TO : 20 Piemonte Region (with copy for 21 Costa)

1. Reference is made to your RT/330/111.1 of 19 November and the enclosures.
2. This HQ entirely agrees with what the IC says in his reply to Reg. BOSAZZI of 2 November, reference RT/10/1604. He could, however, have gone a little further and pointed out that not only does AIC make no promotions in grade, but that the Italian Government does not make such promotions either for an official stationed in Military Government Territory.
3. On this point and the subject of promotions generally, would you please refer to Civil Affairs Section circulars 10/4/21/10 of 28 February and 29 June which should be read together. It appears from para 5 of the first mentioned circular and the Ministry of the Interior circular attached to it, the Italian Government have made proper provision for considering the promotion of officials serving in Military Government Territory after the territory is returned and they do not consider the matter until then.
4. Accordingly, applications from Italian officials for promotions should not be forwarded to this HQ but returned to the applicant and he should be referred to the Ministry of the Interior's circular of 14 February above-mentioned.
5. I would emphasize the point that, although Reg. BOSAZZI cannot be promoted yet so long as he performs the functions of Reg. Capo he is entitled to receive the pay and emoluments of that appointment. It does not appear from the papers forwarded by you that he is being paid in this way. No doubt the IC (if he has not already done so) will look into the matter and see to it that Reg. BOSAZZI does receive pay appropriate to the duties he is discharging, retrospectively to the date when he assumed them.
6. Reg. BOSAZZI's application and the Prefect's covering letter are returned herewith. Copies of the circulars above-mentioned are also attached.

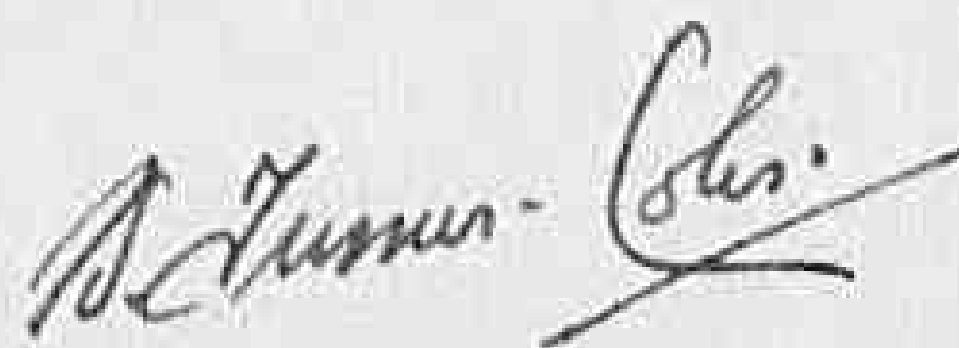

The Italian Government has brought to the attention of this Commission that many officials and employees who went North with the Fascist Republican Government received promotions in grade and that similar promotions in grade were conferred on personnel already residing in Northern Italian provinces which, after the 8th of September 1943, remained under the jurisdiction of said illegitimate Government.

2. These promotions are considered null and void by the legal Italian Government, according to Art. 2 of D.L. No. 249 of 5 October 1944. Accordingly, all such officials still in office are entitled to receive only the salary due to them according to the rank they held on 8 September 1943, without any recognition of the promotions in grade given by the Fascist Republican Government.

3. ~~However~~, This does not affect the right of Allied Military Government to appoint and dismiss officials according to Executive Memorandum No. 62. Such appointments, however, are temporary and have no effect on the permanent rank or status of the appointees in the Italian civil service. During the tenure of the office-holder in such temporary appointment, he receives a salary commensurate with the position held.

The Ministry of Treasure has pointed out that many of the officials and employees who transferred themselves to the North with the fascist republican Government, received promotions and that analogous promotions were granted to the personnel already residing in Northern Italian provinces which after the 8th of September remained under the jurisdiction of said Government.

These promotions have no value for the legal Italian Government since according to art 2 of D.L. 5 October 1944 they have to be considered null and without any juridical effect.

We therefore beg the Allied Commission to inform the competent authorities of AMG about all the above, so that they will see that such officials, also if still holding office, receive only the salary due to them according to the rank they held on the 8th Sept. 1943, without any recognition of promotions given by illegitimate authorities.

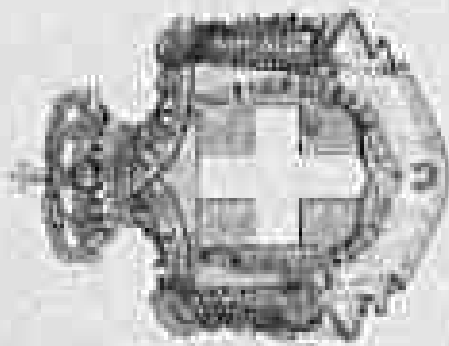

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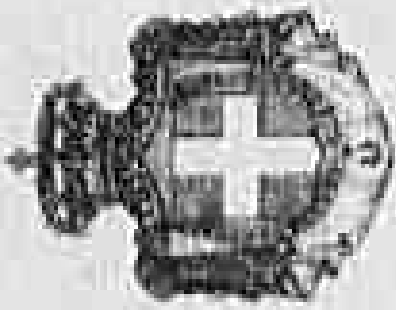

Inasmuch as what regards the Consigliere of the Prefecture of Florence dott. LAZZA Ideale, we assure the Sub Commission that we have taken into consideration the favourable judgment made by the Sub Commission in his regards and that during this month his position will be submitted to the Unique Commission of the Personnel in accordance to his promotion to the superior grade.
