(4) In an attempt to anticipate the excuses, which inevitably will arise from officials called forward for the cloth, and to reduce to a minimum the delay in filling the positions of Prefet, V.P.V. and V.P.I., it is suggested that the Ministry of Interior be asked :- 1. To notify forthwith all officials who have been nominated for central service in the cloth. 2. To fix a certain period within which all excuses and appeals, by the officials concerned and their superiors (if any), against the nomination, must be made. 3. To : His Excellency the Minister of the Interior.

Your Excellency:

1. Reference is made to the Ministry's letter No. 5000 (Dir. Gen. Paracalo, dated 24 May, and to the conference held here yesterday between officers of the Sub Commission and M. B. Dott. MICALI, Cav. GARRA and Marchese PARENTI, when it was agreed that the steps described below should be taken.
2. The officials of the Ministry stated that from now onwards a grant of 20,000 lire would be made in favor of officials appointed to northern provinces to cover the expenses involved.
3. Ferrara. It was agreed that the Ministry could telegraph or telephone the Prefect of Naples to inform Dott. GOCOLA of the expenses grant and that if he did not report himself to Rome immediately severe measures would be taken. In the event of a satisfactory answer not being received by Monday, 29 May, the Ministry would make another nomination for this province.
4. Bologna. Dott. MULLO is acceptable to the Allied Commission for the post of Vice Prefect Inspector of Bologna. It was agreed that the Ministry would telegraph or telephone the Prefect of Ancona to inform Dott. MULLO of his transfer, that he must report himself direct to Bologna as soon as possible and that he would receive the grant of 20,000 lire. This Sub Commission on their part would communicate with the Provincial Commissioner of Ancona to facilitate Dott. MULLO's journey by all means in his power: this has been done.
5. Piacenza. The officials of the Ministry undertook to send a letter to the Sub Commission confirming that Dott. D'ERRICO is not subject to operation proceedings. Subject to this, he is acceptable to the Allied Commission for the post of Vice Prefect Inspector of Piacenza. It was agreed that the Ministry would telegraph or telephone the Prefect of Poggia to inform Dott. D'ERRICO of his transfer, that he must report himself to Rome immediately and that he would receive the grant of 20,000 lire.
6. In order to prevent delays in any future cases which may arise, the Ministry will send to the Sub Commission a list of the officials pre-

visually agreed and available to act as Vice Prefects, Vicario and Inspector in the North. When this list has been agreed between the Ministry and the Sub Commission, the Ministry will warn all such officials that they are liable to be called upon for service in the North, so that any requests for exemption which such officials may desire to make can be received and considered in advance.

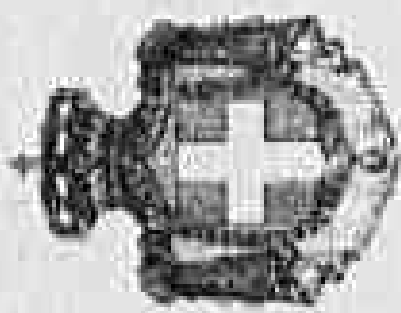

SUBJECT : Pool of Prefects and Vice Prefects

NOTE of interview with Marchese PARENTI of the Ministry of Interior

INTERVIEWED BY: Major C.C.R. Williams and Capt. W.I. Cunningham

DATE : 10th April 1945 - 16.00 hours

Mr. Rice interpreting

1. Marchese PARENTI said he had asked for this interview as he wished to discuss with us the suggestions in the letter from this Sub Commission dated 3rd April 1945 (page 29 on this file). He did not think the suggestions were good for two reasons :
 - a) - if officials were notified that they had been chosen to go to the North they would immediately commence to bring all possible pressures, political and otherwise, to bear on the Ministry and other Ministers to rescind their nomination.
 - b) - having then medically examined now would be no guarantee that they wouldn't go sick when required to move.
2. He said reason (a) was exactly why we had suggested the notification of officials i.e. in order that all excuses could be cleared up.
3. PARENTI said he thought there would be much less delay if officials were not notified till the last minute and thus had no opportunity to organise pressure on the Ministry.
4. He said we had been telling them we could supply them with officials. In effect this was not true. Several Prefectures had been without certain officials for over six months now and we could not get officials to fill these vacancies. Fourteen officials in the past 4 months had failed to move when ordered, pleading health or other excuses (see list page 7). We could not continue in this way when the front broke and the North was liberated. He thought excuses should be dealt with now, as when the demands came in from the North we wouldn't have time to deal with excuses. Should we leave the North without adequate government?
5. PARENTI asked if we had any suggestions to make.
6. He said we had already made the suggestions in the letter. He thought it was a matter of discipline. As regards the excuse of illness he said it would seem to follow that if an official was so seriously ill that he could not move to another Prefecture he was surely too ill to continue working and should be dismissed or retired - two or three dismissals would cure this trouble.
7. PARENTI said this would require an alteration in the law. He also referred to the letter from the Ministry on the subject of the VPI for Japan (copy attached). He thought that the officials were getting round even the Italian

Military doctors. He could do no more.

8. He said we appreciated this and would have to write a report on the matter for the attention of our superiors.

9. ~~XXXXVI~~ suggested that we should propose that the Ministry should have a Sector of their own whom they and we could trust who would be sent off to examine an official as soon as he pleaded sickness or better still if Allied Commission would have these men examined by Allied Commission Doctors.

10. We said that the latter suggestion could not work as no Allied Commission officials remained in the portion of Italy under the Italian Government and anyway we considered that the whole matter was the responsibility of the Italian Government.

This Ministry is peretly aware of the necessity that movements of personnel be effected, under the present circumstances, with the utmost solicitude.

As a matter of fact, with a view of overcoming the possible opposition which, mostly for financial reasons, the personnel might have offered to transfer orders on alleged health grounds, this Ministry, as it is known, has provided by an appropriate circular, that the infirmities declared by the personnel at the moment to be transferred to another locality be verified by a special collegial military doctor, departing in this from the procedure followed heretofore in similar cases.

However, once the infirmity has been ascertained and recognized through the established guarantees, this Ministry for obvious reasons cannot but conform with the attestation drawn up, under its own responsibility, by the military medical authorities,

Should however your Commission be in a position to suggest any other solution which may help obviate the present situation, this Ministry, which cannot depart from the rules governing this matter, would of course be glad to adopt as its own the suggestion in question in order to derive from it every useful advantage.

Having said this, we wish to assure your Commission that under today's date directions have been given to the High Commissariat for Sicily to have deputy Vice Prefect Inspector dr. Stefano Russe report at once to your Allied Commission.

We also wish to confirm that this Ministry will not fail to take disciplinary sanctions against Dr. Papaleo in the event that his infirmity would turn out to be non existant.

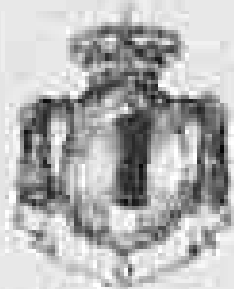

Your Excellency :

1. The Ministry of Interior has nominated many officials for eventual appointment as Prefects and Vice Prefects Vicario or Ispettore in Provinces yet to be liberated in Northern Italy, and this Sub Commission has notified the Ministry from time to time of those officials who are acceptable to the Allied Commission for these appointments.
2. In order to reduce to a minimum any delay which may hereafter arise when these officials are required to proceed to their new posts I would suggest that the Ministry should consider the advisability of
 - (a) Notifying forthwith all these officials that they have been nominated for eventual service in the North.
 - (b) Fixing a certain period within which all excuses and appeals by the officials concerned, and their superiors (if any), against the nomination must be made.
 - (c) Having all the nominees examined now by Italian Military Doctors to determine their present state of health.
3. If these precautions were carried out now it would anticipate the majority of the present causes of delay in staffing newly liberated Prefectures and both the Ministry of Interior and this Sub Commission would know which officials were most likely to proceed, immediately when called upon, to their new appointments, and could therefore choose the proper and most likely officials in cases of urgency.
4. I should be pleased to have your observations on the proposal. 1882

Your Excellency:

1. I refer to the Ministry's letter No. 5000 (Dir. Gen. Personale) dated 15 January and to subsequent correspondence.
2. It is reported to me that Dott. VISCONTI is at present the subject of epuration proceedings, he having sworn the oath to the Fascist Republican Government. He cannot, therefore, be considered until the judgment of the Epuration Commission is known.
3. Dott. CRISCUOLI is stated to have been "squadrists", "marcia su Roma", and "poliarpa littorio". In his case also, I shall require to know the decision of the Epuration Commission before considering him further.
4. Dott. CAMILLERI is reported to have been an official of the M.V.S.N. and to have epuration proceedings against him. He also cannot be accepted by the Allied Commission until the result of these proceedings is known.
5. The 3 officials above named, together with the 4 referred to in para 5 of my letter of 30 January, make 7 who are not acceptable to the Commission until epuration proceedings have been completed. I trust that every possible step will be taken to see that these proceedings are completed as quickly as possible.

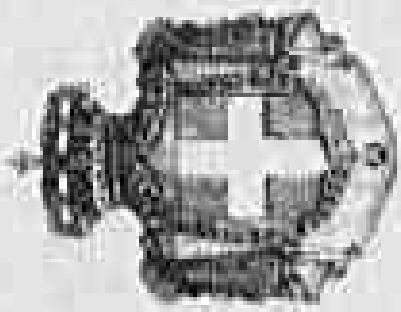

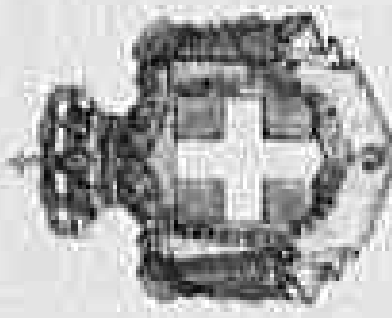

SUBJECT : Vice Prefect, Vicari and Vice Prefects Inspectors actually at disposition.

Referring to the previous verbal agreements, we inform this Sub Commission, that we can consider actually consider at disposition the officials who's biographical notices we enclose, for carrying out the vicarious and inspective functions.

Several of these officials have given service in Offices under the Administration of the Allied Military Government.

In the case, however, that the Commission should not consider utilising them in offices under the Administration of the Allied Military Government, even if a different one from that in which they have given service, this Ministry would consider appointed them in Prefectures passed under the Administration of the Italian Government to and at the same time take an equal number of officials to be put at the disposition of the Commission.

As we have already pointed out in another occasion, this Ministry would prefer pointing out to the Commissions, officials against whom no objections can be raised and who had not made any unfavourable impression on the Allied Authorities, but taking into consideration the numerical deficiency of the personnel and as a result of this the impossibility of providing the necessary staff for every Prefecture, it is obliged, in the cases where there are no special charges against the officials, especially of a political nature, but only for reasons of incompatibility in a specific Prefecture, to propose them to the Sub Commission so as to be used in another province.

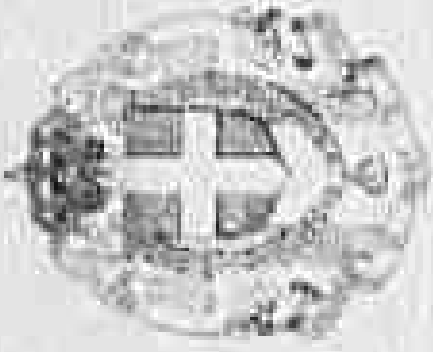
