2. The following instructions have been received from A.F.P.Q. regarding cases where it is found necessary to withhold permits for political meetings:
  - a. "When important political meetings are banned, short official announcements should be made, giving reasons and the text wired to A.M.G. Headquarters. This should combat unfavourable comments and propaganda."
  - b. "Whenever in the exercise of your authority and discretion action has to be taken involving the denial of authority for any political meeting, you are requested to inform this Headquarters by cable without delay :
    - (1) Nature of meeting which will not be authorized.
    - (2) Auspices under which it was to be held.
    - (3) Date, time and place proposed.
    - (4) Brief reasons for prohibition.
    - (5) Text of official announcement made."

As a supplement to the rules given in Order No. 17, dated 1944, relative to the freedom of meeting for political parties, I, CHARLES POLETTI, Lt Colonel, Regional Civil Affairs Officer by virtue of powers conferred upon me

ORDER

1. That the promoters of the meetings must conform to the rules given in ART. 18 of the Italian Public Safety Laws, which requires three days notice to be given to the Public Safety Authority.
2. All parades, demonstrations and public manifestations are prohibited without the special permission of the Public Safety Authority.
3. All political pamphlets must show clearly on the front the name of the author or the names of the persons belonging to the Committee which published such pamphlets, and the name of the publisher.
4. Before publication of the aforesaid pamphlets, one copy must be deposited with the Public Safety Authority.
5. It is prohibited to exhibit in public places or places that are open to the public any posters or writings of a political nature without the approval of the Public Safety Authority.
6. No person shall instigate any violence against Military or Civil Authorities.
7. In addition, the regulations for the publishings of papers, pamphlets and any other publication, remain in force under the control of P.W.A., Via Giostra 1, Palermo.
8. Any offender against the terms of this order will be punished according the law.

4. Prima della pubblicazione degli opuscoli in parola, una copia dovrà essere depositata presso le autorità di Pubblica Sicurezza;
5. E' vietato affiggere in luoghi pubblici ed aperti al pubblico manifesti e scritti di natura politica senza l'approvazione della autorità di Pubblica Sicurezza;
6. Nessuna persona patrocinerà le violenze contro le Autorità Militari e Civili;
7. Inoltre rimangono ferme tutte le disposizioni in merito alla pubblicazione dei giornali, opuscoli ed ogni altra pubblicazione che restano sotto il controllo del P.D., Via Giostra 1, Palermo;
8. I contravventori alle disposizioni di quest'ordinanza verranno puniti ai sensi della Legge.
