TO : His Excellency the Minister of the Interior.

Your Excellency,

1. I refer to the Ministry's letter No. 5000 (Dir. Gen. Personale) dated 20 December, 1944.

2. Inquiries have been made and it has been ascertained that on 1 September last Dott. TRIA was expelled from the 8th Army area by order of 8th Army Field Security Service. It does not appear that he was ordered to reside in any particular place. On the other hand, the order of expulsion from 8th Army area does not appear to have been revoked.

3. He was expelled for cooperation with the Germans, as is shown by the facts that (a) he held the office of Commissario Prefettizio of Serrungarina Comune from October 1943 to May 1944 and from 15th July to 30th August, 1944, and (b) he was Chief of the Liaison Office at Pesaro between the Fascist Republican Government and German Headquarters in that town. For this latter purpose, he held a pass issued by the German "Platzkommandantur" of Pesaro.

4. In the circumstances, the Allied Commission would not view with favour the re-employment of Dott. TRIA in any capacity.

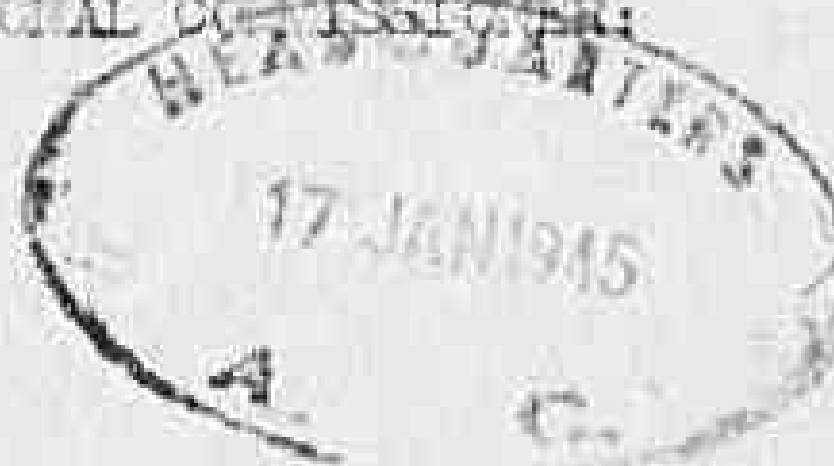

1. Herewith copies in English and Italian of the Ministry of Interior's letter No. 5000 (Dir. Gen. Personale) dated 23 December 1944, relating to the above-mentioned official.

2. I do not understand the Ministry's reference to 8 Army having expelled Dott. TRIA from Pesaro province and ordered him to reside near Salerno. This does not appear to be the kind of action that would be taken by any Allied Military formation: it sounds more like an act of the local Italian authorities, possibly the police.

3. I should be grateful for any information you can give me about Dott. TRIA, and in particular if any disciplinary action was taken against him by either Allied or Italian authority, I should be glad to know the grounds of it.

4. I am sending a copy of this letter to AHD 8 Army in case they have any information.

SUBJECT : - Appointment of Italian officials
in Military Government Territory.

18 November 1944

TO : - His Excellency the Minister of the Interior

Your Excellency :

1. Recent letters addressed by the Dir. Gen. of Personnel to this Sub-Commission as to the movement of Italian officials to Provinces under Allied Military Government have suggested the desirability of reaching an agreement with the Ministry as to some of the principles which should govern the cooperation between the Ministry and the Sub Commission in these matters. One of my officers accordingly visited H. E. MICALI on the morning of 16 November for this purpose; and I write in order to place on record the arrangements which were then made.
2. First, the Ministry have recently proposed the transfer of some subordinate officials for family or economic reasons. Much as I sympathise with the personal difficulties of Italian officials in these days, I do not consider that we can carry out movements in Provinces under Allied Military Government on such grounds alone. The shortage of personnel to handle such movements - in the Ministry as well as in this Commission - and the extreme difficulty of finding transport make it imperative to confine personnel movements to minima.
3. It was accordingly agreed that no movements of Italian officials would be made unless they are absolutely necessary for the purpose of good administration.
4. Secondly, reference was made to the practice of many Prefects in Military Government Territory in addressing their requests as to personnel to the Ministry direct. This practice merely causes additional confusion and delay. It is essential that Prefects address such requests to their Provincial Commissioner. Dr. MICALI was accordingly asked : -
 - (a) to return all such written communications to the Prefect in question with a request that the communications be sent to the Provincial Commissioner; and
 - (b) to inform any Prefect who submits such a request personally and verbally to him at the Ministry that he must submit it to the Provincial Commissioner.
5. If the procedure described above is strictly followed, much time and correspondence will be saved and this Sub Commission will be in a position to

- 2 -

inform the Ministry in each case of the views of AMG officers as well as of the Prefect. Accordingly, it will not be necessary for the Ministry to make any proposal as to the official personnel of Provinces under AMG, except in reply to a communication of this Sub Commission. H. E. MICALI was therefore requested thirdly to refrain from making any proposals for such movements unless and until this Sub Commission asks for a nomination or requests the opinion of the Ministry upon a proposed movement.

6. Will you please have all officials at the Ministry who deal with the movement of personnel informed of these principles so that they may be strictly adhered to. Much delay will thus be avoided in re-establishing the administration of recently liberated Provinces.

7. The foregoing only applies to movement to or from or within Military Government Territory. In Italian Government Territory this Sub Commission is not concerned with the movement of any except Prefects and Vice Prefects. And in those cases we are only concerned to approve the nominations; the use of military transport does not enter the question.

TO : His Excellency the Minister of Interior

Your Excellency:

1. I refer to Captain Williams' conversation on this subject with your Chief of Cabinet and Gen. Camera on 26 September.
2. The teams of officials for newly liberated provinces have become much depleted owing to the calls made for such officials recently and owing to the assignment of certain of the officials for service with the Ministry. On the other hand it is likely that as the armies proceed further north, less and less reliable officials will be found available for the prefectures.
3. I consider therefore that we ought to proceed immediately with the constitution of three new teams each consisting of the Vice Prefect, a Consigliere, 2 Segretari, and a Ragioniere.
4. I should be glad if you will submit names accordingly, with the usual biographical particulars as soon as possible.
5. I would ask that once an official has been agreed between us for service in a northern province, he should not be used for employment with the Government here in Rome, from which he could not be spared, without first letting me know. Otherwise I naturally assume that such an official is available whereas, in fact, he would not be.

I return, duly completed, the record form sent me with the letter of 24th inst. No. 5000.

Regarding the declaration concerning my membership in the militia. I wish to point that as I had to go to Bologna, as chief of cabinet in 1939 under prefect Benigni, who in his former Palermo Office was appointed senior of the militia, I also was pressed to accept the appointment of centurione in the squads (being already a complementary port captain on leave).

In view of the desirability of the moment and the particular circumstances in which all officials were forced to live and which unfortunately, as everyone knows, were often the determining and compelling factors in all their decisions, I did not see that I could refuse.

I never placed any trust whatsoever in this appointment - known only to very few - and of which I did not even notify your Ministry, one of the reasons being that the particular office duties of which I was always in charge in the prefecture, permitted me to avoid with ease any kind of activities pertaining to that appointments.

The Ministry is aware of the progressive steps of the 18 years of my career, which I have reached through work, free of all exhibitory manifestations, exclusively dedicated to carrying out the tasks entrusted me in the important offices to

- 2 -

which I have been assigned and where I have always enjoyed the complete trust of my superiors as well as the respect and regard of the social circles with which I have come into contacts with no political distinction whatsoever, for reasons pertaining to my office.

As may be easily inferred from my registered activities and from the testimonies of my superiors in the Personnel Office of the Ministry, I have never drawn any profit or advantage in my career from fascist merits which I have not had, and much less from having attained, for a brief period, the position of officer of the militia in the manner and for the reasons described above.

It is needless to add further comments to the declarations contained in the record card I return attached, I trust the high sense of justice of those who shall judge today my past work and in waiting I rest assured.

And lastly I would like to ask your Ministry to kindly let me hear personally when my position will be examined so that I can give whatever further explanations are necessary and in particular to report my activities during the stay at Rome after the 6th September 1943, as a secret member of the clandestine committee of resistance.

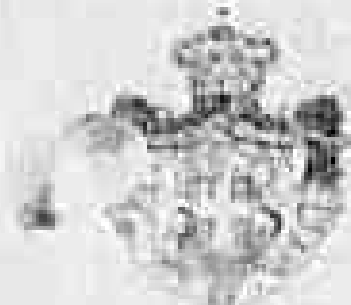

SUBJECT: Teams of officials for forward provinces

TO : His Excellency the Minister of Interior

Your Excellency:

1. I have been considering the constitution of these teams which by agreement between us are wanted to go forward and undertake the administration of newly liberated provinces.
2. We have agreed that such a team should consist of four officials:- a Prefect, a Vice-Prefect, a Consigliere or Segretario, and a Ragioniere.
3. On more than one occasion, AMG of the Armies has suggested that the provision of an official to act as Capo Gabinetto is desirable.
4. I appreciate that this appointment is one for the Prefect to make personally, that it is usually held by a Consigliere and that the Consigliere or Segretario who is one of the members of the team of 4 could quite properly act in the capacity of Capo Gabinetto if the Prefect desires him to. Nevertheless, I have come to the conclusion that the suggestion of Army AMG ought to be accepted and that an additional Consigliere or Segretario ought to be included in future teams, raising the number of officials in each from 4 to 5. The Prefect will then have some freedom of choice. 543
5. In the case of the 3 teams which we are now forming, therefore, please let me have the names and usual particulars of 3 additional Consiglieri or Segretari. Please have them fill up Scheda Personali and forward them to me with the other particulars.
6. This letter is in confirmation of yesterday's conversation between Comm CAMERA and Capt. Williams.

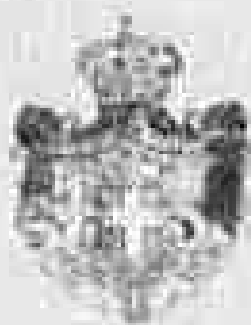

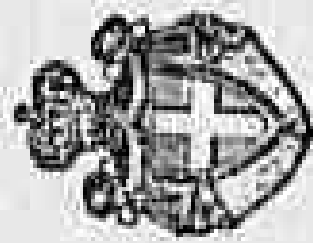

SUBJECT: Italian officials in forward area

TO : His Excellency Dr. I. Soboul, Minister of Interior

Your Excellency:

1. I thank you for your letter no. 4250 of 28th June and the enclosed lists of administrative and accountancy officials.
2. This was the subject of a discussion this morning between Mr. Gamba and Captain Williams of this Sub-Commission.
3. As was explained to Dr. Gamba, I consider it of the highest importance that the small number of Italian officials able to constitute a "skeleton team" for the administration of a prefecture should be assembled and ready to move forward at the shortest possible notice. If the assembly of the team is left until after AKE calls for them, many days are wasted in getting them together and in the meantime the newly liberated province is without the experts it needs.
4. I am advised by Mr. Gamba that such a team should consist of: -
 - A Prefect
 - A Vice-Prefect (or a Councillor of Prefecture with the functioning of Vice-Prefect)
 - A Councillor or Secretary of Prefecture
 - An Accountant.
 This is the constitution of the team at present being assembled for the province of Grosseto.
5. The Prefect would, of course, be chosen from the list of Prefects living in Rome with which you have supplied me, and will be sent forward from the capital city. The other three officials should be assembled here in Salerno now and be warned to be ready to set out at a few hours' notice.
6. In order to facilitate the assembly, it is suggested that the three officials in question should be chosen from among those in the Ministry at Salerno, as they will thus already be here and will not have to be fetched from remote provinces. When the demand comes for them and they are sent off, other three officials to take their place at the Ministry can be called for from the provinces. The three so called for would not only enter the service of the Ministry, but would also constitute a second team and be warned to be ready to set out should they be required.
7. If necessary, this process would be repeated.

8. In accordance with arrangements made this morning with Dr. Casara, I await the names of the three officials in the service of the Ministry whom you would suggest to form the first team. I understand I may expect to receive these on Monday next, 3 July.

SUBJECT: Provision of Italian Officials in Forward Areas.

TO : Regional Commissioners,
Regions I, II, III, VI and VII.

1. Organisation of the forward areas is a more difficult task than the administration of an already organised back area and calls for active, forceful and efficient Italian officials capable of putting up with a certain amount of hardship.
2. Regional Commissioners may be inclined to object to the release of such individuals who are chosen to go forward on the grounds that they are indispensable and necessary to the Region concerned.
3. The release of such men to forward areas will throw more work on the remaining, probably less highly skilled, officials.
4. It must, however, be recognised that when moving forward and taking over new Provinces and cities, good men are essential.
5. Regional Commissioners should release officials asked for unless there is some special reason making it imperative that a particular official should be retained. There should not be many cases like this. Where they occur a full report should be submitted with the minimum of delay.

- 1 From time to time INTERCOM is requested to find Italian officials for forward areas. (AMC 8 Army OM/72 of 27 May addressed COM, copy to you, is a case in point).
- 2 Organisation of a front area is naturally a more difficult task than administering an already organised back area and calls for active, forceful and efficient officials capable of putting up with a certain amount of hardship.
- 3 It is found that Regional officers are prone to object to releasing individuals selected on grounds of efficiency, indispensability etc.
- 4 It is submitted that on the grounds of overall efficiency, back areas must be prepared to release officials particularly suited for this special work and do the best they can with less highly skilled officials.
- 5 If you agree, may the necessity for the release of these officials be pointed out to Regions.
