OPERATIONAL ORDER No. 1.

1. INFORMATION

(a) Enemy Troops. Action may be expected in the form of raids on harbour and shipping, small seaborne landing, parachute troops or internal saboteurs. Gas and bacterii may be used.

(b) Own Troops. As shown in No. 1 Zone Operational Instruction No. 1.
(May be seen on request to Hq. Commandant)

2. INTENTION.

Enemy attacks against premises occupied by this Headquarters will be repelled.

3. METHOD.

(a) In the event of an alert due to enemy action as laid down in paragraph 1(a) above, the alarm will be given by continuous blasts on whistles. In addition Offices will be warned by telephone from the central switchboard.

(b) In such event all detailed active personnel will parade immediately outside the armoury located on the first floor of the Palace of Justice, Room 118, under their Squad Commanders (Appendix 1A), draw rifles and ammunition and proceed to their alarm posts as detailed below.

(c) All Allied personnel inside or in the immediate vicinity of A.C.C. Buildings other than those detailed in Appendix 1A will remain at normal posts of duty or obey such orders as may be issued by the Headquarters Commandant.

(d) Personnel away from the immediate vicinity (2 miles) of Headquarters will report to the nearest military unit.

(e) All Civilians i.e. employees or visitors will assemble on the first floor in Court Room number 101 and will await instructions.

(f) O.C.'s Detachments A and B will be prepared to protect the areas and Government property, in addition to furnishing any mobile detachments required.

(g) R.V. for Mobile Platoon: Sgt's Mess, Ground Floor, Palace of Justice.

4. ADMINISTRATION.

(a) All ranks will be under the orders of the Headquarters Commandant.

(b) O.C.'s A and B transport will assemble all available transport within respective garages, prepared to proceed on orders from the Headquarters Commandant.

(c) O.C.'s transport and personnel Companies A and B, the Headquarters Supply

2. INTENTION.

 - (c) All Allied personnel inside or in the immediate vicinity of A.C.C. Buildings other than those detailed in Appendix "A" will remain at normal posts of duty or obey such orders as may be issued by the Headquarters Commandant.
 - (d) Personnel away from the immediate vicinity (2 miles) of Headquarters will report to the nearest military unit.
 - (e) All Civilians i.e. employees or visitors will assemble on the first floor in Court Room number 101 and will await instructions.
 - (f) O.C.'s Detachments A and B will be prepared to protect the areas and Government property, in addition to furnishing any mobile detachments required.
 - (g) R.V. for Mobile Platoon: Sgts Mess, Ground Floor, Palace of Justice.
- ## 4. ADMINISTRATION.
- (a) All ranks will be under the orders of the Headquarters Commandant.
 - (b) O.C.'s A and B transport will assemble all available transport within respective garages, prepared to proceed on orders from the Headquarters Commandant.
 - (c) O.C.'s transport and personnel Companies A and B, the Headquarters Supply Officer, the C.Q.M.S. British, the Messing Officer, the Medical Officer, will submit forthwith to the Headquarters Commandant their arrangements in accordance with these instructions. 3643
 - (d) All ranks will be made thoroughly familiar with the lay-out of the vulnerable points of the Headquarters (See Appendix "B").
 - (e) Main Gates at Entrances A, B, C, and D (See Appendix "B") will be closed and barred.
 - (f) The Medical Officer will establish an Emergency First Aid Post with necessary equipment in Room No. 8, Ground Floor, this Headquarters.
 - (g) Headquarters Supply Officer will maintain emergency rations scale covering a period of 48 hours.

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(h) Casualties; -

Service personnel - normal
Civilian personnel - Ospedale Riuniti.

Ammunition;

50 rounds per man first issue.

3. INTER-COMMUNICATION.

Headquarters established in rooms 28, 29 and 30, ground floor, Palace of Justice.

4. COMMUNICATION.

1. Internal telephone communication.
2. By runner.

(a) 2 Liaison Officers or M.C.O.s. will report in person to Headquarters Commandant's Officer from all Sub-Commissions when their personnel have complied with the above instructions. In addition telephone reports to this effect will be made.

(b) An Officer will be detailed by the Headquarters Commandant for Liaison Duties at the Headquarters of No. 1 Zone Commander. (Appendix B)

(c) Telephone and teletype operators of this Headquarters will remain at their posts.

(d) C.C. Transport will hold 4 Jeeps for despatch purposes at the disposal of the Headquarters Commandant.

Appendix "A"

Reference Operational Order No. 1.

Officers commanding A and B Detachments will detail EM, CRs, and NCO's to act as defense troops to protect all vulnerable points of this Headquarters and will submit nominal rolls to Headquarters Commandant forthwith. O.C. Transport will instruct attached Italian soldiers under their Detachment Commander in regard to the defense of the garage.

After the alarm has been given all nominated personnel will parade under their respective Squad Commander at the armory. Squad Commanders will supervise the drawing of arms and ammunition and will immediately take up defensive positions at their allocated posts. See Appendix "B".

Within 48 hours after the issue of this Operational Order instructions will be issued for a meeting of all Operational Commanders with the Headquarters Commandant when their detailed instructions will be given.

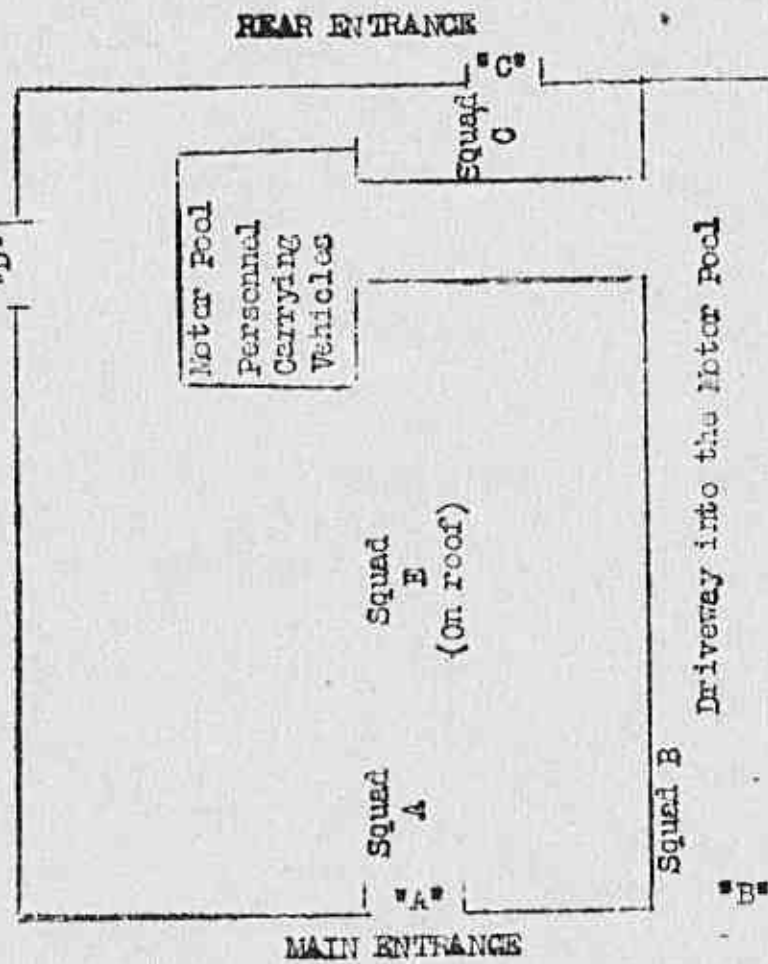
