TO : All Concerned.

1. All recommendations for the promotion of enlisted men will be submitted in one copy to the Commanding Officer, 2675th Regiment through the Company Commander on the form attached as Inclosure 1. Particular attention will be given to include the figures showing authorized grades based on the latest Table of Allotment (cf. Inclosure 2) and actual grades assigned as shown on the organizational Turning Report of the date on which the Promotion Form is initiated.

2. All promotions of enlisted men will be announced in Regimental Special Orders except those from Private to Private First Class which are announced in Company Orders.

3. Enlisted personnel will be promoted only one grade at a time. In compliance with RAC and AFSA Directives the following periods of time are considered as minimum time in grade for eligibility for promotion to the next higher grade:

Private to Private First Class	1 Month
Private First Class to Corporal	2 Months
Corporal to Sergeant	3 Months
Sergeant to Staff Sergeant	4 Months
Staff Sergeant to Tech Sergeant	5 Months
Tech Sergeant to Master Sergeant	6 Months

The periods listed above are not to be considered as either the average time an individual should remain in grade or as entitling the enlisted man to promotion upon completion thereof.

4. Personnel will be promoted only as a result of their demonstrated fitness for the responsibilities and duties of the position and grade for which recommended.

SUBJECT: Promotion of Pfc. Paul E. Carr, 33752776.

5 October 1945

TO : Commanding Officer, 2675th Regiment.

1. I again want to bring to your special attention my recommendation for the promotion of Pfc. Carr, the only American enlisted man serving in this Sub Commission, having been employed by it since 10 October 1944.
2. With the curtailment of office personnel, more and more responsibility has been thrown on the shoulders of this very capable man. As confidential stenographer and clerk, Pfc. Carr has had to handle documents of the greatest importance to the Allied Commission, involving the highest levels in the Italian and Allied Governments. Recently, in the absence of the British Chief Clerk who is on LIAP, Pfc. Carr has in addition had to perform the latter's duties which involve the supervision of 4 Italian civilians. He has consistently performed his work in a superior manner to the complete satisfaction of myself and all the officers of the Sub Commission. He enjoys the confidence of all because of his ability and tact in the performance of his work.
3. I wish to point out that Pfc. Carr's predecessor possessed the rank of Technical Sergeant, an indication of the fact that Carr has been greatly under-ranked ever since he started working here. As pointed out above, in the last several months his duties and responsibilities have increased and there is every indication, because of the nature of the work of this Sub Commission, that they will continue to increase. It is becoming more and more his lot to assist in the preparation of papers requiring the direct attention and signature of the Chief Commissioner.
4. I strongly recommend the promotion of Pfc. Carr to the highest grade possible.

SUBJECT: Eligibility for Enlisted Promotions.

TO : Acting Director, Local Government, Allied Commission, APO 394

1. It is desired that the attached sheets be completed by you so as to provide information which this headquarters may utilize in the future, to facilitate meritorious distribution of promotions. All enlisted men except 1st Sergeants and Master Sergeants will be included.

2. THESE FORMS SHOULD BE COMPLETED AS EXPEDITIOUSLY AS POSSIBLE. Only one copy need be forwarded. (Room 28, 6th Floor)

3. Use a separate form for each grade. For example, Grade Three (will include Staff Sergeants and Technicians 3rd Grade); Grade Four (will include Sergeants and Technicians 4th Grade); Grade Five (will include Corporals and Technicians 5th Grade).

4. Priority will be indicated within each grade in last column, considering each grade separately. For example, if Company "Z" has a combination of 20 Tec 5's and Corporals, and it is desired to recommend four for promotion, the numeral "1" will be placed in the last column opposite the name of the man most highly recommended, "2" opposite the next highest, etc.

5. This compilation will NOT include men with an Adjusted Service Rating Score of 85 or over.
