SUBJECT: Volpes, Vice Prefect, Guevara.

TO : AF, Southern Region

1. Reference your letter E/109, of 30 September, it would seem to me that our letter AFG/AFD/AF/AF of 25 August addressed to AF Region VII has not reached you.
2. In this letter above, our records contain the following report by Lt Col Nichols, FO Guevara, stated "Volpes is a meddling and of no use at all. He would not make a satisfactory prefect." As we base our actions in this Sub-Command (and indeed our recommendations) very largely on the reports of the FOs and RAs, you will agree that I am placed in a quandary.
3. I have, I think, in my letter of 25 August, of which I am enclosing a copy, more or less reopened the earlier decision, and I should be glad therefore to hear from you as a result of your further consideration.
4. The first part of your letter of 30 September is based on wrong information, since our objection was based not on the state of local government, but on Volpes' personal qualifications arising out of Col Nichols' reports.

Reply to letter 4/22/1 of 8 September

With reference to the last part of the above-letter, we wish to inform you that, according to the records of this Ministry on the past activities of Dr. Chieffo, the position of the latter is as follows:

1 He was employed by the Civil Administration of the Interior in 1920, and ever since has received high qualifications and very complimentary judgements both for his work in prefectures and in the Central Administration;

2 In particular, he was constantly described as having a capacity well beyond the average; in fact, when still a Councillor, he was able to direct the Contracts and Supplies Division of the General Direction of P.S., obtaining praise for having been capable of supervising State interests in highly important affairs;

3 When working in the prefecture of Foggia, the Motor-pool of this Ministry (which was controlled by the Contracts and Supplies Division directed by Chieffo) were found on investigation to be guilty of serious misbehaviour, and Chieffo was consequently accused of negligence and poor interest in the supervision of that service, besides other points.

4 As a result of these charges, Chieffo was punished with suspension from his grade and wages for a period of six months. This measure was repealed, however, by a ministerial decree of 13 October 1942.

5 The general conviction resulting from such contrary judgement, was that the investigation, although concerning Chieffo, was influenced by the resentment which the Chief of Police, Bocchini, had for him.

6 Since then, Dr. Chieffo has done excellent work as General Inspector in the Ministry.

His activities since the 8 September 1943 are worthy of praise, since he completely abandoned his service and collaborated with the opposers of the Germans.

In consideration of his past career as a whole, as described above, it seems that the position of Dr. Chieffo merits revision, especially as Prefects are so scarce at the present moment and this official is known to have the qualities of energy and capacity for useful work under the grade mentioned.

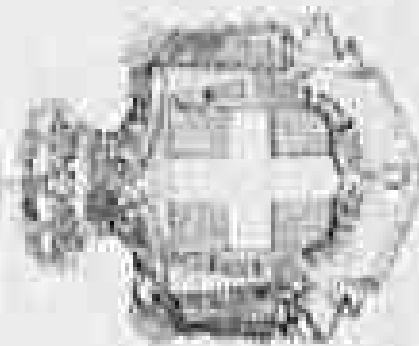

On the Regional Commissioner's recent trip to Catanzaro, he learned that the promotion of Vice Prefect VOLPEZ to be Prefect of a northern province was stopped on the grounds that Allied Control Commission had complaint in July last that the local government of Cosenza were not acting with sufficient energy.

2. In the opinion of Allied Control Commission officers in Catanzaro Zone, Vice Prefect VOLPEZ was not responsible for any lack of energy, he has done well in the past and he should do well as a Prefect. The Prefect of Cosenza, Sig. MIRAGLIA, confirms this view, and added that Colonel Nichols, now in Siena, could give a good report on Vice Prefect VOLPEZ.

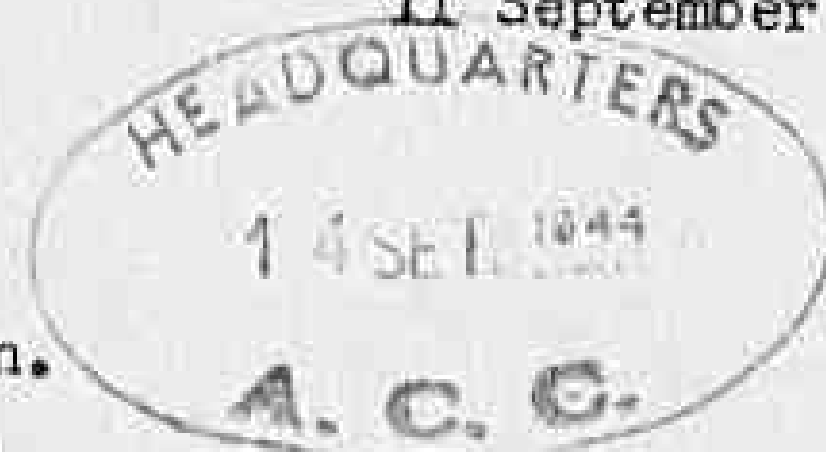

3. The Vice-Prefect of Benevento, "duardo Fappacena, is not considered as having all the capabilities of a good Prefect. His capacity is that of a Vice-Prefect although he might be quite successful in a Province of minor importance already functioning.

4. There is nothing known of anything detrimental to his character.

Your Excellency:

1. I refer to my conversation this morning with H. B. Berruti and Cav. Andrea Camera when it was agreed that the undermentioned Prefects and Vice-Prefects might suitably be nominated to be Prefects of newly liberated provinces; and they were provisionally nominated for the provinces set opposite to their respective names:

2. I explained to your representatives how the successful military operations at both ends of the Gothic Line rendered it most urgent to have an adequate supply of Prefects for the north of Italy at once. There are the provinces of FORLI, FERRARA, MODENA, REGGIO NEL EMILIA, PARMA, and PIACENZA to consider as well as the numerous provinces of LIGURIA, PIEDMONT, LOMBARDIA, and VENETIA, for which provision must be made.

3. In the meantime, I shall be glad if you will, as arranged this morning, call up to Rome immediately the Prefect DE GOZZUZZA and the Vice-Prefects FORI, MOZZI, and CIPRIANI.

4. Will you please also let me have the usual biographical particulars as to the Prefects PASCUCCI, SPECIALE, and Vacca DE DOMINICIS.

5. A certain Luigi STELLA was mentioned by your Chief of Cabinet this morning as being now at disposition and I should like particulars of him well.

Col Spicer referred to the list of 19 Vice Prefects for promotion received by him from the Ministry on 12 August. 4 had been passed as suitable for Army Areas - CIPRIANI, LONGO, MOZZI, and POZI - and the remainder are being screened as soon as possible. 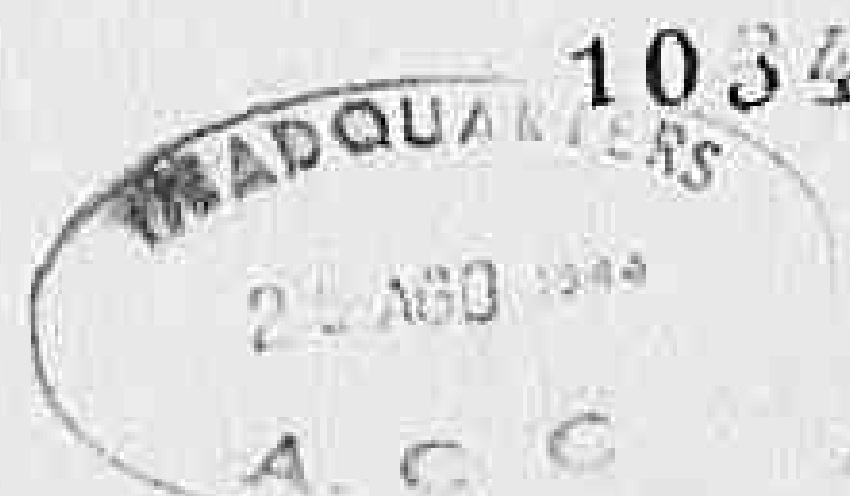

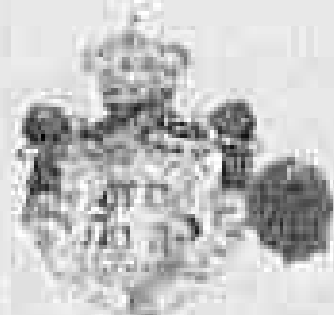

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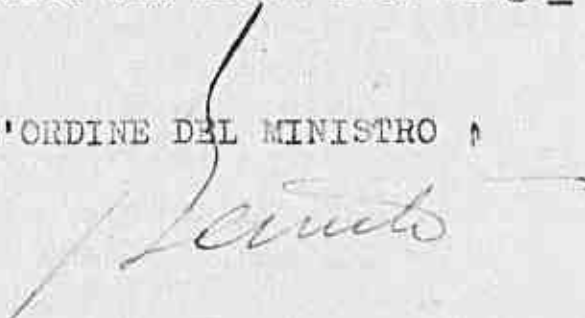
