The Sindaco of Palestrina is a declared Communist and the absolute
despot of the place together with about other 100 people - the only
communists in a population of about 20,000 souls.

He makes a continuous propaganda against the Allies saying that the
only help that Italy can hope for will come from Russia.

The population is in a very uneasy situation because of the abuse
of powers and everybody wishes that the said Sindaco be dismissed.

Agosta the 30th Sept. 1945

To: Headquarters Allied Commission.

Mr. Oliverini Salvatore writes a complaint saying that the Comune of Agosta is administrated by a Sindaco, Sig. Biagio Stassini, who was secretary of the republican fascist party and member of the local Direttorio Fascista. He is a most dishonest despot. For example he would not give salt to people who were not members of the republican party.

The Communal Board is formed of other undesirable people:

- 1 Eusepi Francesco , ex-fascist.
- 2 Proietti Umberto , ex-milite (member of the fascist militia).
- 3 TOMEI Domenico " " " " "
- 4 Cesare Massimo , ex-member of the Local Direttorio Fascista.
- 5 Stazi Giuseppe , ex-milite
- 6 Massini Venicio , ex-segretario politico of the Fascist party.

They are all most dishonest and disloyal people and the population is tired of being still under fascist slavery.
