SUBJECT: Air Travel - Miss P. Rasmussen

TO: Priorities Officer,
R.A.F. Transport Command,
ROME

Miss Phyllis Rasmussen, British Civilian, who is employed in my office handling the work of a Junior Officer, is scheduled to terminate her service with the Allied Commission on 25 October 1945. Her departure was planned to be coincident with the return of an officer from U.K. who is at present on LIAP. However, I have been informed that that officer, because of his low release group, is to be retained in England.

It is therefore absolutely essential for the carrying out of the work of my Sub-Commission that Miss Rasmussen prolong her service for one week to enable me to secure another officer. Miss Rasmussen has consented to remain for that period.

The failure of the regular officer to return from U.K. has made it impossible for me to send my Deputy, Major C.G.R. Williams, to London to consult with local government experts there concerning British voting procedure. This information is urgently needed by the Italian Ministry of the Interior in order to enable them to properly frame a similar type of legislation for certain categories of voters.

Miss Rasmussen, who has been working on election matters with us, has been thoroughly briefed and has been instructed by me to consult with these experts and arrange for the transmission of the requisite information by special messenger or air mail.

She bears with her a letter from my Deputy, who is personally acquainted with the local government agent.

Inasmuch as Miss Rasmussen cannot be sent to U.K. for another ~~2959~~ and thereafter must perform with the greatest urgency the special mission described above, it is absolutely essential that she have a very high priority which will enable her to arrive in London not later than 2 November 1945.

SUBJECT : Civilians (r) for the Allied Commission (ITALY)

TO : Distribution below

1. It is desired to plan for the replacement, by civilians, of British Other Rank personnel in this HQ.
2. Will you, therefore, please make a survey of Other Rank posts which can be civilianised and forward your recommendations to this Branch giving the following information :-
 - (a) Qualifications of individuals or groups of individuals by equivalent army ranks, e.g. general duty clerks, shorthand typists, statisticians, office supervisors, specialists, etc.
 - (b) Any particular post which can be filled by an Italian civilian as opposed to a British civilian.
3. It will be assumed that civilians can be provided in equivalent army ranks from Private to W.O.1.
4. Please base your calculations on the phased programme assuming that our Sub-Commissions will remain very approximately at the same strength as at present for 3 months, but will then gradually decrease over a period of a further 3 months as responsibilities are handed back to the Italian Government.

1 C-5 AFHQ are preparing a study on the possibilities of the gradual replacement of military by civilian personnel within the ACC framework prior to the cessation of hostilities in Italy. In the event of it being decided that this can and should be done it is desired to attach to this study an appendix showing the posts now held by military personnel under ACC which could be occupied by civilians.

2 Directors of Sub-Commissions will please therefore submit on the attached pro-forma a list of posts in Sub-Commissions including their specialists with Regions in the field which could be filled by civilian representatives. This list will be returned without fail by 1200 hours on Thursday 27 July as the committee now studying this problem wish to leave on Friday morning.

3 This list should be in two parts:

Part I : officers who can be replaced during the continuance of hostilities.

Part II : officers who can be replaced after the cessation of hostilities and assuming also that very few combat troops remain in Italy.

4 In compiling the list under Part II, Directors can assume either that their functions at HQ and in the field will remain as at present or alternatively if they feel that in the circumstances envisaged in Part II it will not be necessary to maintain so large a staff at HQ or in the field they may so state in the remarks column, and in such case will show what total number of personnel will be required and which may be civilian.
