SUBJECT : Staff for Region VIII.

To : *Establishment Branch. HQ. ACC.*

Reference your let Q/28 of 4 May 44.

- 1 For two reasons it has not always been possible to draw the staffs required from Regions I, II and III as suggested.
 - a in some cases the staffs of these Regions have already been reduced to a minimum and no further officers can be spared from that territory.
 - b the persons particularly appropriate and required for Senior appointments in Region VIII are located elsewhere.
- 2 In discussing the question of ceilings it was made plain that in some cases (Legal in particular) Region VIII could only be staffed if some of the territory at present occupied was restored so that some of the staff at present employed there (e.g. Naples) could be released. This still applies. Legal have no spare staff and cannot earmark persons unless they know what areas are going to be released and when. Further, release of territory does not result in instant availability of staff. Legal anticipate that from one to two months must elapse from release of territory before any appreciable number of Legal officers could be withdrawn from it.
- 3 Subject to these remarks the persons to be earmarked are as shown on the attached list.
