SUBJECT : Report of interview with H.E. Avv. Vittorio PELLIZZI - Prefetto
Reggente of Reggio Emilia - on 19 June 1945

TO : Director, Local Government Sub Commission

FROM : Captain W.I. CUNNINGHAM

1. The Prefect did not talk very much. He gives the impression that he is willing to let you talk as much as you like while he listens. He appears to be a strong man and seems to have a good knowledge of the details of his Prefettura.

2. V.P.V. Dott. Domenico MORILLI is clear as far as epuration is concerned but the Prefect said he was not a good man "either materially or politically". He is a career official grade V who was retired by the fascists and brought back to office after the liberation. He knows the law and administration well. The Prefect would like a VPV to replace him but will keep him until a replacement arrives.

3. V.P.I. Dott. Alfonso EXCELLI will be subject to epuration. The Prefect doesn't think much of him as a man and says he was a corrupt official. He is good at his work however and the Prefect will try to keep him until a substitute can be found. I explained the difficulty of finding suitable officials to the Prefect.

4. Consiglieri. There are two. Dott. Giulio BIANCHI - I' Consigliere who is acting as Capo Gabinetto. He is good. Dott. Ernesto PACHER I Consigliere is only moderate. The Prefect would like two more Consiglieri. I told him that I was doubtful if the Ministry could supply any more, but explained the correct method of application.

5. Secretaries - There are two - The Prefect would like one more.

6. Deputazione Provinciale is nominated and is working well. The members were all arrived at in agreement with CLN. They are quite good and do a lot of work.

7. Giunta Provinciale Amministrativa - Has been appointed but hasn't met yet. The first meeting will be held this week.

8. Giunta Comunale. Exist in all Communes and are functioning. Some are good and some are bad. The Giunta Comunale in Reggio is the only one which has been regularly appointed and the Prefect is examining all the others. They are willing but for the most part ignorant.

9. Sindaci are in all Communes. They are willing but not very good as they are mostly labourers without any education. The majority were communist nominees.

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9. Sindaci are in all Communes. They are willing but not very good as they are mostly labourers without any education. The majority were communist nominees. They are not confirmed in office yet as better men are being sought.

10. Segretario - The Prefect thought 27 or 28 were career officials. Some are looking after 2 or 3 communes with avventizi to assist. It is not easy to get temporary clerks as the pay is only 2,000 lire per month and no one wants to work for that. He was in favour of holding examinations.

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11. Epuration - The Commission is functioning - The Prefect doesn't think many of the Local Government officials will be dismissed as the badly compromised ones have already gone.

12. Electoral Lista - The commencement of work on these would be a good

SUBJECT: Interview with Lt. Col. I. de L. Radice, PC Reggio Emilia, 19 June 1945

TO : Director, Local Government Sub Commission

FROM : Captain W. I. Cunningham.

1. Prefetto Reimonte Avv. Vittorio REIMONTE had been President of the local CIN. He was playing a double game and making the CIN promises in meetings with them which he blamed AMG for not being able to carry out. However, he was quite a good man and the PC could rely on his cooperation for all major causes. It was probably only in minor matters that he favoured the CIN, probably to support his own position.

2. VPI. Dott. Domenico MORELLI had been found in Reggio. He had been retired for 10 years and re-appointed by AMG. He was all right and no replacement was required.

3. VPI. Dott. Alfonso MORELLI had remained at the Prefecture. He would probably be epurated but PC hadn't as yet asked for another VPI as he knew they were difficult to get. He would, however, like a good man to replace MORELLI. I told the PC of our difficulties in getting good officials.

4. Other Officials. No requirements. I told the PC of AG/4/30/14 of 1st April 1945, in case any officials should be required later.

5. Deputazione Provinciale was functioning well. They had a particularly good President who was the nominee of the Demo-Christian party. Did not spend too much time on politics.

6. GPA was formed and had started functioning.

7. Giunte Comunali. Were in all Communes. The only one confirmed in office was that of Reggio. The others would not be confirmed until it was seen how they behaved.

8. Sindaci. The remarks in para 7 apply here too. Sindaci were functioning according to their ability and political colour.

9. Segretario Comunale. There were several missing but others were "doubling up" and covering the Communes. He thought that examinations would be a good thing.

10. CIN. The PC had had some clashes with the CIN. The last over 14 days ago when they attempted to tax people enormous sums for "reconstruction". That had been nipped in the bud by a notice in the local newspaper and the position made perfectly clear that the CIN had behaved correctly.

He was playing a double game and making the CIN promises in meetings with them which he blamed AMG for not being able to carry out. 2. VPI. Dott. Domenico MURILLI had been found in Reggio. He had been retired for 10 years and re-appointed by AMG. He was all right and no replacement was required.
3. VPI. Dott. Alfonso MURILLI had remained at the Prefecture. He would probably be epurated but PC hadn't as yet asked for another VPI as he knew they were difficult to get. He would, however, like a good man to replace MURILLI. I told the PC of our difficulties in getting good officials.
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10. CIN. The PC had had some clashes with the CIN. The last over 14 days ago when they attempted to tax people enormous sums for "reconstruction". That had been nipped in the bud by a notice in the local newspaper and the position made perfectly clear to a meeting of the CIN. Since then the Provincial CIN had behaved correctly. Some of the small Communal CINs were uncontrollable. It would require many more CAOs to visit the communes constantly to rectify this. He had 2 CAOs and ~~5~~ 3 more!
11. Epuration. The Commission was appointed but was not very good. Separate Commissions to deal with various types of people would probably be better. A separate one was being appointed for school teachers.
12. Voters Lists. We discussed this question and the PC thought the work could be carried out all right with existing machinery. He will assist where possible.
13. The PC did not commit himself on the question of handover to the Italian Government. The time would depend entirely on the political situation and how soon things became stabilized in the North.
