1. The PC Major Lewis W. MCINTYRE had not returned from Venice and the Executive Officer had returned to England for release from the Army. 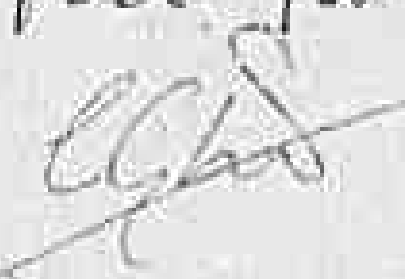
1. PARENTI produced the list (at fo. 718E) of officials available to North as Vice Prefects.
2. We observed that the first name on the list was OMEDIO-SALE, as to whom we had long ago informed the Ministry that he was not acceptable to the Allied Commission in any capacity.
3. We also observed that 7 officials were marked "soltanto giurato". He explained that this meant that the only charge of Fascism against them was that they had taken the oath to the Republican Government, and that they had not yet passed through operation. I said that under no circumstances could we accept any official who had not undergone due process of operation.
4. I observed that there were a number of new names on the list we had never heard of before, and I should have to look into it and reply to the Ministry in writing as to who was acceptable or not.
5. He then referred to the discussion on Friday last, 25 May, and to the agreement reached with Dott. CAMERA that all officials liable to serve in the North should be warned in advance of their liability, so that they could make their excuses now. He said the Ministry had overruled Dott. CAMERA and agreed with his view and did not propose to warn people in this way. I said I had written a letter to the Ministry on 26 May summarizing the results of this discussion and referring to the proposal of warning officials in advance. If the Ministry were now unwilling to do this, I must have that in writing. He agreed to send the letter.
6. Ferrara. Dott. COCCIA would be in Rome on Friday, 1 June, ready to go North. He has been informed of the new grant of 20,000 lire. (Note: Obviously his plea of illness was a lie.)
7. Piacenza. D'ERRICO has plead illness after being informed of the grant of 20,000 lire. The Ministry will give us another nomination tomorrow.
8. Bologna. I said we telegraphed PC Ancona to facilitate this official's journey to Bologna direct. PC, however, had telephoned today (Major Maunders - Capt. Lewis, to say that MOLLO had just been given 15 days leave to go to Udine on private affairs. As to this, see file 4/1/97 fo. 145. As there is no signal communication with Venetia Region and 7821 very improbable MOLLO would leave Udine before his private affairs are completed, no matter how imperative his orders, we said it seemed better to make another nomination. PARENTI agreed and promised to give another nomination tomorrow.

9. Imperia. PARENTI said the Ministry's nomination for this post was FERRI, Dott. Bruno, now Consigliere 1^o classe at Benevento. After some discussion, we accepted him and he said he would be in Rome ready to go on Friday, 1 June.

10. Before agreeing to FERRI, however, we pointed out again that obviously the idea of a "pool" was not working. In this case, for one of the chief vacancies in the North, the Ministry nominated an official quite unknown to us, for whom we have no biographical particulars, and who is not in Rome. & who is now suggested for the "pool" for the first time.

1. Major Williams explained that the S/C had suggested this meeting because, as a result of recent dealings with the Ministry for filling vacancies recently notified from the North (Ferrara, Bologna and Piacenza), there appeared to be some misunderstanding as to the way in which the "pool" system should be operated. The pool of Vice Prefects, for instance, consisted of a certain number already in Rome and others holding office in the provinces. It was the intention of the S/C that nominations for the North should be made from those in Rome--that then the Ministry could call up a Vice Prefect from the provinces to take the place in Rome of the official sent North--that thus a certain number of officials would always be maintained present in Rome and ready to go. This procedure had been explained to the Ministry several times in the "planning" stage and we thought it had been fully understood and agreed. However, for the 3 vacancies mentioned above, the Ministry had nominated officials holding office in the provinces of Naples, Foggia and Ancona.
2. We gave the Ministry officials the names of those Vice Prefects who, according to our records and previous correspondence with the Ministry, should be held in Rome available to be sent North. As to two of them--SPASIANO and VINCENTI--it appeared from what the officials said that the Ministry had never intended these two to be available for the North. Dott. CAMERA said these had only been notified us in order to get the views of the Allied Commission before they were promoted.
3. A discussion ensued as to how far AC was interested in promotions, Dott. CAMERA quoting correspondence from Salerno last June, which clearly related primarily to appointments. We pointed out that this was completely out of date and that on numerous occasions in the last six or eight months we had told the Ministry verbally and in writing that AC were not concerned with promotions as such but only with certain appointments. Since the MacMillan memorandum, we were only concerned with appointments in AMG Territory. There was, therefore, no point in notifying us of any intended promotion if the individual concerned was not to be given an appointment in AMG Territory. Conversely, the notification by the Ministry of an intended promotion was naturally assumed in this S/C to indicate that the official in question was available for the North.

4. It appears that there are only 4 Vice Prefects in the "pool" who are actually in Rome, and these the Ministry are reluctant to spare. There are also 3 Rag. Capi in the "pool" and in Rome who could be given inspective functions. In the course of the discussion, it was evident that the Ministry are now attaching primary importance to the officials' own wishes, and is seeking to recommend to us only those whom they know to have expressed a desire to go North, irrespective of their availability or of the speed with which they can be got to Rome and away to their new province.
5. Major Temple said the time had come to speak quite frankly with the Ministry. The S/C had given frequent assurance to officers and administrators of AMG that if they required career officials to fill vacancies in their Prefectures, the S/C could and would supply them. Interminable delays have been experienced in filling such vacancies during the past winter and autumn: it looked as if similar delays were going to be experienced this summer. ROs and FCs wanted their vacancies filled promptly. If they could not be filled promptly, it would be better for the administration to forget about obtaining officials from Rome and to do the best they could with local talent. The S/C could not allow indefinitely ROs and FCs to be under the impression that their demands for personnel could be filled promptly if such in fact is not the case. Unless we could feel more certain than we do at present that demands would be filled more promptly, we should have to notify ROs and FCs of the true position and advise them to appoint local men rather than apply to us.
6. Dott. CAMERA raised the question of AMG dismissals, saying that a number of officials were suspended by AMG when there was very little against them, and if only these could be available to the Ministry, they could meet demands much better. We refused to be diverted by this "red herring". We referred to the experience of filling vacancies in Toscana, Umbria, Marche and Abruzzi during last autumn and winter. In no case had the Ministry been unable to nominate a candidate: sometimes they had nominated two or three in succession. It was the excuses offered by the nominees (mainly sickness) which caused the delay—not the inability of the Ministry to furnish names because of the large number of AMG suspensions.
7. H. E. MICALI said that a decision had been taken the previous day in the Ministry to offer a grant of 20,000 lire to all officials nominated for AMG provinces to cover their expenses of moving, finding a new house, etc.: they hoped this would diminish the number of excuses offered. As to the three particular vacancies now to be filled, the Ministry made the following suggestions:
7. Ferrara. Dott. COCCIA, the Ministry's nominee and who had plead sickness, would be notified by telephone or telegraph through the Prefect of Naples that if he did not present himself at once, severe measures would be taken. If a satisfactory answer was not received by Monday, 28 May, the Ministry would make another nomination. (NOTE: PARENTI told us on Monday, 28 May, that this had been done and that COCCIA would be in Rome by 1 June: obviously the 20,000 lire has worked.

8. Bologna. The Ministry would telephone or telegraph the Prefect of Ancona to send Dott. MOLLO across to Bologna direct to act as Vice Prefect Inspector. We on our part would communicate with FO Ancona to facilitate MOLLO's journey. (NOTE: We signaled FO accordingly, who telephoned on 28 May that MOLLO had been given 14 days to go to Udine on private affairs. In the absence of signal communication with Udine and as an Italian official is unlikely to leave his private affairs uncompleted no matter what orders he gets, we decided to drop MOLLO and ask the Ministry for another nomination.

9. Piacenza. The Ministry would notify D'ERRICO by telephone or telegraph through the Prefect of Foggia of his appointment to Piacenza, of the grant of 20,000 lire and that he must present himself to Rome at once or severe measures would be taken. PARENTI told us on 28 May that this had been done and that D'ERRICO alleged he was sick. The grant has not worked in this case. We have asked for another nomination.

10. We said that we would agree to the proposals outlined in paras 7, 8 and 9 above. We did so reluctantly and only because that seemed to be the quickest way of getting anything done.

11. The Ministry officials said they would let us have at once a list of officials available to be sent to the North as Vice Prefects, distinguishing those in Rome from those now in the provinces.

4. Bologna. Dott. MOLLO is acceptable to the Allied Commission for the post of Vice Prefect Inspector of Bologna. It was agreed that the Ministry would telegraph or telephone the Prefect of Ancona to inform Dott. MOLLO of his transfer, that he must report himself direct to Bologna as soon as possible and that he would receive the grant of 20,000 lire. This Sub Commission on their part would communicate with the Provincial Commissioner of Ancona to facilitate Dott. MOLLO's journey by all means in his power: this has been done.
5. Piacenza. The officials of the Ministry undertook to send a letter to the Sub Commission confirming that Dott. D'AMRICO is not subject to epuration proceedings. Subject to this, he is acceptable to the Allied Commission for the post of Vice Prefect Inspector of Piacenza. It was agreed that the Ministry would telegraph or telephone the Prefect of Foggia to inform Dott. D'AMRICO of his transfer, that he must report himself to Rome immediately and that he would receive the grant of 20,000 lire.
6. In order to prevent delays in any future cases which may arise, the Ministry will send to the Sub Commission a list of the officials pre-
