1. Notice is hereby given that the allied military government will terminate within your province at 24.00 hours on 31 December 1945. The Italian Government will resume administration of your province at the same hour.
2. In order to give effect to this transfer, the Supreme Allied Commander and Military Governor has issued Proclamation No. 16 (H) a copy of which is attached hereto. Copies for publication are being forwarded under separate cover.
3. In order to make clear the terms upon which the Italian Government will resume the administration of the provinces mentioned in the above proclamation No. 16 (H), Dott. Alcide De Gasperi, President of the Council of Ministers has issued a proclamation a copy of which is appended hereto. Copies for publication are being forwarded under separate cover.
4. In order to avoid any possibility of misunderstanding as to the position of persons who have been nominated to or removed from appointments by, the Italian Government has passed Legislative Decree of the Lieutenant General No. 374 of 31 August 1945 a copy of which is attached hereto.
5. You will ensure that the contents of this notice are brought to the attention of all Italian and other persons within your province who are in any way responsible for or connected with the administration hereof.

ALLIED MILITARY GOVERNMENT OF OCCUPIED ITALY

PROCLAMATION No. 16 (H)

"WHEREAS, I assumed all powers of government and jurisdiction in the territory of Italy occupied by my troops and over its inhabitants and military government was established to exercise these powers in such territory under my direction, and

"WHEREAS, in the exercise of such powers, Proclamations and Orders have been issued from time to time by me or by my predecessors or under my or their authority throughout such territory, and

"WHEREAS, the United Nations have consented at the request of the Italian Government to restore as much of the said occupied territory to the jurisdiction of the Italian Government as may be compatible with military exigencies;

NOW, WHEREAS, I, William D. Organ, K.C.B., D.S.O., M.C., Lieutenant-General, Supreme Allied Commander Mediterranean Theatre and Military Governor, hereby proclaim as follows:

Allied Military Government established by me or by my predecessors and all Proclamations and Orders heretofore issued by me or by them or under my or their authority in that portion of Italy comprising the whole of Metropolitan territory at present under Allied Military Government including the Comunes of Colle Salvetti, Livorno, Pisa and Piombino, and the Islands of Elba, Giglio and Pantelleria, but excluding Venezia Giulia and the Province of Udine, are hereby terminated as of 21.00 hours on the 31st day of December 1945. The Italian Government will therefrom administer the above territory, subject to all powers, rights and immunities of the United Nations and of the Supreme Allied Commander, Mediterranean Theatre and the Allied Commission.

PROCLAMATION

To the Italian people:

The United Nations have acceded to the request of the Italian Government that further territory, in addition to that already restored, be restored to Italian Government administration as of today's date, in accordance with the terms and conditions necessary for military requirements.

The provisions hereof concern the whole of metropolitan territory at present under Allied Military Government including the Communes of Colle Salvetti, Livorno, Naples and Pisa, and the Islands of Lampedusa, Linosa and Pantelleria, but excluding Venezia Giulia and the Province of Udine.

The restoration is subject to the following conditions:

1. Military Government in the territory restored as of this date having been terminated by the Allied Military Government, all powers of government and jurisdiction in the territory restored and over its inhabitants, and final administrative responsibility, subject only to the rights reserved to the United Nations, are vested in the Government of Italy.
2. All Proclamations and Orders heretofore issued by the Military Governor or under his authority by his delegates in the said territory and which have been terminated therein by the Military Governor as upon its restoration, are hereby recognised by the Italian Government as having been validly issued during the time they were operative and are declared to be of the same legal effect as if they had been issued by the Italian Government in accordance with Italian law, and they will be so recognised by all Italian courts and officials.
3. All acts done by any member of the Allied Forces in pursuance of such Proclamations or Orders, and all official action of any nature taken by the Allied Military Government in pursuance thereof including all appointments to and removals from any office, public or private, will be recognised by all Italian courts and officials as legal, valid and binding.
4. All sentences imposed by Allied Military Courts are hereby recognised by the Italian Government as valid and legal and of the same effect as if imposed by an Italian court and will be so recognised by all Italian courts and Italian officials unless set aside or modified by or with the consent of the Allied Commission.

Art. 1.

A tutti gli effetti della legge italiana, le nomine ad uffici pubblici conferite dal Governo Militare Alleato nei territori ad esso soggetti, hanno carattere d'incarichi temporanei.

Art. 2.

Coloro che, all'atto del ritorno dei territori all'Amministrazione italiana, si trovino preposti a pubblici uffici, in virtù di disposizioni del Governo Militare Alleato, continuano ad esercitare le loro funzioni fino a quando non siano sostituiti dalla competente autorità del Governo italiano, salvo la loro eventuale immissione in ruolo.

AI fini del trattamento economico spettante per detti incarichi, le persone estranee all'Amministrazione sono equiparate ai dipendenti di ruolo del grado gerarchico cui corrispondono le funzioni ad esse affidate. Tale equiparazione è disposta con decreto del Ministro competente, di concerto con quello per il tesoro.

Qualora trattisi di funzioni esercitate, da parte di estranei all'Amministrazione, in enti pubblici diversi dallo Stato è corrisposto il trattamento economico previsto dalle vigenti disposizioni o dai rispettivi ordinamenti per la carica cui le funzioni stesse corrispondano.

Art. 3.

I dipendenti dello Stato e degli enti previsti dall'Art. II del decreto legislativo Luogotenenziale 27 luglio 1944, n. 159, rimossi dall'ufficio o licenziati per

motivi di epurazione, dal Governo Militare Alleato, s'intendono sospesi cautelarmente dall'ufficio ai sensi dell'art. 22, terzo comma, del decreto legislativo Luogotenenziale 27 luglio 1944, n. 159.

Detta sospensione decorre dal giorno in cui i provvedimenti sindacati vennero adottati.

La contestazione degli addebiti, ai fini del giudizio di epurazione, deve essere fatta entro tre mesi dal giorno della restituzione all'Amministrazione italiana dei territori in cui detti provvedimenti vennero adottati o, se trattasi di territori già restituiti, dal giorno della entrata in vigore del presente decreto.

E' fatto salvo ogni diverso provvedimento disciplinare da adottare nei confronti di detti dipendenti, in conseguenza di procedimenti penali istituiti a loro carico.

Art. 4.

Le disposizioni del presente decreto valgono anche per i provvedimenti adottati dal Governo Militare Alleato nei territori che, all'atto della entrata in vigore del decreto stesso, siano già stati restituiti all'Amministrazione Italiana.

Art. 5.

Il presente decreto entra in vigore il giorno successivo a quello della sua pubblicazione nella *Gazzetta Ufficiale* del Regno.

The provisions of Executive Memorandum No. 77/45 para 5 (e) will apply with regard to the issue of these passes.

Prohibited Frontier Zone, and Prohibited Frontier Zone Line.

(b) Movement of civilians inside the zone is restricted to 10 kms., and movement into or out of the zone is forbidden unless such civilians are in possession of movement of Civilian Passes. Passes may be issued at the point of departure by AAC Officers.

5. The license or passes to the Special Control Zone and / or prohibited - restricted Zone shall only be made to exceptional cases and limited to those persons who allow food and sufficient persons in another cities to travel whether on railroad, tube, road, the mail-road. No passes are required within cities area.
6. Movement is free in the areas to the west of the Security Control Line and the prohibited - restricted Zone Line, and this includes movement between the Italian and Sicily, Sicily, and Malta.
7. The license or passes will be a public Security responsibility.
8. Special attention is drawn to the fact that persons wishing to leave Italy must be in possession of Security Control Authorization or certificate of selection before crossing them to leave the country.
9. Members of the Italian Armed Forces may be sent on duty and on leave to places to the left of the Security Control Zone and will be subject to movement into the Security Control Zone and prohibited - restricted Zone.
10. Provisions of Executive Regulation No. 77/45, which will be implemented, will continue to apply where

Coast V 131970 - V343970, thence along road through Monterotondo, Montieri and Chiudino to inter-Army boundary at Road Junction Q677043.

2. Effective the same time Grosseto Province is turned over for all purposes to Regional control.

3. The communes of Piombino, Camiglia and Suvereto are in rear of the new rear boundary, but in conformity with the established practice of avoiding divided responsibility for the administration of a Province, no change in the status of Livorno Province is proposed at the present time and the Provincial Commissioner will remain responsible to this Headquarters for the whole of the Province.

1. Consequent on the Eighth Army's advance an adjustment of its Rear Boundary has been made leaving only a small part of Campobasso Province within the Army area.

2. The only part remaining is forward of a line along the road CASTIGLIONE - CARPINONE - ISERNIA thence South to the Provincial Boundary at VALLE CRICOLA.

4. The following conditions will apply until further notice:-
