SUBJECT: Personal secretary.

TO : VP Civil Affairs Section.

1. Nobody is better aware than yourself of the dearth of efficient shorthand stenographers in AC. When in Cairo, I had very strongly recommended to me a lady by the name of Mrs. Patricia Kenyon, a civilian, who is willing and anxious to come to this country.

2. I made definite inquiries in regard to Mrs. Kenyon and understand from reliable authority she is a high speed stenographer and also most competent, now working at the Embassy, but has resigned her position there since she does not feel that it carries sufficient responsibility.

3. I should be glad to have Mrs. Kenyon applied for and brought to this country to be my personal secretary, since I am now Director of two Sub Commissions. Her speed is 150 words a minute and she is well educated in every way. I presume this matter will be dealt with by G-1, should you approve, and the terms of salary, transport, etc. arranged by G-1.

4. I consider both Local Government and Patriots Branch have more than a full days' work for one stenographer--one to each branch to be used by my deputies and their subordinate officers who will have to take over themselves very much more of the work than hitherto. I, on the other hand, can find full employment for a personal secretary, who also is, incidentally, a shorthand typist, and I very much hope that if, as it is my desire, the Local Government Sub Commission is to retain its efficiency and the Patriots Branch is to become, under my direction, as efficient as the Local Government Sub Commission in its organization and effect, it will be agreed that a full time personal secretary is fully justified. I therefore hope you will pass this to G-1, and if necessary through the Chief of Staff, with your strong recommendation accordingly.
