SUBJECT: Rations for Civilian Driver.

10 November 1944.

TO : HQ, Commandant.

1. On 26 October 1944, Col. Spicer, Director, left for Naples, pursuant to orders on his way to Cairo, driving down in the automobile assigned to this Sub Commission, and driven by Oreste MARAZZI. Because of his haste in leaving, Col. Spicer failed to secure the necessary rations for the driver, as well as for himself. Beside that, he expected to send the driver back the same day.
2. However, it was necessary for Col. Spicer to retain the automobile and said driver for three days, the driver returning with the car on the 4th day. During this time the driver had to be provided with food at his own expense.
3. Since he was entitled to the rations and the same would have been provided had Col. Spicer applied for them, I would appreciate it if three-day rations were now provided for the driver by way of compensation for his outlay.
