In it, the children of the above-mentioned Priore Alberto invoke their father's liberty, who was arrested 4 Nov, 1943, by the British Police at Montenero di Bisaccia (Campobasso) and interned in Concentration Camp of Crumo Appula (Bari).

This case is directed to the Hon. Commission for consideration, for reasons given by the writers, who affirm that the parent has been the victim of calumny-story and is a painful family situation.
