1. Para 4 (a) of W.O. letter 124/Gen/64(GIS) of 27 Dec 44 authorizes certain workers of Voluntary Societies to be granted officer status in order to enable them to perform their functions within relief units.

2. Authority has now been delegated to this H.Q. to grant such status to personnel of voluntary societies in conjunction with the voluntary Societies concerned.

3. A signed authority will, therefore be issued to each individual so selected and this will be valid for the period during which the individual is working with the Allied Commission (Italy) only and may be revoked at any time in conjunction with the voluntary Society concerned.

Applications for such authorities :

1. Giving full name.
2. Location.
3. Name of Voluntary Society.
4. Brief details of duties.

4. FBI details of bullets, will be submitted to this H.Q. "for attention Establishment Section."

4. Para 4 (a) of W.O. Letter 124/Gon/64/(C.A.8) of 27 Dec 45 is reproduced below in amplification of the above and for easy reference.

W. H. Stead:

"4 Status."
(a) Certain workers of Voluntary Societies will have the relative status of officers of the Forces in order to enable them to perform their functions within Relief Units and in conjunction with the Civil Affairs but this will not debar them from any facilities accorded generally in these conditions of service to members of Relief Units. For all financial purposes and for the issue of equipment, clothing and necessities they will be regarded by the War Office as of Other Rank status. This Officer status may be granted before embarkation by agreement between the Relief Department of the Foreign Office and the War Office or by agreement between the appropriate Military Authority in the field and the individual."
