1. A request has been received from Marshal Badoglio for the repatriation, if possible, of Dr. Massimo Adolfo Vitale, a resident of Tangier, c/o the Clinic of Professor Bevarida. The Marshal states that Dr. Vitale is an ex-Prefect of Derna who retired to Tangier as a result of the racial laws of the fascist party.
2. If there is no objection on your part it is requested that Dr. Vitale be repatriated to Italy.
