NOTE OF INTERVIEW with H. E. BERRUTI and Dott. CAMERA.

SUBJECT: Italian officials in Switzerland.

INTERVIEWED BY: Major R.R. Temple, Chief Executive Officer, Local Government Sub Commission and Captain W.I. Cunningham.

DATE: 27th March, 1945.

INTERPRETER: Signore Arrigo NICE.

1. Major Temple asked H.E. Berruti if there were any officials of the Ministry of Interior who might be in Switzerland, having left their positions as a result of their anti-fascist views, as there was a possibility that inquiries could be made about them.

2. Berruti replied that he only knew of two and gave their names:

TRINGHERO Mario: Prefect formerly of Bologna.

MENDOCHINI Giuseppe: Vice Prefect formerly of Venezia.

3. Major Temple informed Berruti that this should be treated as confidential. If any information was obtained about these two officials it would be passed on to the Ministry in due course.
