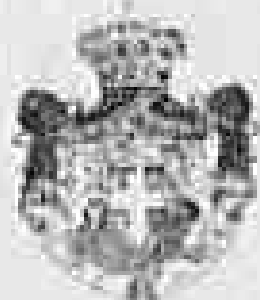

1. I said that letters had been written and were on their way giving approval to appointments of three Directors-General (CARRARINI, VINCIGUERRA, and others) and nine Prefects (MAGGI - COQUINA - SACCHETTI - ALVAREDO - MIRAGLIA, Constantino - PALANCA - CARRARA - DE SANTIS - and CARRARINI).

2. As then went through all the rest of the Prefect who remained in the pool.

3. Of these there are two included in the list of movement of Prefects submitted for AGC confirmation, see file AGC/1/17/Int at No. 21 - who are supposed to be "collocati a disposizione in attesa di destinazione" or in other words, to be relieved of their present appointments - whatever they may be - and held temporarily at the Ministry without a job. The two in question are MAGGI and MIRAGLIA.

4. The point at issue arises as to why these two names were submitted to AGC for approval at all. It emerged in the conversation that Bernini and Camera considered the Magglio-the-Maglie correspondence to apply not only to appointments to a post but also to promotions to a rank or grade. I said I could express no opinion about this without instructions and without a careful re-examination of the correspondence; but I would look into the matter on return to the office.

5. In fact the Italian Government went to have MAGGI as Secretary General to the High Commission for Refugees. This they have not yet put out officially; but I rather the appointment has not yet formally passed the Council of Ministers. 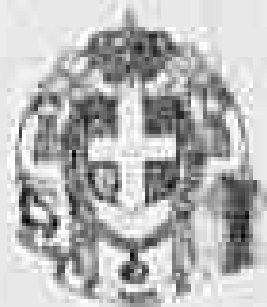

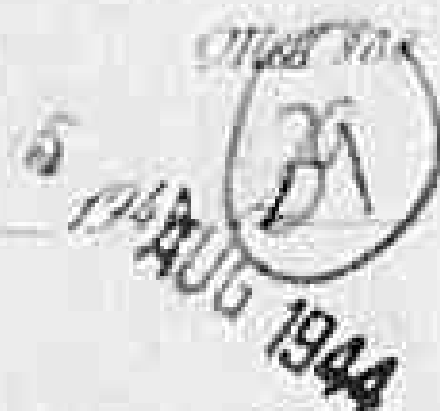

In accordance with your instructions I have screened Dr. Carlo Schiavi and have found the following.

Dr. Schiavi was born in 1881 and began his career in 1910.

For about 20 years he was Head of the Public Safety Personnel Section of the General Police Headquarters.

He was a close friend of the ex-fascist Police Chief, Bocchini, who appointed him to his position in succession to Senise.

Schiavi retained this job under the Republican Fascist regime and has served them as before as a very willing instrument.

It has been reported to me that he frequently intimidated anti-German police agents and forced many against their will to go North with the Republican Fascists and the Germans.

While many other public officials risked their lives and property to protect their courageous pro-Allied compatriots by warning them of pending arrests and enquiries, Mr. Schiavi clearly demonstrated his willing collaboration with the Germans by executing orders from them to the letter.

His action therefore, assisted the enemy and brought harm and suffering to the pro-Allied elements who would certainly view his employment by the Allies with grave misgiving.

He is said to be protected by the present Under Secretary of Interior, Canavari, who even went so far as to prohibit the local newspaper "Avanti" publishing an article exposing Schiavi.

Attached is a letter from Captain Harris, F.S.S. Intelligence corps, which is self explanatory.

I agree with Captain Harris's recommendation that Schiavi should be dismissed from his present position and not recommended for any other position under A.C.C.

POLLOCK, Chief Public Safety Division, in which I recommended he should be suspended from his post of reorganising the Pubblica Sicurezza in Rome. SCHIAVI, it is reported, was a satellite of TAMBURINI, Chief of the Fascist Police, and is said to have collaborated with the Republican police in the transfer to the North of Italy of Pubblica Sicurezza Personnel.

3. Reference is also made in Weekly Report of 276 FSS of 17 - 23 July page 5, para C (i).

4. It is understood, though not with any certainty, that SCHIAVI has been recommended for the post of prefect somewhere in the Florence area. This Section would recommend that no such appointment is given him.

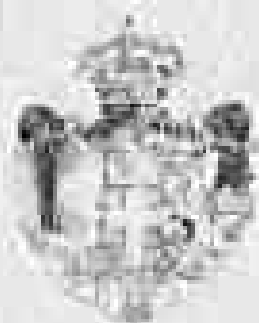

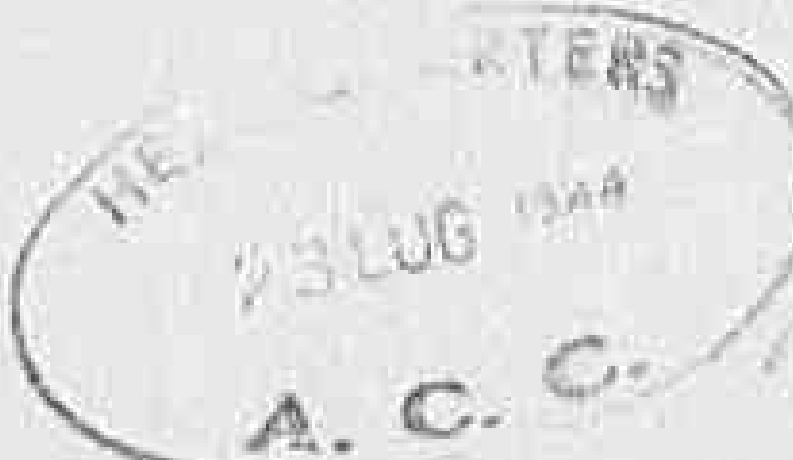

SUBJECT: Pool of Prefects

TO : Director, Security Branch

1. The Italian Government have supplied me with a list of all the available Prefects (and Vice-Prefects fit for promotion to Prefect) from which candidates will be selected for forward provinces as and when called for by Army AMG.

2. Before any of these can be accepted they will need of course to be screened. This has already been done on previous occasions for many of the names. There remains however, 16 nominees which I must pass to you for screening.

3. I annex translations of the short biographical particulars of each of these 16 officials as supplied by the Italian Government.

4. I have not overlooked the new procedure described in Daily Bulletin No. 17 of 20 July, para 2, under which Schede Personali should normally be completed first. In these cases however the Government have taken an unusually long time to supply the names and particulars - no doubt on account of the move to Rome - and they were not, in fact, complete till yesterday afternoon. In the meantime I have been asked to be ready with tens of officials for 9 forward provinces and I expect at any moment to receive cables calling for tens to be actually sent to one or more of these provinces.

5. I have in fact called for the completion of Schede in all these 16 cases, and I will pass them to you as and when received. But it may easily take a fortnight or so before I get these back; and I do hope you will agree that to postpone the request for screening until the Schede are returned would delay matters too much.

1. Captain Temple referred to the message sent to him over the telephone yesterday from the Ministry, through the Italian Liaison Section, from which he understood that the Ministry did not think they could complete the preparation of the list of Prefects.

He said that he was rather concerned and hoped that this did not mean that the Minister had abandoned original suggestion that such a list should be prepared.

2. The Minister said that he was in a particular difficulty at the moment because he was about to go out of office and another Minister to come in.

3. He had consulted with Bonomi, who entirely agreed with the idea of having such a list. The Understanding with Colonel Spicer that the Ministry would prepare the list, therefore, still holds.

4. The Minister said, however, that he now found it impossible to go on completing the list from government resources in South Italy. There were not enough Prefects or Vice-Prefects available for the purpose.

5. The government knew, however, that there were many Prefects in Rome who had either escaped from their Provinces or had been working at the Ministry there. If the preparation of the list could be delayed for a few days until these Rome officials could be obtained, the position would be clearer.

6. The Minister said he would certainly go on nominating a candidate for this or that Province, as they become liberated, and these would have to be non-career men, but he could not prepare a list that would be of any use without drawing <sup>Rome</sup> officials. 725

9. Captain Temple told the Minister that the formal approval of ACC to his proposal that future ACC appointments should be called "Prefetti Reggenti" had just been received and instructions had been sent out accordingly to all regions.

10. H.E. said he was very glad to hear this and greatly appreciated the help Colonel Spicer had given. He promised to inform Bonomi of this.

11. The Minister asked to be informed when Col. Spicer comes back, as he would like an opportunity to take leave of him.

NOTE:

Both Captain Temple and myself feel that what finally cleared the air was the ACC approval to the use of the title "Reggente". It was evident to us that Aldoio, not knowing whether or not ACC had formally agreed to his, was intending to construct his list out of career people only - that he had practically exhausted the career officials he had in the south of Italy, and as to non-career people, his difficulty is that he must choose some one whom the new Italian government would accept

SUBJECT : Prefects of Freed Provinces

Will reference to our verbal understanding this Ministry is putting in hand with all speed inquiries necessary to arrive at a selection of personnel able to be at the head of the provinces which will be freed.

On this subject we must call the Commission's attention to a very important subject.

In the territories still occupied by the Germans, according to radio news, the so called fascist republican government as soon as it was set up replaced all career prefects with politicians of its own following. Many the career prefects have been dismissed because they have not wanted to collaborate with the government. Therefore, when the provinces will be liberated the replacement of prefects, now in office will have to be completed.

This will cause the appointment of many new prefects chosen among people who have not followed the administrative career of the Ministry of the Interior. This will not agree with the law while provides that the number of such appointed prefects must not be more than the two fifths of the total number of prefects.

But this is not the most important point of the problem. According to the present situation, it would be much more important to underline that the new free and democratic situation which envisages the co-existence many parties, it is interest of the people that provinces would be governed by officials and not by men belonging to parties. Another consideration that induces this Ministry to approach the question is that prefects who have followed a regular career and have been dismissed by the republican fascist Government should be employed - after examination of their political past - in order that they should be repaid for the attitude taken notwithstanding the many difficulties they have passed through. This will not be possible if new prefects are appointed as soon as provinces are freed.

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putting in hand with all speed inquires necessary to arrive at a selection of personnel able to be at the head of the provinces which will be freed.

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In order to obviate this difficulty and to meet at the same time the immediate needs among the liberation of provinces, this Ministry suggests that the prefectures should be entrusted to men previously chosen, but appointed as regents or in an acting capacity rather than as Prefects, so that one can be vice to regularise the various appointments at later date.

We shall be glad to know the Commission's opinion.

In relazione alle intese verbali questo Ministero sta conducendo nel modo più sollecito possibile le indagini necessarie per addivenire alla scelta del personale da porre a capo delle province che saranno liberate/.

Al riguardo deve sottoporre, intanto, all'attenzione di codesta Commissione una questione di principio di particolare importanza.

Nei territori ancora occupati dai tedeschi, secondo quanto risulta dalle comunicazioni radio, il pseudo governo repubblicano fascista, na, sin dai primi giorni del suo avvento, sostituito con uomini politici di sua fiducia tutti i prefetti di carriera molti dei quali poi sono stati anche destituiti per non aver voluto aderire alle direttive del governo medesimo.

Pertanto, all'atto della liberazione delle province la sostituzione dei prefetti in carica dovrà essere integrale.

Ciò determinerà la nomina di numerosi nuovi prefetti non di carriera in contrasto con una disposizione di legge che stabilisce che il numero dei prefetti non provenienti dalla carriera amministrativa del Ministero dell'Interno non deve superare i due quinti del numero complessivo dei prefetti.

Ma non è questo il punto più delicato della questione, come, date le particolari circostanze che attraversiamo, potrebbe non essere decisiva la considerazione che, in regime di libertà democratica che prevede la coesistenza di diversi partiti, è nello interesse delle popolazioni mettere a capo delle province dei funzionari anziché degli uomini di partito.

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quello che invece, induce questo Ministero ad affrontare la questione è la considerazione che, per un principio di sana giustizia, i prefetti di carriera destituiti dal governo repubblicano fascista, previo un accertamento dei loro precedenti politici, dovranno essere convenientemente utilizzati in omag-

gio all'atteggiamento da essi assunto e mantenuto pur nelle numerose difficoltà di vita che avranno certamente dovuto affrontare. Ciò che non sarà possibile se man mano che verranno liberate le province saranno nominati nuovi prefetti.

Per ovviare a tale inconveniente e fronteggiare nello stesso tempo le immediate esigenze della liberazione delle province questo ministero proporrebbe di affidare le prefetture agli uomini scelti in precedenza, in modo da avere successivamente la libertà di normalizzare le varie posizioni.

Si gradirà conoscere al riguardo il pensiero di codesta Commissione.-
