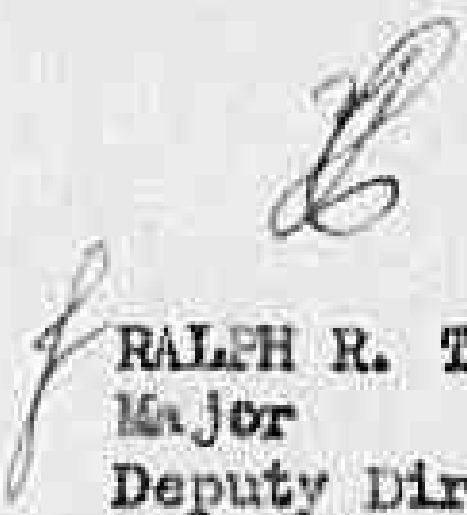

MEMORANDUM TO: All Sections and Independent Sub-Commissions

SUBJECT: Printing and Stationery Expenditures

1. In order to insure that the expenditure of public funds for printing and stationery is kept to an absolute minimum, the following procedure will be immediately adopted in this Headquarters.
2. In all cases involving printing and stationery expenditures, sections and independent subcommissions will submit with their final request to the Headquarters Commandant a certification that the project to cost approximately one lire is an absolute necessity for the efficient conduct of their business. The cost estimate will first be obtained from the Printing Officer, Headquarters Commandant's Office.
3. The Vice President of the Section will scrutinize the project and sign the certificate on projects in which the cost is in excess of 200,000 lire; the Headquarters Commandant will then further certify on such project that the proposed expenditure is the lowest at which the project can be accomplished under existing conditions before submitting to Executive Commissioner for approval.
4. It is understood that bids must be accepted within seven days for the contract to become operative in order to meet the rapidly fluctuating costs.

SUBJECT: Typewriters

TO : G-4, Naples

1. This Sub-Commission is still with one typewriter which has been allocated to it. I have, today, through the courtesy of Lt Darby, (A), been lent another in order to cope with the increasing work of this Sub-Commission.

2. I have found the pool of typists of little value, and I cannot work with the requisite efficiency unless I am supplied with further typewriters.

3. I would point out that when at Naples, I had three typewriters allocated to this Sub-Commission, and that I did not leave any rear link there. I was definitely assured by the officer, whose name I cannot remember, that the same complement of typewriters would be available to me on arrival at Salerno, though not necessarily the same machines. This has not proved to be so, and the efficiency of this Sub-Commission is being embarrassed by the lack of typewriters.

4. I should be grateful, therefore, if you would do everything possible in your power to supply this Sub-Commission with two additional typewriters at an early date.

5. I do not consider it right or fair to ask officers to purchase typewriters for official use. With the increasing work of this Sub-Commission, the position is unsatisfactory, and I trust that you will see your way to remedy this serious state of affairs.

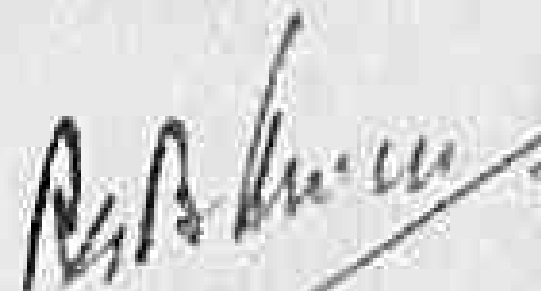

Col. Spicer:

Sgt. Tappicea has canvassed the situation with respect to obtaining a supply of printable blank cards. They are not available through G-4. However, there is a private firm in Naples which can supply up to 20,000, plain white or lined, approximately the size of the sample attached. Sgt. D was advised that they would have to be paid for, as the stocks have recently been frozen.

At a conservative estimate, we shall need a minimum of 100 for each province, including communal officers, and not allowing for changes and replacements. There are 94 provinces in Italy.

If we order a quantity (10,000) plain white cards now, we experiment as to the format, and, when the latter has been decided upon, have them printed accordingly, as the need arises.

What is your recommendation?

1. That we try get the 20,000 available now. Not?

2. That you see G-4. with necessary finance but the position to them. Obtain authority to purchase.

3. A Card index Card is also a necessity. Yes
