1. With reference to your letters HC/4/27/45 of 5 FEB and HC/4/27/45 of 5 FEB, enquiries have been made in the case of Dr. Mancuso by J1 F.S.S. and their report is as follows:-

"Background investigation into the above-named who is at present Consul here and class at the Prefecture of CALABRIZIA, has been rendered difficult by the fact that he only arrived at CALABRIZIA on the orders of the Ministry of the Interior four and a half months ago.

Whilst at CALABRIZIA Dott. MANCUSO has been employed as Chief Prefecture Inspector and according to informants is not held in very high esteem. It is felt, however, that other employees in the Prefecture are somewhat jealous and have the idea that he has achieved advancement by favouritism at the Ministry of the Interior.

No information is available on Dott. MANCUSO's record and political sympathies previous to his arrival at CALABRIZIA, and it is presumed that these will have to be obtained on the mainland."

2. F.S.S. Reports are still awaited in the case of Dr. De Felice and Dr. Russo.

3. There is only one Public Safety officer in this 1974 region and he is located at Palermo. I cannot see that any good purpose would be served in bringing the officials in question long distances across the island merely to have them seen by an Allied Public Safety officer who has only recently arrived in the island and who would have to speak to them through an interpreter. It seems to me that in cases of this nature one must rely on particulars supplied by

the Ministry of the Interior and on P.S.S. or similar reports if they are available.

The following report from SI P.S.S. has just been received regarding Dott. DE FELICE Francesco:-

" Background investigation into the above named who was born in CATANIA on 15.3.1887, and who is at present employed in the Prefettura at URPANI, results as follows:

A report in the O.I.C. files at URPANI dated 24 NOV 43 reads: - "M.V. Prof. Cav. Uff. Francesco DE FELICE, Via Garibaldi 12, URPANI. Consigliere of the Prefettura. Arrived from the Prefettura of CATANIA on 4 Jan 43. Member of the P.M.F. from 1928 onwards. Never held any position or employment in the party. Has good moral conduct and takes little interest in politics. Appears to be pro-allied."

According to SI P.S. sources DE FELICE, although a member of the Fascist Party, was never very active politically. Although he is not regarded as a brilliant administrator he has had a considerable amount of experience as a State official. Local opinion is mixed regarding his capabilities and it is suggested in some quarters that he is open to bribes. His wife is considered free and easy with money. Professes pro-allied sentiment.

TO : RC Sicily Region.

1. Thank you for your letter AC/014.12 dated 26 Jan. 1945; and for the information given in the third paragraph about Dr. TORRISI of Catania.
2. Dr. DE FELICE may be at Syracuse instead of Trapani as the Italian Government proposed on 18 January to transfer him to the latter place.
3. As to him and Dr. MANCUSO I quite appreciate that in the absence of any Provincial Commissioner you have no information available about them. My difficulty is that I must inform the Italian Government whether or not they would be acceptable to this HQ as Vice Prefects in Military Government Territory, and I cannot accept them for this purpose without having some security report, and without at least some rough idea of what they are like personally. The only place I can get this information from is Sicily. I hardly feel we should be justified in taking Consiglieri away from Sicily Prefectures for perhaps several weeks and bringing them up to Rome to be screened. Moreover, you will agree, I think, that screening in the neighborhood of the locality where they work would be a more satisfactory process.
4. In these circumstances, would you be good enough to consider the suggestion that MANCUSO and DE FELICE might be requested through Italian channels to present themselves to the appropriate provincial HQ, where there is a Public Safety officer who could screen them. In that case, I should be very grateful if the officers doing the screening would note down their impressions of the men and attach them to the report.
5. When any considerable advance takes place in North Italy, the situation, as seen in this HQ., may involve considerable exchange of officials between the North and the South, which may compel me to turn to you for information in cases similar to these before I can properly send an official from the South into an Army area. This consideration is in my mind in asking you please to consider whether there is not some means of overcoming the difficulty.

Your Excellency:

1. I refer to the Ministry's letter no. 5000 (Dir. Gen. Personale) dated 5 December, and to subsequent letter under the same reference dated 23 December, enclosing biographical particulars of 18 Primi Consiglieri proposed for promotion to the rank of Vice Prefect Inspector.
2. As is known to the Ministry, this Sub Commission does not concern itself with promotions to a permanent rank in the hierarchy of functionaries of the Ministry. It is only concerned to approve or otherwise proposals to appoint officials to certain posts in a province. If any one of the 18 Consiglieri in question were proposed for appointment to exercise the inspective functions in a province, then it would be the duty of this Sub Commission to state to the Ministry whether or not the Allied Commission agreed to that proposal. The Sub Commission does not, however, concern itself with the rank of an official apart from the particular post he is proposed to occupy.
3. The 18 Consiglieri in question have, therefore, been considered for the object of determining whether they would be acceptable to the Allied Commission for discharging the inspective functions in Italian or Military Government Territory.

SUBJECT: Proposed promotions to VPI.

6 January 1945

TO : Director.

1. Papers 1 - 5 in this file contain particulars of the Ministry's proposal to raise 13 Consiglieri di 1^o classe (Grade VII) to the rank of Vice Prefect Inspector (Grade VI).
2. In the first place, I suggest AC is not concerned with the rank of any Italian official but only with the appointment for which he may be proposed. If the Italian Government like to propose e.g. a Consigliere for the post of VPI, the fact that the nominee is of junior rank is no concern of ours. We are only concerned to see that the official personally is (a) non-fascist (b) cooperative (c) reasonable efficient. This point has been made to the Ministry before.

3. The present nominations should therefore be examined for the purpose of determining which of them could be accepted as VPI's in A/G territory.

If the Italian Government like to propose e.g. a Consigliere for the post of VEV, the fact that the nominee is of junior rank is no concern of ours. We are only concerned to see that the official personally is (a) non-Fascist (b) cooperative (c) reasonable efficient. This point has been made to the Ministry before.

3. The present nominations should therefore be examined for the purpose of determining which of them could be accepted as VEV's in AMG territory.

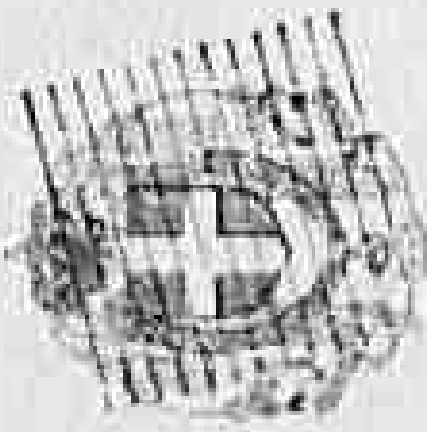

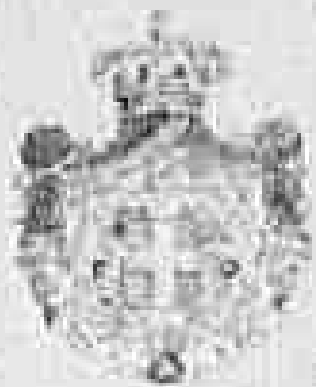

1. We referred to the Ministry letter (129 on the file) submitting the names of 14 consiglieri 1^o classe whom the Ministry propose to promote to the rank of Vice Prefect Inspector. We said we should like biographical particulars of these. One or two were already known to us: we should let the Ministry know in which case we now desire such particulars.

2. We proposed then to have them screened and according to the results of the screening inform the Ministry which of them were acceptable to the Allied Commission for service in Military Government Territory.

3. We then outlined our idea as to the reconstituting a pool of junior officials for service in the northern provinces as follows:

(a) We should be prepared with a certain number of officials who could act as :

(i) VFPV or VPI

(ii) in junior posts on the administrative side (consiglieri and segretari)

(iii) on the Accountancy side (rag. in various grades) .

(b) In each of these three groups there should be a certain number ready here in Rome : they should not be kept idle but employed in the Ministry.

(c) There must be sure to be a certain number in each of the three groups from those now serving in provinces in the south: they too should remain working in their provinces at present.

(d) The idea was to have enough in each group-here in Rome or in the provinces-sufficient to answer the first few demands in newly liberated provinces where there was nobody on the spot who was available (our could be kept in office, to discharge the requisite functions, while we are satisfying these first few demands from the pool, we should have time to build it up again for later demands.

(e) Members of the pool in Rome would be regarded as the first line of reinforcements. As they were drawn upon, members of the pool in the provinces would be called up to Rome to take their places.

4. MICALI drew attention to the absolute importance of knowing as soon as possible what officials discovered in the newly liberated provinces could be used, and particularly whether if they could not be used in that province they could be used in another further south. We agreed: we said it was always our endeavor to obtain information of this kind and have officials who might be usable elsewhere sent to Rome to report to the Ministry. We said there were already instructions out on this and we would consider the advisability of renewing or emphasizing them. MICALI and BERRUTI also drew attention to the extreme shortage of officials ---BERRUTI saying that whereas they had normally a roll of career officials in the directing grades of about 1,300 or 1,400 they had now only some 1000. We said we fully appreciated this but did not ask for large numbers.

5. We suggested that the Ministry should now take a few days to review their resources and consider how many and who they could recommend in the pool and we would have a further discussion with them next week.

SUBJECT : Career Prefectural Officials

TO : His Excellency the Minister of the Interior,

Your Excellency :

1. In view of the certainty that the Allies will shortly drive the Germans out of northern Italy, I feel it my duty to report to you that it would appear that the number of officials we still require for the efficient administration of these northern provinces is perilously low.
2. Secondly, it must be pointed out that from my personal observations a certain number of the Prefects no longer possess the virility and energy which is necessary to the efficient administration of these provinces, since it is certain they will be confronted with very difficult tasks,
3. It has been brought to my notice - and I can confirm this personally - that there are a considerable number of young men in the Prefectural and administrative services who could, in my judgment, perform such duties efficiently, but they are prevented from being appointed to such office because of their juniority in grade. I do think therefore that it would be wise to give this matter consideration and to be objective and substantive, I suggest that such as are outstanding should be promoted in grade in order that they may be nominated as Prefects or Vice Prefects in these forward appointments.
4. I feel that if you will give this matter your consideration, it cannot but have a healthy effect on the efficient administration of these northern provinces which we hope will soon be liberated from the yoke of the enemy,
