SUBJECT: Italian officials.

TO : Regional Commissioner, Rome Region.

1. Information has been received that the questore of Rome, who remained in office until shortly before the Allied occupation, is now to be found at Bagnoregio (Viterbo Province). It is thought unlikely that he can make his escape for the present as he is suffering from a broken pelvis as the result of an accident in the course of his flight northwards.

2. Further information should be sought and any action which may be thought appropriate should be taken through the Provincial Commissioner, Viterbo Province.

TO : SACO US 5th Army

I am sending you the information we have been able to obtain at the request of Lt Colonel Rowell.

In considering and evaluating the enclosures the following points should be borne in mind:-

Time:-

- (i) that a short time was available for the compilation of the list.

Source of information:-

- (ii) the sources of information have proved limited and as mentioned to Lt Colonel Rowell there may be other sources to which we have not had access.

Reliability of information:-

- (iii) The persons giving the information have been away from the scene for a considerable time. Whilst they seemed genuine in every respect we have not had sufficient dealings with them to say definitely that their observations can be regarded as both completely reliable and accurate. I might point out that the Government concedes that the information when checked in Rome may reveal a different picture in many respects. Further, screening of names is essential, obviously for those now in Rome.

In conclusion the enclosures are the best that could be compiled in the time and subject to the above circumstances. If, however, I can be of any further assistance I am at your disposal.

TO : SCAO, AMG, 5th Army

DATE : 26th May 1944

1. During interviews with me and my staff officers, Lt Col Rowell on your behalf, requested this Sub-Commission to take the following

action:-

- (i) to arrange for the checking of a list prepared by Lt Col Rowell of Chief Administrative Officials in Rome City and Province (from City Governor down to and including certain senior Provincial Officials).
- (ii) to ascertain, if possible, whether such list (prepared from records) is accurate and as far as practicable to have it brought up to date with a view to AMG knowing the persons they might expect to find in office.
- (iii) to obtain any available information on the party history and ability of office holders.
- (iv) to request the Italian Government:-
 - (a) to submit for consideration the names of 2-3 persons for possible appointment to each of the following positions:-

Governor of Rome
Two Vice Governors
General Secretary, and
 - (b) to provide officials who could, if required, proceed at short notice to take over vacant offices.
- (v) To obtain the views of the Minister of Interior Or
 - (a, certain persons mentioned by Lt Col Rowell, and
 - (b) on the Rome Committee of Liberation.

- (C) (i) List of Officials nominated by Italian Government.
(ii) Information thereon.
- (D) Notes of Dott. Speciale with additional information regarding Delegations together with map.
- (2) Short autobiographical notes on persons providing information.

MINISTER OF INTERIOR

3. The Minister of the Interior was contacted and the contents of para 1(i) - (v) conveyed to him. He was interested and co-operative. During interviews he intimated that the Italian Government and its officials had little or no up to date detailed information. He undertook to contact certain persons who had escaped from Rome.

4. The persons who finally provided the detailed information are:

The three above-named mentioned the following difficulties in dealing with the list:-

- (i) That Tipaldi, the most up to date had not been in Rome since January 1944.
- (ii) That changes may and in some instances had taken place since then.
- (iii) That Tipaldi's knowledge primarily related to more or less officials only.
