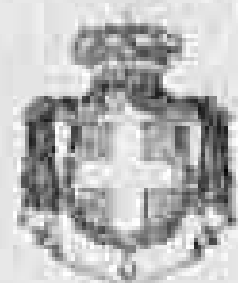

1. To date we have received scanty information as to the actual appointments of Prefects in the northern provinces. We have been officially informed that only one Prefect has been formally installed, to wit Dott. Gianguido DOMENESS--Socialist--Province of Bologna--CIN nominee. We have also been informed that in the province of Ferrara the head of the Provincial CIN, who himself is non-political, ~~has~~ named ~~REMO~~ Remo, has been appointed Acting Prefect temporarily pending the selection of a permanent Prefect.

2. In two cases, the CIN nominee is also the Government's candidate and, therefore, the possibility of their being appointed is very good. These are Sig. AVAZZINI Enrico--Christian-Democrat--Province of Mantova, and Sig. DEL GIUDICE Pietro--Socialist--Province of Aquania.

3. We have received a signal from Brigadier Dunlop that he expects to appoint the following persons, all of whom are CIN nominees: it can be taken, therefore, that they have been appointed by now, since we have replied to the signal that the ID has full authority to make appointments after consideration of the Government's candidates. 1. NOMINATION FOR VICE PREFECT VICARIO FOR FERRARA

BERRUTI said that the name of the nominee would be furnished today.

2. CIN NOMINEES FOR PREFECTS IN THE NORTH

BERRUTI was given the list of nominations to date and informed that the appointment of BORGHESE for Prefect Regent of Bologna has actually been made. He said that he was personally acquainted with the CIN nominee for Mantova--AVANZINI. Col. Cripps mentioned that we had been informed that MICHELI, the Government's nominee for Prefect of Parma, had refused to take the post. BERRUTI exhibited much surprise and said he would try to find out what the story was on this matter. Col. Cripps informed him that we had received no written confirmation of this fact as yet.

3. PUBLICATION OF DECREE FOR COMPILED OF ELECTORAL LISTS IN THE TERRITORY

BERRUTI said that he expected the Decree to be published in a week.

4. DELIVERY OF ELECTORAL MATERIAL

BERRUTI stated that he would communicate with the Prefects of Pesaro, Ancona and Terni to ascertain whether the delivery of electoral forms had been made to those provinces.

5. ADMIRAL STONE'S LETTER OF 19 APRIL CRITICIZING ELECTION METHODS

BERRUTI stated that DONOMI's letter of April 23 was in fact a reply to the letter of April 19, although he had informed Major Temple last week that it was not. He had checked on the situation. However, he agreed that the response was very general because the Government was not in a position to take up the details mentioned in the Chief Commissioner's letter. He realized that those details went to the heart of the problem and stated that a more detailed letter would be sent very shortly taking up directly the points mentioned.

6. MOVEMENT ORDERS FROM ITALIAN GOVERNMENT TO PERSONNEL TO TRAVEL TO NORTHERN PROVINCES

BERRUTI said he knew nothing about the movement order being issued by the Ministry to MOLLO Domenico, Capo di Gabinetto of Ancona, to proceed to Udine to take up his former duties there. He said he was fully aware of the fact that no such order was proper. However, at our request he would check with the Personale Division to ascertain whether any functionary in the department issued such instructions.

7. REQUEST FROM MINISTRY TO AUTHORIZE PERSONNEL TO PROCEED NORTH FOR PERSONAL REASONS

The request of an official named LIVOI to proceed to Rome for personal reasons was mentioned. BERRUTI said that hundreds of such requests are coming in. Col. Cripps mentioned that permits would shortly be issued by the Italian Government itself and that they would have to dispose of the matter without any assistance on our part. BERRUTI took back the letter concerning LIVOI and said they would dispose of it themselves.

8. ARCHIVES

In response to the question as to what was being done in connection with the Government's archives in Verona, BERRUTI mentioned that the Government's archives were partly distributed in other provinces, too. Furthermore, he stated that the Chief Commissioner had agreed with the Prime Minister to permit a party representing several Ministries on May 17 to proceed North in order to locate and protect the Government's archives.

1. To date we have received scanty information as to the actual appointments of Prefects in the northern provinces. We have been officially informed that only one Prefect has been formally installed, to wit Dott. Gianguido BORGHESE--Socialist--Province of Bologna--CLN nominee. We have also been informed that in the province of Ferrara the head of the Provincial CLN, who himself is non-political, ~~and~~ named HIRSCH Renato, has been appointed Acting Prefect temporarily pending the selection of a permanent Prefect.

2. In two cases, the CLN nominee is also the Government's candidate and, therefore, the possibility of their being appointed is very good. These are Sig. AVANZINI Emilio--Christian-Democrat--Province of Mantova, and Sig. DEL GIUDICE Pietro--Socialist--Province of Apuania.

3. We have received a signal from Brigadier Dunlop that he expects to appoint the following persons, all of whom are CLN nominees: it can be taken, therefore, that they have been appointed by now, since we have replied to the signal that the HQ has full authority to make appointments after consideration of the Government's candidates. 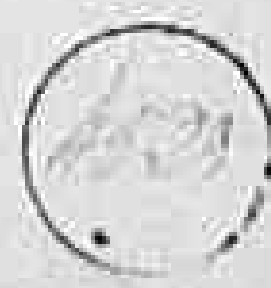

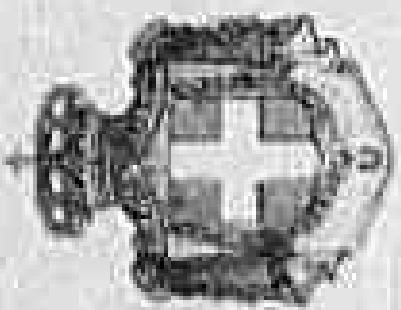

REPORT OF A MEETING BETWEEN THE PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL OF
MINISTERS AND BRIGADIER G. B. UNION, VICE MINISTER, CIVIL
AFFAIRS SECTION, ON 26 APRIL 1945 at 1230 HOURS.

Brigadier UNION referred to His Excellency's Meeting with Admiral STONE and himself on Tuesday morning when His Excellency asked the Allied Commission to appoint Italian Government nominees to the position of Prefect and Questore in provinces in North Italy when liberated.

Brigadier UNION stated that the question had been very carefully considered by the Allied Commission and he had a proposal to make which he thought would provide a solution satisfactory to His Excellency.

Brigadier UNION pointed out that the Allied Commission felt it was fundamental that the appointment of Prefect and Questore was one which must ultimately be left in the hands of the Allied Military Government Provincial officer and His Excellency agreed.

Brigadier UNION then stated that the Allied Commission appreciated the position of the Government in the matter. The Commission realized that the Government must have its say in any appointments made.

The Commission therefore proposed that the Government should submit the names of persons to fill the appointment of Prefect and Questore for each of the Provinces to be liberated. These names would be signalled to forward areas to the Allied Military Government officer concerned for his consideration.

It must be appreciated that the Allied Military Government officer would undoubtedly have other nominations before him; for instance, the Provincial CII would no doubt have a nominee; the AG officer might consult other sources of advice, e.g. the local Archbishop. It would therefore be a great advantage if the Government would nominate a local man who would be likely to be acceptable to local interests, for the AG officer could not be expected to appoint somebody who was not acceptable to local interests, or the administration of the province, which was ultimately the responsibility of the AG officer concerned, might become a matter of much difficulty.

His Excellency said he entirely appreciated the position and the Government had shown this by nominating already MINERLE for the position of Prefect of PAVIA, where he was extremely well known.

His Excellency said that he entirely agreed, but ^{the} important thing from the point of view of the Government ^{was} that the local CENs must not be allowed to ~~take that they had the right to make the appointments, should submit names for~~ ^{positions which were a governing factor.}

Brigadier WUJON stated that he could reassure His Excellency in this matter; it would be made quite clear that the appointment rested with AEF and that the CEN had no right whatever to make any appointments; they had the right to put forward names for consideration by AEF, but no more. His Excellency, the Allied Commission regarded this as fundamental.

Brigadier WUJON then pointed out that due consideration would be given to all candidates and it might well happen that a period of ten days to a fortnight, or even more, might elapse after liberation before any appointment would be made. In important towns such as MILAN, TURIN, etc., the British and American Political Advisors would be present and would be consulted before any final selection was made.

Brigadier WUJON stated.....

Brigadier URJOEN stated that if on liberation a person was found to be acting as facto as Prefect, he would probably be retained in office for the execution of routine matters while his successor was being chosen. It would be made quite plain to such a facto Prefect or Quastore that his appointment was purely temporary for a matter of a few days until his successor was finally selected.

The Excellency entirely agreed to the proposals made by the Allied Commission and stated that he would endeavour to let the Allied Commission have the Government's Nominees for the provinces mentioned below by 1300 hours tomorrow, Friday 27 April, 1945, so that Col. CHIFFE could take a list to forward areas tomorrow afternoon - BULGONA, MASA, LA SERRA, CHENVA, MASA, MASO.

The Excellency then enquired whether Ministers would be able to go forward in the near future to newly liberated provinces.

Brigadier URJOEN said that he hoped that the Army control line would be moved forward in a few days from its present position to a line which would probably be KAVONA, YOLI, YINTEL, PINOLA, LONCA, VISA, LIVONA and the Government would be informed when in fact this new line would come into force.

Brigadier URJOEN emphasized, however, that the present practice must continue and that no Minister could cross the Rear Army Control Line without special permission from this Headquarters and that until the battle had finished and conditions settled down the Commission would not be willing to grant such permission. It must be appreciated that this was necessary owing to the Military situation; as soon as hostilities had ceased, and conditions had become more settled, the Allied Commission would revise its policy in this respect.

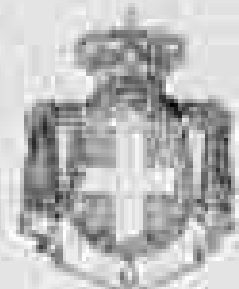

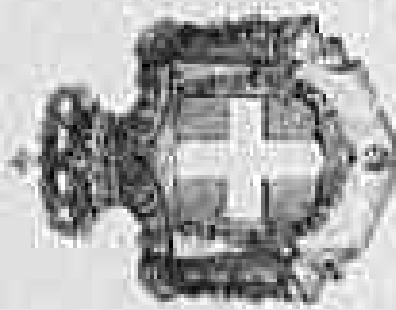

Your Excellency:

1. I refer to the Ministry's letter No. 854 Cabinetto, dated 7 January, notifying this Sub Commission of your proposal to promote a number of Vice Prefects Vicario and Vice Prefects Inspector to the rank of Prefect. The views of the Allied Commission have been conveyed to you with respect to all the Vice Prefects named in your letter with the exception only, I think, of Dott. MAURO and Dott. LIUTI.
2. In view of the shortage of qualified officials, it has been decided not to object to the utilization of Dott. LIUTI in the rank of Prefect in a province under Military Government. It would be preferable, however, if the Ministry would not propose him to this Sub Commission for any such office, unless and until all other suitable officials have been exhausted.
3. It is regretted that the Allied Commission could not employ Dott. MAURO as Prefect of a province under AMG.
4. Nothing contained in this letter prevents the Italian Government from promoting both these officials to the rank of Prefect, or from employing them in a province under their jurisdiction, and for which they are solely responsible.

1. I wrote to you yesterday under this reference dealing, amongst other things, with the approval of the Allied Commission to the above-named as a Prefect in Military Government Territory.
2. Later in the day, I received a letter from the Regional Commissioner, Lazio-Umbria Region, forwarding a letter addressed on 29 January by Dott. ZACCHI to Major Phillips, Provincial Commissioner, Viterbo, together with a statement prepared by Dott. ZACCHI as to his career. I enclose copies of these papers for your information.
3. You will observe from the last paragraph but two of Dott. ZACCHI's statement as to his career that he is well aware that you have proposed his name to the Allied Commission for promotion to the rank of Prefect. When Major Williams last discussed the subject of these promotions with the Chief of Cabinet, H. R. BERRUTI particularly asked that care should be taken that correspondence about this subject reached the Cabinet of the Ministry only, because it was important that the officials under consideration for promotion should not get to hear of the proposal before it had been considered by the Council of Ministers.
4. Proposals of this kind are always treated in this office as confidential, and Dott. ZACCHI's case has in fact not been mentioned either to the Regional Commissioner or the Provincial Commissioner. I can throw no light upon the circumstances in which Dott. ZACCHI got to hear of it.

TO : His Excellency, the Minister of the Interior

Your Excellency,

1. I refer to your letter n. 854 Gabinetto dated 7 January and to your subsequent letter n. 1407 Gabinetto dated 17 January.
2. The Allied Commission are not concerned with the promotion in rank of officials of the Ministry but only with their suitability to hold office in a particular province. The proposals set out in your letters cited above have therefore been examined with a view to determining whether the official named therein would be acceptable to the Allied Commission as Prefects of provinces now or hereafter to come under Allied Military Government or of provinces under the control of the Italian Government.
3. As you know, I am particularly concerned at present with the formation of a "pool" or reserve of Prefects and others for service in the provinces of North Italy, as they become liberated. Your proposal has been examined with this consideration particularly in mind and I shall indicate - in this letter or as soon as possible hereafter - which officials are acceptable in this capacity. Any official I may accept at the present stage however, must be subject to further review when named for a particular province and after personal interview here.
4. Subject to the foregoing considerations, the following are acceptable to the Allied Commission and will be regarded by me as included in the "pool" of Prefects available for service in North Italy : -

LACCHI, Giuseppe
DI GIOVANNI, Filippo
LIGONE, Orlando
SPASIANO, Sergio
VIGARI, Angelo
5. Dr. DI GIOVANNI should not however be proposed for any province in Toscana Region.
6. The Allied Commission would not raise any further objection to the appointment of Dr. VIGARI, who is to be Prefect of a province under the control of the Italian Government, but he is not considered suitable for a province

under the Allied Military Government.

7. In view of his recent behaviour at Aquila, I do not consider Dr. OMOLIO-SALE to be fit to be the Prefect of any province.

8. Inquiries are being made as to the remaining 5 Vice Prefects named in your letters: I will write to you further about them as soon as I can.

9. Even if you cannot immediately communicate their forthcoming promotion to the Vice Prefects named in para 4 of this letter, I would ask you to inform them at once of their liability to serve in North Italy and direct them to be ready to move at 48 hours notice. It would also be advisable, I think to afford them the opportunity to raise now any excuses on the ground of sickness and so on. Such excuses could then be dealt with in advance: and we might avoid - at least to some extent, I hope - the interminable and exasperating delays which we are now experiencing in connection with the provinces of Toscana, Abruzzi and the Marche.

1. I refer to the penultimate paragraph of the Minister's letter of 7th January (See paper 1A on file). I asked if this meant that the cases of di Giovanni, Vicari and Spasiano had not been submitted to the Duration Commission so that the Commission had not given any judgment in their cases.

2. Berruti said "yes, exactly," because in these three cases there was nothing at all in their regard for the Duration Commission to consider. I said we had no observations on that situation as regards Vicari and Spasiano, but it placed us in a difficult position as to di Giovanni. This VP had been suspended from office at Arezzo by AMG. The Ministry now recommended him for use as a Prefect in AMG territory. How could I send back to the AMG as a Prefect a man whom they had rejected when Vice Prefect? Moreover, the fact of di Giovanni's suspension would be generally known and might well diminish his authority as a Prefect.

3. Berruti said he thought that we had already agreed that di Giovanni could be used in AMG territory provided it was not in Toscana. In any case he repeated that he could not submit the case to the Duration Commission because there was no case. di Giovanni had refused all cooperation with the Germans or Republicans; he had refused to work in the Prefecture under the Republican Prefect, and had not taken the oath. If a case like this were submitted to the Duration Commission they would merely return it to the Ministry without considering it, saying that there was nothing for them to consider.

(Note - I have not been able to trace any such consent on our part for the use of di Giovanni in AMG territory as Berruti mentions above: I think he is mistaken).

4. Berruti made a further suggestion that we might agree to the use of di Giovanni as a Prefect in Italian Government territory. I said 1662 I referred not to agree to anything that morning: we would consider H.E.'s remarks and send a considered reply.

5. I then referred to Nacchi, Onofeo Sale and Limone, pointing out that these were already Vice Prefects in Provinces and their promotion would mean finding substitutes. We had not the least desire to prevent their promotion on this ground and we assumed that the Ministry were prepared to provide substitutes. Berruti said "of course" and the Personale were already considering who to suggest in their place.

6. I asked if the Ministry intended to promote these people at once, or to withhold their actual promotion until a Province becomes available for them. Immediate promotion might mean some disturbances in the Administration. For instance L. Jona had only been VP Piazza six weeks or so and such a rapid change is not a good thing.

7. H.E. said the Ministry attached a very high importance to regard for seniority in order of promotion. We looked at the names in the letter of 7 January (Vol. 1 on file) and H.E. stated that the first five were men of considerable seniority and would (if we accept them) be promoted at once. The remaining seven were more junior and would be promoted later. The twelve names had been set out in the Minister's letter in strict order of seniority.

8. After some more discussion I told H.E. that:

- (a) We would write accepting Zocchi, S. medeo Sale and Jona
- (b) also Vicari and Spasiano
- (c) de Fco who was the business of Public Safety Sub-Commission
- (d) di Giovanni we would decide on further
- (e) The remaining names were unknown to us: we were making enquiries and would let the Ministry know.
