1. Ref. your request dated 4 April 1946.
2. Approval is given to the employment of SPARVIERI CSVALDO as a Interp/Tech. at a rate not exceeding 5390 Lire per day/month. Plus cost living bonus.
3. The minimum rate, which is 2860 Lire per day/month, will be paid for the first seven days, and may be increased commensurate with employee's skill and ability as set out in para. 2 above. It is policy of this Headquarters, as determined by AFHQ. Administrative Memorandum No. 47, dated 16th November 1944, that salaries of civilian employees will be increased gradually, in accordance with their performance, rather than immediately increased to the maximum on completion of the fourteen day probationary period.
4. Your attention is directed to Office Memo. No. 15, this Headquarters, dated 1st August 1944.
