DISCONTINUANCE OF NAFGD

W. 21 JUN 1946

1. Naples Air Force General Depot is discontinued in the vicinity of Naples, Italy, effective 2359B hours 30 June 1946. This organization became nonoperational at 2359B hours on 15 June 1946.
2. Personnel will be transferred in accordance with directives previously issued by Assistant Chief of Staff, G-1, this headquarters.
3. Equipment will be disposed of as previously directed by Assistant Chief of Staff, G-4, this headquarters.
4. Records will be disposed of as outlined in Circulars Number 35 and Number 85, both this headquarters, 1946.
5. Surplus funds will be closed out as directed in Redeployment Circular Number 9, this headquarters, 1945, and will be made payable to Custodian, MTOUSA Central Welfare Fund.
6. NAP Form Number 11 will be prepared for each member of the command, including those transferred from the organization during the 60 day period preceding discontinuance, indicating name of the unit to which the individual was or is scheduled to be transferred. The completed forms will be delivered on or before date of discontinuance to the Postal Officer of the Army Post Office serving the discontinued unit. NAP Forms Number 11 are available at Army Post Offices.
7. The Commanding Officer of NAFGD will furnish a certificate to the Civilian Personnel Officer, this headquarters, stating that all Italian civilian employees have been paid up to date, or that arrangements have been made with the section concerned for their payment, and that each Italian civilian employee has been furnished with Workers Social Insurance Card, Allied Forces in Italy (Form SI-March 1945).
8. True copies of the AES Unit Ration Card as of the date of discontinuance will be furnished all units or installations which are scheduled to receive personnel from the discontinued organization.
9. a. Final rosters will be prepared and forwarded in accordance with AR 345-900, as amended.
- b. The appropriate data will be entered in the Morning Reports as provided for in Section IV, AR 345-400, dated 3 January 1945, as modified by letter, Headquarters, MTOUSA, file AG 330.33/430 STAT-O, dated 20 March 1945, subject: "Morning Report" and letters file and subject as above, dated 12 May 1945 and 16 June 1945, respectively.

10. Confirmation of discontinuance will be reported to this headquarters without delay. Paragraph 17c, AR 310-50, dated 1 December 1944, will be complied with.

11. Fifteen (15) copies of the accomplishing orders will be furnished this headquarters.

1. Pursuant to authority contained in letter, Headquarters MTOUSA, file 322/164 A-O, subject: "Organization of Allied Commission, (U.S. Contingent)," dated 30 September 1943, Company "O" 2675th Regiment, Allied Commission, (Ovhd), is discontinued effective 2400 hours 10 June 1946.
2. Officers and enlisted men assigned to Company "O" will be reassigned on orders from Headquarters this Regiment.
3. a. Final roster will be prepared in accordance with Paragraph 13, AR 345-900, and three copies will be forwarded to this Headquarters on 11 June 1946.
b. Final morning reports (both original and UPS copies) will be forwarded to this Headquarters with final rosters. The appropriate data will be entered in the morning report in accordance with Paragraph 38, AR 345-400.
c. Organization files of record will be processed and disposed of in strict compliance with Circular No. 35, Headquarters MTOUSA, dated 12 March 1946. The organization's serial files of Army Regulations, War Department Circulars and MTOUSA Circulars will be returned to this Headquarters. Service records after proper indorsement have been completed and records have been checked and brought up to date, will be furnished to the Commanding Officers of the units to which enlisted men are transferred.
4. United States government property will be cleared as directed in separate instructions issued by S-4, this Regiment.
5. The Commanding Officer of Company "O" will prepare NAP form 11 for each member of the unit, including all personnel who have been members of the unit during the past 60 days, showing the unit to which each was or will be transferred. The completed forms will be delivered without delay to the Postal Officer, APO 794.
