The Sub-Commissions located at SALERNO will move by road to ROME on 9 Jul 44.

2 DETAIL

Offices of these Sub-Commissions will close at SALERNO at 1600 hours 8 Jul 44 and re-open at the same time at ROME.

a Transport: 8 - 3 ton lorries and 1 Staff Car will be provided by HQ Comit fully fuelled and oiled with reserve equal to tank capacity at the Palace of Justice at 0700 hours 9 Jul 44.

b Convoy Comdr: Lt Col S. H. WHITE.

c Assembly Point & Time: Hotel Vittoria, Cava. 0820 hrs.

d Starting Point & Time: Road junction N5935 (N of Cava) 0840 hrs.

e Route: To Naples, Route 18 thereafter Route 7.

f Speed and Density: 15 MPH 20 VPM, after 2100 hrs 40 VPM.

g Halts: For 1 hour at 1300 and 1900 hours:

for 15 min at 0915, 1100, 1500, 1700, 2100 hrs.

No furniture or fittings will be taken.

Sub-Commissions will prepare a list of their packages and their senior NCO will check that they are all loaded and hand a copy of the list to the transport officer who will obtain a receipt on his copy on giving delivery of the stores in Rome. He will remain responsible for the stores overnight and will satisfy himself as to their safe custody until delivery.

8 Officers and Officers baggage

Officers are responsible for seeing that their baggage is stacked in the appropriate place at either the Palazzo of Justice by 0630 hrs or the Hotel Vittoria, by 0730 hrs.

Officers living in Salerno will take their places in Lorry B before 0730 hrs. Those living at Casa will take the places allotted to them before 0830 hrs.

Officers are advised to take with them in their cars a haversack or small handbag with kit for the night, in case their kit is not delivered the same night. (The convoy is not due to arrive until about 2300 hrs).

Officers up to rank of Lt Col will probably be located at the Flora, will mark their kit conspicuously F and it will be packed on the F lorry.

Officers of the rank of Col will probably be accommodated at the Grand, will mark their kit with G and it will be carried on lorry G.

In addition all officers will ensure that their name is clearly displayed on the luggage and labels.

9 Deliveries:

If possible, personal baggage on lorries D F G will be offloaded on arrival at quarters in which case officers will take delivery of their kit. If this is not possible the baggage officer will be responsible for safe custody during the night and for arranging delivery next morning.

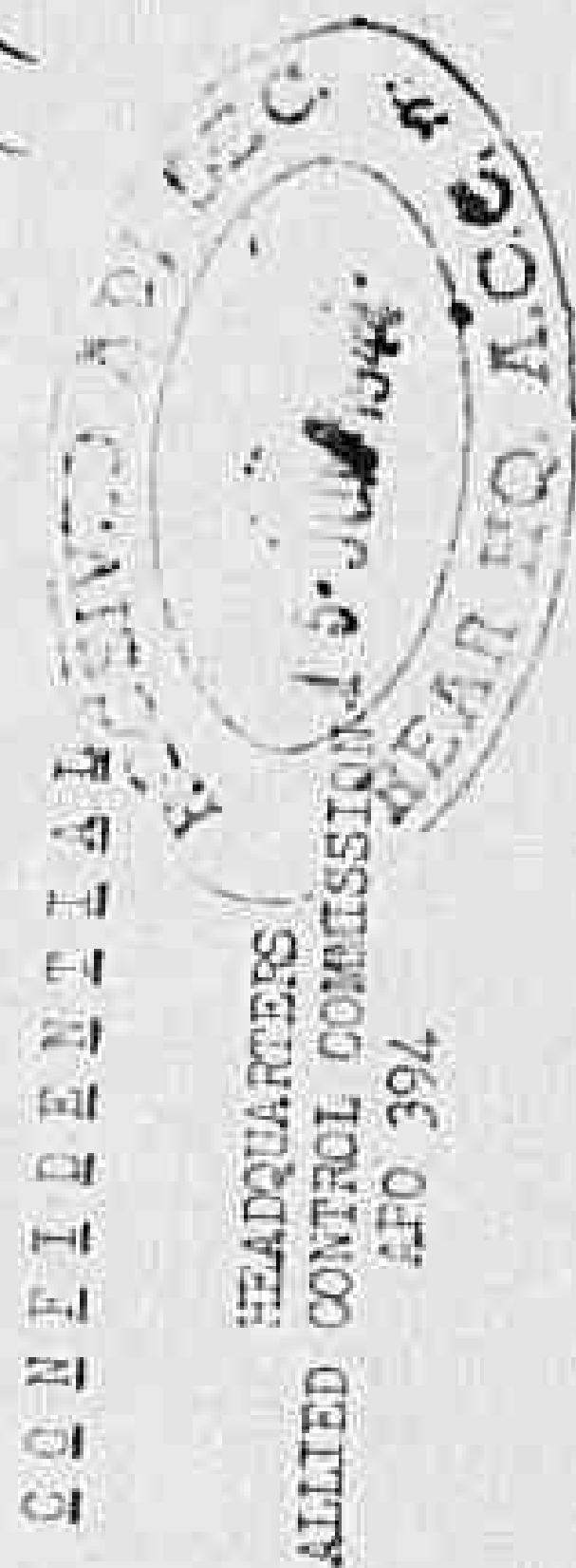

2. INTENTION.

ADVANCE HEADQUARTERS will move to ROME in two convoys on 15 June 1944.

3. METHOD.

- a. Comdr. Convoy A: Colonel M. H. MEANEY
Comdr. Convoy B: Lt Colonel H. T. W. MILLAR
- b. Vehicle Loading Table: See Appendix "A".
- c. Assembly Area A & B Convoys: PLAZZA PROVINCIA and VIA ARMANDO DIAZ, NAPLES.
Assembly Time: Convoy A complete 2330 hours, 14 June 1944.
Convoy B complete 0030 hours, 15 June 1944.
- d. (i) Start Point: W corner of PLAZZA PROVINCIA
(ii) Start Time: Convoy A, 0005 hours
Convoy B, 0100 hours
- e. Route: Route 7 - See Appendix "B".

One hour halt after each 5 hours.

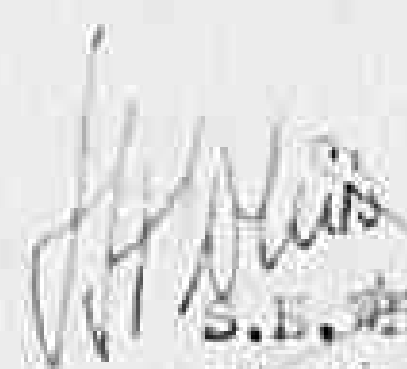

On the move from Brindisi to Salerno takes place, Capt Drage will act as Mess Secretary and Treasurer. Lt. Col Cripps will, if necessary, detail a part-time Mess Officer to assist.

8. Office Procedure at Salerno.

a. During the interim period, i.e. until the Brindisi - Salerno move takes place, no correspondence will be addressed to Salerno as an echelon of HQ, ACC. All correspondence and cables will be dealt with at Naples, and distributed to the Administrative Half Section from there by the twice-daily courier service.

b. Cable address of Salerno detachment is "Patima Forward", and there is now a direct telephone line.

9. Reallotment of Office Space at Naples.

a. Separate orders will be issued at an early date.

b. Under the revised office plan, no office space will be provided at HQ, ACC. Naples for Officers of the Administrative Half Section except as provided in the attached Memorandum to all concerned, dated 27 January 1944, i.e., for Vice President and PL, two Legal Officers and four (4) visiting Officers of Sub-Commissions. Any Officers not in this category who have special work in Naples must vacate their offices and arrange for office accommodation with Region III. They may continue to occupy HQ billets and use HQ Messes.

MOVEMENT TO SALERNO

1. Reference is made to Warning Order of today's date.

2. PERSONAL BAGGAGE - a. Baggage of officers who will move to SALERNO on 26 January 1944:

(1) Officers will pack as much baggage as will not be needed the night of 25 January, and prepare it for shipment, marking it clearly with name and rank. By 0900, 25 January, every officer will report to the Billeting Office, Headquarters Commandant's Section, the location and description of such baggage. This will be assembled during the day by the Headquarters Commandant's Section at a central point.

(2) On the morning of 26 January, the Headquarters Commandant will spot vehicles in front of, or near, each billet between 0700 and 0730 to pick up the remaining baggage. It is the responsibility of each officer to notify the Billeting Office, (Extension 39), before 1800, 25 January, where he wants this vehicle spotted. This baggage also should be clearly marked with the officer's name and rank. This baggage will then be carried to a central point.

(3) Baggage not ready by 0730 will have to be carried by the officer himself.

b. Officers moving to SALERNO on 27 January 1944:

(1) Same rules as the above, except that each item will take place 24 hours later.

3. OFFICE EQUIPMENT - a. No T/E equipment, namely, typewriters, stapling machines, field desks, and the like will be taken to SALERNO. 4501

b. No office equipment, such as desks, tables, chairs, bookcases, filing cabinets, and the like will be taken to SALERNO.

c. Before 1300, 26 January, the Administrative Directorate and AG will phone the Office Section (Extension 39), Headquarters Commandant's Office, stating the number and size of boxes desired for transport of equipment for each sub-section. Empty boxes will be delivered promptly as called for,

d. Before 1530, 26 January, all boxes will be packed.

e. Between 1530 and 1630, carpenters will come to each section to close the boxes. Boxes that are not ready by 1530, 26 January, cannot be taken. Painters will come at the same time and will paint on the boxes the identification of the section, and number the boxes.

f. After being properly marked, the boxes will then be removed to a central point, and will be placed under guard until delivered to the convoy.

g. The necessary office equipment and T/E equipment will be drawn from the Headquarters Company at SALERNO.

4. Office equipment, baggage and T/E equipment will be loaded on the convoy trucks and be ready at the IP at 0930 on 26 January for those ordered to go on that date, and on 27 January for those ordered to go on that date.

5. PERSONAL - All officers will sign out both with the AG Branch and the Billeting Office before leaving.

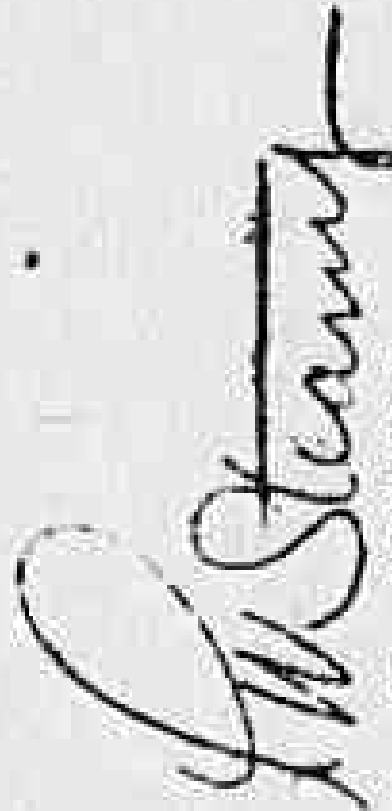

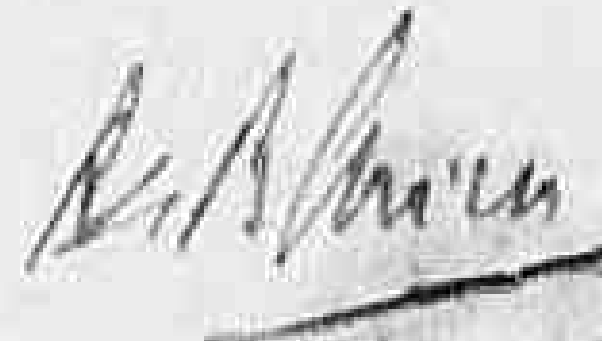

5. After 0730 hours 14 Dec. 1943, no officer not previously ordered to new station "N" on permanent change of station, will be dispatched on permanent transfer to "N" without prior called acceptance from HQ, AAG, Naples.

II. TRANSPORTATION

1. All officers EM/CH's designated to change station and named in par. 2 and 3, S.O. No. 31, or any amendment thereto will move via motor vehicle convey, which will depart from convey assembly point at Officer's Mess on Via Stabile 14 December 1943 at 0730 hours.

2. Lt. Col. R.K. BRIGGS is designated as CONVOY COMMANDER. He will immediately prepare convey march orders, (containing details from G-4 Branch) and will designate appropriate commanders, police, security and security officers. All officers other than those designated as convey officers will be considered as passengers and will not take orders or take part in the operation thereof, except under emergency conditions.

1. Officers will not receive Army data which have not been specifically issued to them, from their billets. Electronic light bulbs will not under any circumstances be removed from their billets. Officers will turn over keys to their billets to office of Headquarters Commandant.

2. After 0730 hours 14 Dec. 1943, no officer not previously ordered to new station "W" on permanent change of station, will be dispatched on permanent transfer to "W" without prior cabled notification from HQ, AMC, Naples.

II. TRANSPORTATION

1. All officers EM/CM's designated to change station and needed in per. 2 and 3, S.O. No. 31, or any movement thereto will move overland by motor vehicle convoy, which will depart from Corvey assembly point at Officer's Mess on Via Stabile 14 December 1943 at 0730 hours.

2. Lt. Col. J.R. Cullen is designated as CONVOY COMMANDER. He will immediately prepare convoy march order, (obtaining details from G-4 Branch) and will designate in definite commanders, radio, supply and security officers. All officers other than those designated on convoy officers will be considered as passengers and will not take part in the operation thereof, except under emergency conditions.

3. All personnel designated by per. 2 and 3, S.O. No. 31 will be considered alerted immediately on publication of this order and shall prepare baggage: (a) to begin about 10 Dec. 1943, (b) with point, on each piece, with time and serial number of car and "S.O. No. 31". (c) Each officer must personally advise Headquarters Commandant Office his correct billet address. There are no EM/CM's available for performance of messenger duties to reason of officers who do not have correct addresses on file. Before 0600 hours 14 December 1943 all officers on last Corvey will place their baggage, packed and marked for shipment, near main door of their billet, to be packed up, with the exception of bedding rolls, whether having or not labels. Bedding rolls will be put in marked and ready for shipment at the main door of the Officers' Mess not later than 0600, 14 December 1943. Prescribed uniform:
