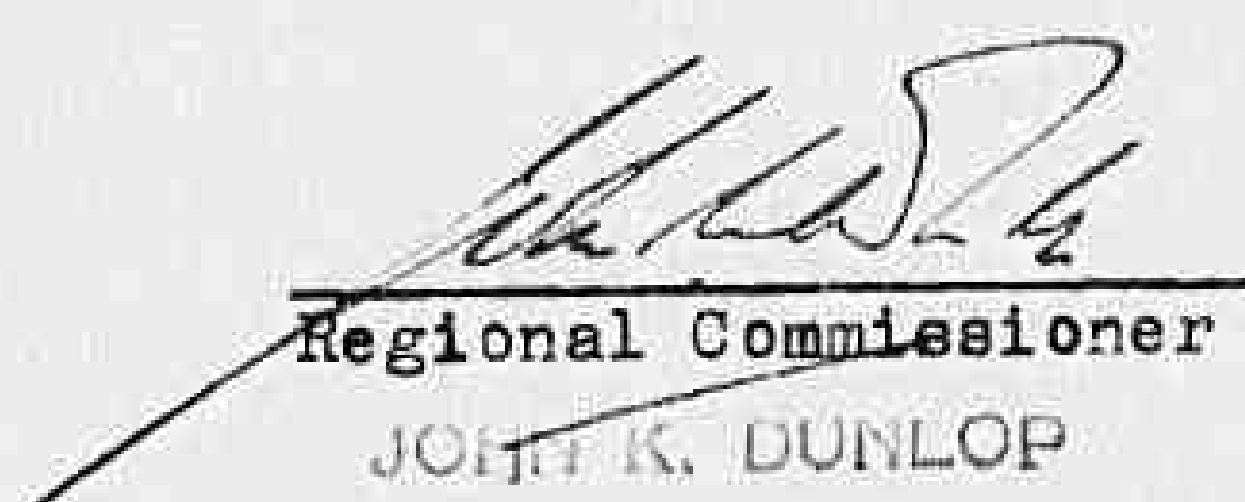

As requested I have investigated the two names which you have given to me in the letter from Allied Commission of 8 August 45 Ref.AC/4/1/178/LG.

Councillor Dott. RUSSO Giulio is reported on by CLN, the Prefettura and the Questura and condensing the information the following is stated : This man is said to have been very easy in giving jobs to people, but it is not known whether he had personal interest in such matters or just ordinary human feelings. He served as secretary of Cabinet of the Ministry of Interior some time ago. He was the Prefettura Councillor of Bolzano from 18/7/40 until 9/9/43 and left after the German occupation and it is not known what he did thereafter. The Questura has no charges against him.

As to Councillor Dott.Biagio PALERMO there is very little information available except that he was known to be a good man, there are no charges against him. He was Prefettura Councillor from 6/10/40 up till the time of German occupation.-

 - a) Dante Carbone was inscribed in the Fascist Party in January 1925;

Major Temple pointed out that local government conditions in the northern provinces were somewhat delicate at present and it was our policy to send to the North only those Prefects who were known to be good and to have irreproachable records. 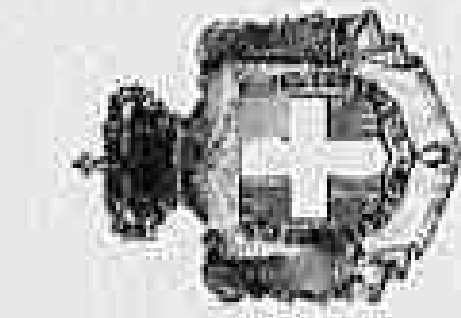

Thereafter on the 24 th of April I went to the Prefettura for a leave of 15 days which I requested on the 19 th of April, accompanying my request with a letter from the Podestà.

While I was at Costermano (Verona) for my vacation, on the 9 th May 1945, after a confused and hastened interrogatory examination I was sent to the prison of Verona, where I am at present, although I have stated that I never carried out violent actions during my permanence in the party and that I never took part in operations against the partisans.

Therefore I ask the Ministry of the Interior to be released on a conditional discharge, in order that I may resume my office, pending proper Court action which I shall face in due time by order of higher Authorities.

5. The Consigliere Arvini has not yet been appointed. The Prefect has all the nominations and only waits the official name of the Communist Party's nominee. I urged the utmost dispatch in getting this body going.
6. In consequence of the absence of a Deputation, no elective members have been appointed to the C.R.A. I pointed out to the Prefect that the C.R.A. was not legally constituted and could not function without them.
7. The material for the electoral lists had been distributed to all communes about 7 days before my first visit.
8. There is up Tribunal at Novigo; its Casellario is in order. Pretori are in office in the up up. There will have to be 6-9 (the Prefect was not sure of the figures) Electoral Sub Commissions as well as the 4 Commissions.
9. The Prefect (a Liberal, in a word: he was a substitute procuratore del Regno. The RC is satisfied with him. It was evident that on questions of local Government and electoral lists, the Vice Prefect Vicario is the "live wire".
10. The office of Vice Prefect Inspector is vacant. There is I Consigliere and no other Group A personnel. The position has been made up to some extent by recruiting non-career men, particularly up. He has been in charge of the Ufficio A people.
11. The Regionaria is adequately staffed in spite of the up of Vice-Consigliere up to be up (abinetto and Vice has entire hand to the RC's office.
12. The Prefect has asked through channels for a Segretario from Ravenna, who he knows wants to move to Novigo. I think this may work, as "Averna" is fairly well staffed, comparatively speaking. The important thing is to fill the post of Vice Prefect Inspector. I advised the Prefect to put up a letter to the Ministry through channels in the usual way and I said I would also mention the matter 5770 on my return.

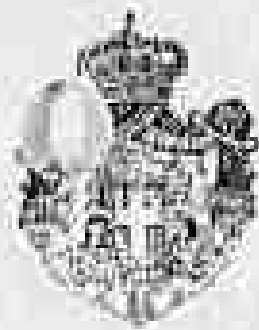

SUBJECT : Prefectural appointments in northern provinces. 15 May 1945

TO : Vice President Civil Affairs Section.

1. To date we have received scanty information as to the actual appointments of Prefects in the northern provinces. We have been officially informed that only one Prefect has been formally installed, to wit Dott. Gianguido BORGHESE-Socialist-Province of Bologna-- CLN nominee. We have also been informed that in the province of Ferrara the head of the Provincial CLN, who himself is non-political and named HIESCH Renato has been appointed Acting Prefect temporarily pending the selection of a permanent Prefect.

2. In two cases, the CLN nominee is also the Government's candidate and, therefore, the possibility of them being appointed is very good. These are Sig. AVANZINI Ennio-Christian-Democrat-Province of Mantova, and Sig. DEL GIUDICE Pietro - Socialist - Province of Apuania.

3. We have received a signal from Brigadier Dunlop that he expects to appoint the following persons, all of whom are CLN Nominees: it can be taken, therefore, that they have been appointed by now, since we have replied to the signal that the RC has full authority to make appointments after consideration of the Government's candidates. These persons are:

4. We have received information as to the names of CLN nominees for other provinces and have given this data to the Ministry of the Interior for any observations they might have concerning the persons. Of the 19 names of CLN nominees, only one was known to H. E. BERRUPI, who characterized him as a good man. This person was Avv. GIACCHERO--Christian--Democrat--Province of Asti. As stated before, the candidates for the provinces of Mantova and Apuania were also the Government's choices. 5760

For your further information, you might be interested to know that BEPRUTI expressed very much surprise when we conveyed to him the information that MICHELI had refused to take the post of Prefect of Parma. He said he would investigate the situation. This Sub Commission has received no formal communication about this matter.

For ROVIGO Avv. LUIGI FUXEDDE Aged 40 years Liberal Party nominated by CLN well reported by Lt Col GRAHAM Provincial Commissioner

For PADOVA AA GAVINO SABADIN, Christian Democrat, formerly Presidente of CLN for whole Compartimento, appears outstanding character.

For TREVISO Avv RAMAZINI Partito D'Azione, nominated by CLN, well reported by Lt Col PRICE Provincial Commissioner. Assume that 5th Army have reported to you in respect of VICENZA Avv. GIURIOLO Partito D'Azione and VERONA GIOVANNI UBERTI Christian Democrat. Will report shortly in respect of BELLUNO Dott ANTONIO DAZZI Christian Democrat. In general am convinced that any attempt to impose imported career Prefects from the south would be a political blunder on part of ROME Government. Am considerably impressed with standing and outlook of CLN nominees in VENEZIE. This view shared by Air Commodore BENSON Colonel SOUTHERLAND and my Provincial Commissioner. Further points for your consideration, ROME nominee for TREVISO Dott SIMONE NAITAN well known to Lt Col PRICE and for shorter period to self in SARDINIA, not considered strong candidate. Dott SILVESTRO ALES known to Lt Col MC BRATNEY not considered strong candidate. Dott GIOVANNI PALAMARA and Dott ITALO NORMILE said to be of FOGGIA and BENEVENTO have only held these offices few weeks.
