I am enclosing herewith copies of the letter and documents sent to Lt. Col. Morton in response to his telegram asking for information. We have not received any progress reports at all concerning Lampedusa or Pantelleria and, as is indicated in the directive of 12 July 1945, para 6, fortnightly reports should be sent directly to Local Government Sub Commission for onward transmission to the Italian Government.

I have discussed with Brigadier Carr the general plan you had in mind for casual tours of the Provinces in Sicily. He sees no objection as long as they are not regarded as official investigations. I assured him that there was no intention on your part to do this. He also thought that it would be sufficient to do 2 Provinces every 10 days or every 2 weeks, instead of every week. I think he had in mind the scarcity of Diesel oil. However, you use your best judgment.

Mastrobuono intends to drop the bee in Aldisio's bonnet about suggesting that he ask you to make available transport for these tours with a special car, but I see no reason why you cannot do that yourself in conversation with Aldisio.

I am procuring copies of the letters from Commerce Sub-Commission that Professor Rota referred to and will hold them for him until he turns up at my office.

I want to thank you for your hospitality and the many courtesies shown me during my stay in Sicily. If I can be of any service to you do not hesitate to call upon me. Incidentally, my stomach is in good shape now.

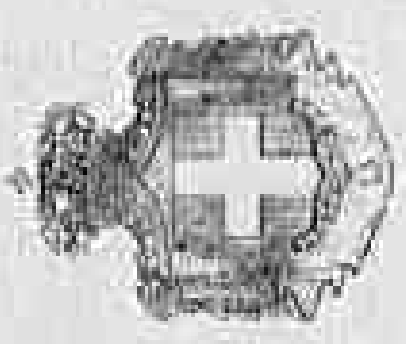

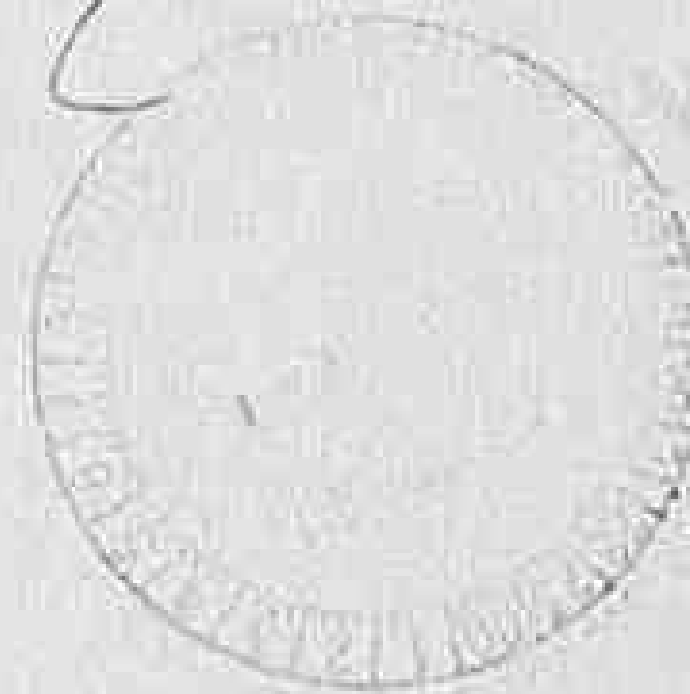

1. Reference is made to the Ministry's letter No.15643 B (Dir. Gen. Amm. no Civile) dated 7 August.

2. It is pointed out that the decision to fix 28 June as the date for commencing the preparation of the electoral lists in these two Communes was based upon information supplied by the Ministry and the Prefect himself through the ALC. Commissioner of Livorno. Both the Ministry and the Prefect stated that in these Communes the preparation of the lists had in fact been already begun on 28 June.

3. The Prefect's present statement that it is not possible to date the commencement back to 28 June therefore contradicts his previous statement.

4. In the meantime the requisite Ordinance fixing 28 June has been issued. It appears in the Official Gazette No.84 dated 14 July.

5. It has therefore been decided to treat the Prefect's present application as a request for an extension of the time limits by 30 days : the Ministry are requested to issue a decree accordingly pursuant to article 24 of the Ministerial Decree of 24 October 1944.

1. Reference is made to your letter AG/45/1/LG of 16 July informing this Ministry of the date fixed for the commencement of the operations for the compilation of the electoral lists in the Communes of central and southern Italy still under Allied jurisdiction among which Livorno and Collesalveti for which the date had been fixed as 28 June 1945.
2. In this connection the Prefect of Livorno, informing that the local Military Government in agreement with the Prefecture had established that the aforesaid operations in the Communes indicated above should commence on 25 July, by telegram dated 31 July points out that it is impossible to date back to 28 June the running of the terms in question since the aforesaid communes, which as a matter of fact were not able to commence the operations prior to 22 July, would not be in a position to comply with terms prescribed for the single operation by Ministerial Decree 24 Oct. '44.
3. In consideration of such a situation, this Ministry kindly request your Commission to please examine the opportunity of modifying the running of the terms established for the communes of Livorno and Collesalveti, by setting the date as of 25 July so as to place the communes in a position to comply with the prescribed terms for the single operations.
4. We are waiting to know the actions taken in this matter for information of this Ministry.

1. Reference your signal of 17 July and this HQ's cable reply No. 2107 today's date. No decision has been taken either by the Italian Government or AC as to when elections--local or national--will be held in any part of Italy. As to local elections, the Italian Government have not yet decided even on the form of the local authorities to be elected, or on the voting procedure to be adopted. Neither will the procedure for election of the Constituent Assembly be settled for some time to come.

2. All we are concerned with at present is the preparation of the electoral lists or registers of voters. The position as to this is fully dealt with in circular AC/45/A/1G of 12 July and the directives enclosed with it, copies of which were dispatched to you on 12 July for transmission to CAOs Lampedusa and Pantelleria. It is appreciated that these are not likely to have reached you at the date of your signal.

3. An additional copy of the above-mentioned circular and its enclosures is included herewith for your use, together with an extra copy of AC/45/A/1G of 18 July issued yesterday.

1. Reference is made to this Sub Commission's letter AC/45/A/LG dated 29 June, informing the Ministry that the Allied Commission had fixed 15 July as the date for commencing the preparation of the electoral lists in certain Northern Regions.

2. Consideration has also been given to the position of those communes in Central and Southern Italy which remain under Allied Military Government : and it has been decided to fix the following dates in respect of them : --

Naples	1 Feb. 1945	
Ancona	20 May	"
Lampedusa and Linosa	21 May	"
Pisa	28 June	"
Colle Salvetti	28 June	"
Livorno	28 June	"
Pantelleria	20 July	"

3. An ordinance to this effect will be published very shortly in the Official Gazette.

4. The fixing of the above-mentioned dates ratifies and confirms the action already taken informally by the local authorities, except in the case of Pantelleria, where the destruction of records has not allowed the work to commence as yet.

5. The Allied Commissioners or Civil Affairs Officers for the communes in question have been informed and they will no doubt in turn inform the Prefects.

TO : Distribution as below.

1. The Italian Government, by DDL 247 of 28 September 1944 and Ministerial Decree of 24 October 1944, have provided for the compilation of electoral lists in Italian Government Territory. This work is already well under way in Southern and Central Italy and should be completed in such places by the end of July.
2. Although provision was only recently made for the commencement of this work in AMG Territory by the implementation in the Gazzetta Ufficiale No. 68 of 7 June 1945 of DDL 201 of 12 April 1945 (contained in Gazzetta Ufficiale No. 59 of 17 May 1945), the Italian Government has informed the Allied Commission that the actual compilation of the election registers was unofficially commenced in the following communes still under AMG control on the dates indicated, with the exception of Pantelleria where destruction of the population registers has made it necessary for the Italian Government to suspend the time-limits for the drawing up of lists pending the reconstruction of such records:

Naples	1 Feb. 1945
Ancona	20 May 1945
Lampedusa and Linosa	21 May 1945
Pisa	28 June 1945
Colle Salvetti	28 June 1945
Livorno	28 June 1945

3. It has been decided to regularise and ratify these unofficial dates by the publication in the Gazzetta Ufficiale of an order signed on behalf of the Chief Civil Affairs Officer, in order not to undo the work already started.

4. In the case of Pantelleria, the date set for the commencement of the compilation has been fixed as of 20 July. As soon as the order is published, copies of the Gazzetta Ufficiale will be sent to you for submission to the Prefects. In the meantime, the work is to go on as heretofore. The Sindaco of Pantelleria and the Prefect of Trapani should be notified immediately of the date fixed so that work can be started.
