- 1. Major Temple asked H.E. Berruti if there were any officials of the Ministry of Interior who might be in Switzerland, having left their positions as a result of their anti-fascist views, as there was a possibility that inquiries could be made about them.
- Berruti replied that he only knew of two and gave their names:

TRINCHERO Mario: Prefect formerly of Bologna.
MANUSHINI Giuspppe: Vice Prefect formerly of Verezia.

3. Major Temple informed Berruti that this should be treated as confidential. If any information was obtained about these two officials it would be passed on to the Ministry in due course.
