Dec 27 th	Director: 1. Reference CABONI who was Prefect of Agrigento ^{and} was removed from office by the Allies and interned. 2. In Jan last the Italian Govt asked permission to reemploy CABONI and certain other Prefects work who had been similarly removed. 3. Permission was given in certain other cases but the CABONI request was refused. 4. In the meantime the Ministry have made various enquiries as to the possibility of CABONI being released particularly on account of his wife's previous state of health. 5. He was released on 29 Aug. 6. He called at this office today and asked if AC. would intimate to the Ministry that they (AC) "had nothing against him" with a view to his recognition and possible employment by the Ministry. 7. Told him I was unable personally to indicate that any such intimation would be given and further that no proposal had been received from the Ministry. If and when such a proposal was made his case would then be considered by AC. in the usual way. 8. He stressed the fear that on account of his internment his position with the Ministry was prejudiced & was endeavouring to correct the intimation which he felt the Ministry officials had of keeping him out of office. 9. This matter was fully considered prior to 3 above and unless and until further grounds are submitted by the Ministry I suggest no further action be taken. N.B. 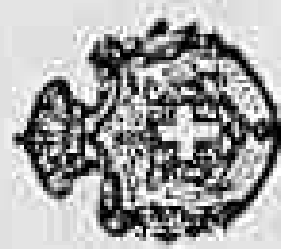
Stanislao Caboni - civil - 371 P.O.W. Camp, Italy.

1. The High Commissioner of SICILY has drawn my attention to the circumstances relating to the detention of the above former Prefect of AGRIGENTO and now in custody of the U.S. authorities in Africa.
2. By memorandum No. 1080 of 10 March 44, from Minister of Interior REALE, his wife was informed that arrangements for freeing her husband had been made from 28 JAN 44.
3. Whether these arrangements were in fact made or not, a study of the case leads me to the conclusion that an error was made in interning this Civil Servant of 35 years service. My opinion is supported by the present Prefect of AGRIGENTO, and I might add that on our occupation he co-operated most loyally with the then S.C.A.O., Lt Col MacCaffrey, who reported favourably upon him.
4. His wife is in a state of poor health aggravated by anxiety for her husband, and is about to undergo a surgical operation.
5. It will be appreciated if this internment may be reviewed with a view to Dr CABONI's early release.

1. The High Commissioner of SICILY has drawn my attention to the circumstances relating to the detention of the above former Prefect of AGRIGENTO and now in the custody of the U.S. authorities in Africa.

2. By memorandum No. 1080 of 10 MAR 44, from Minister of Interior REALE, his wife was informed that arrangements for freeing her husband had been made from 28 JAN 44.

3. Whether these arrangements were in fact made or not, a study of the case leads me to the conclusion that an error was made in interning this Civil Servant of 35 years service. My opinion is supported by the present Prefect of AGRIGENTO, and I might add that on our occupation he co-operated most loyally with the then S.C.A.O., Lt Col MacCaffrey, who reported favourably upon him.

4. His wife is in a state of poor health aggravated by anxiety for her husband, and is about to undergo a surgical operation.

5. It will be appreciated if this internment may be reviewed with a view to Dr CABONI's early release.
