Reference Vol. 8B. As instructed by Miss Rasmussen I called up Dr. Strano of the Ministry of Int. to find out whether the appointments of "deputies members" in the Pro vincia Commissions of Comd. Milano, Pavia, Sondrio, & Varese were in order and provided for in the decree.

Dr. Strano replied that there is no provision in the decree for such appointments. Art. 8 provides only for the appointment of a President and two members. He doesn't know of any precedent of this kind believes that the purpose of this measure was to have a ready substitution in the interest of the expeditionness of the works of the Commissions.

Having remarked that actions taken by a deputy member not regularly appointed may be later impugned, Dr. Strano concurred and agreed that a situation like this may give rise to contestation.

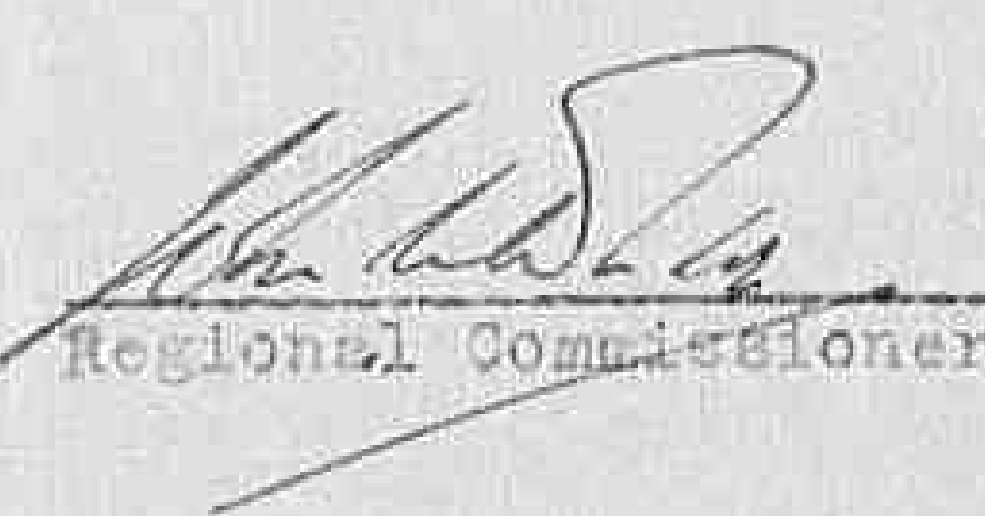

Having seen the "deliberazioni" of the Council of Ministers on proposal of the President of the Council of Ministers, First Secretary of State, in agreement with all Ministers:

We have sanctioned and we promulgate the following:

ART 1

Deputy Presidents for the provincial commissions for sanctions against politically dangerous fascists ^{constituted under} Art. 2 of D.L. 26 April 1945 No. 149 may be appointed according to formalities and qualifications established by Art. 3 of D.L. 4 January 1945 No. 2.

The Deputy-President will act in the President's absence or ^{incapacity} ~~inability~~ to attend.

Sub-Commissions having the same powers as the Commissions may be appointed in the form contemplated by ^{first para} of said Art. 2 of D.L. 26 April 1945 No. 149 in those Provinces where the number of cases to be examined requires it.

ART 2

In the territories not yet returned to the Italian Administration this Decree will come into force when it is made executive by A.C. 2488

We order that the present decree, bearing the Seal of the State be inserted in the Official Collection of Laws and Decrees of the Kingdom of Italy and we order to all concerned to comply with it and to have it complied with as a law of the State.

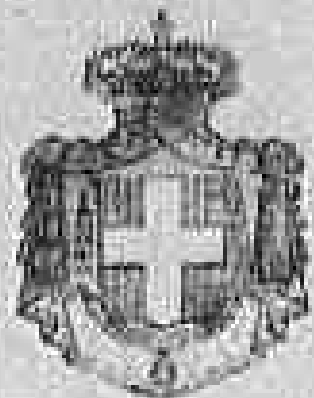

1. The Judiciary Record Office has almost finished returning the lists to the various electoral offices. Everything is going to be ready in a week at the latest.
2. Nothing is changed re. the suspension of people from the right to vote. Carlo Bear the President of the Provincial Commission entitled to better suspensions has not yet been either substituted or sent for (he is now on leave).
3. The work for the compilation of lists is almost everywhere progressing favourably. From a Comune after the prescribed publication sent them to the Commissione Provinciale (Borough Commission) for the necessary provisions.
4. They are inventorying all the ballot-boxes and the material to be found in the Communes and also drawing lists of what is missing. Data will be shortly notified. We expect that no less than 500 new ballot-boxes will be required. We are examining the tenders made by several firms and we shall choose the best. As to the rubber-stamps we understand that a specialized firm in Milan was compelled by the Prefecture to suspend any order. Thus we suppose that the Ministry is going to provide directly for the supply of everybody.

1. To date from the local Judiciary Record about 300,000 names of people having the right to vote were sent to the various communes. The accelerated rhythm given to the work allows us to declare that the list of the 100 thousand names left will reach the Communes within the month of October.

2. Since so far it was not possible to constitute a Provincial Commission for sanctions against fascism it was not even possible to deprive any people of the right to vote.

As to the a/n Commission we announce that the Cabinet Council with a note of the 12th inst. (No. 45411/10124) informed that Carlo Heer, a Judge of the Law Courts of Bergamo, has been appointed President of the mentioned Commission. The notification of this appointment, however, could not be done because Judge Heer was on leave in Piedmont where he is going to stay till the end of October. On the 24th inst this Prefecture wired to the Cabinet of the Prime Minister and to the first President of the Court of Appeal in Brescia pointing out that it is necessary either to substitute Judge Heer or direct him to return to his office immediately.

1. Reference is made to your 15639/10124+10/1.7 dated 3 October 1945
and 15692/4/6743 dated 4 October 1945.

2. A misunderstanding by the Ministry of the Interior seems to exist
as to the procedure agreed upon between the Ministry and this Sub-Commission
for the appointment of Provincial Commissions for the disfranchisement of
fascists. The following is a resume of the work which led to the final adoption
by the Ministry of the Interior and the Allied Commission of the procedure set
out in this Sub-Commission's directive AG/45/A/10 of 3 September 1945, a further
copy of which is enclosed for your information.

3. On 10 August 1945, the President of the Council of Ministers was urged
in a letter from the Civil Affairs Section (reference AG/45/A/10) to have these
Provincial Commissions established under D.L. 159 of 27 July 1944 as quickly as
possible. On 22 August a copy of a proposed telegraphic circular was received
for distribution to Prefects in the North. That Ministerial circular indicated
that Commissions had not as yet been set up in certain provinces under the con-
trol of the Italian Government. On 25 August a conference was held between
Major Temple and Dott. VIGNETTI of the Electoral Service and it was pointed out
that the afore-mentioned telegraphic circular could not be sent out inasmuch
as D.L. 149 of 26 April 1945 was not in effect in AM Territory.

4. Copies of the notes of this conference were sent to the Ministry of
the Interior with letter AG/45/A/10 dated 27 August 1945. In that letter the
Allied Commission again urged that action be taken as indicated in the notes.

5. On 29 August 1945, the Allied Commission were informed by the
Presidency of the Council of Ministers that the President agreed upon the ap-
pointment of the Commissions as contemplated in Decree 159. On the same date
a copy of the letter sent to the Presidency of the Council of Ministers, signed
by Dott. VIGNETTI, was received in which reference was made to the desire of
this Commission that the Provincial Commissions be established as soon as
possible. Dott. CATRACCI was informed of our concern at not receiving an
answer as to the Government's decision in this matter at a conference
with an officer of this Sub-Commission on 29 August 1945.

6. Eventually, on 3 September 1945, a conference was held at the Ministry in which the participants were Dott. VIGNOXINI and Dott. VIGNOLI, both of the Electoral Service; Dott. VARINO of the Cabinet of the Presidency of the Council of Ministers; and Major Temple. In order to clarify the Prime Minister's letter of 29 August 1945, a procedure was agreed upon by all present for the appointment of the President and the members of the Provincial Commissions. On 6 September 1945, this Sub-Commission sent to the Ministry, under cover of letter reference AG/45/A/14 a copy of the directive sent to Provincial Commissioners in AMG Territory with regard to this matter. That directive contained a copy of an order in English and, for the information of the Prefect, in Italian regarding the appointment of the 2 members of the Commission and pointed out what was clearly outlined at the conference on 3 September 1945, namely that Art. 8 of D.L. 159 of 27 July 1944, as modified by Art. 2 of D.L. 2 of 4 January 1945, were in effect in AMG Territory and would be followed. Provincial Commissioners were instructed to request the Presidents of the Courts of Appeals to nominate 2 popular judges in each province in order that they may be formally appointed by the Provincial Commissioner.
7. Provincial Commissioners have been advised of the name of the President of each Provincial Commission as appointed by the President of the Council of Ministers.
8. The foregoing lengthy explanation is given in order to clarify any misunderstanding by the Electoral Service of the Ministry of the Interior as to what procedure is in operation and also to indicate that the Allied Commission has for a long time been aware of the necessity for the immediate appointment of the Provincial Commissions as well as the effects of any delay in doing so.

3. For your information we are sending you herewith a copy of the form of letter which is being used for notifying Provincial Commissioners of these appointments. As is stated therein, the letter is all the authority required by the officials, both Allied and Italian, administering the Province.
4. With reference to the letters addressed by the Presidency to the Prefects and forwarded to us under cover of your letter a/m, it is desired to draw your attention to two points:
 - a) in the second paragraph of the letters in question reference is made to DLL No. 149 of 26 April 1945. This decree has not been rendered executive in AMG Territory;
 - b) in the fourth paragraph of the letters in question the Prefect is informed that AMG will communicate directly with the First President of the Court of Appeals, thereby implying that the Prefect need not do so. This is not the case. The Provincial Commissioner will inform the Prefect and it will be for the Prefect to consider who else should be informed and to take action accordingly.
5. For these reasons the letters in question have not been despatched and are returned to you herewith.
6. It will be noted that amongst the letters returned to you is one addressed to the Prefect of PIACENZA. Inasmuch as the Province of PIACENZA is under the jurisdiction of the Italian Government, this Sub-Commission has taken no steps to transmit the information and the letter is returned to you for action.

No. 159 of 27 July 1944, as modified by Art. 2 of D.L. No. 2 of 4 January 1945, which is in effect in AMG Territory. It was agreed with your Ministry that D.L. No. 149 would not be implemented in AMG Territory.
- A letter has today been addressed to the Provincial Commissioner of VICENZA pointing out the apparent difficulty of the Prefect and asking that information be submitted to this Sub-Commission as to the position of the Provincial Commission for VICENZA. 1. Attached is a copy of a letter (reference 15692/7/6741 dated 4 Oct 45) which has been received from the Ministry of the Interior.
2. With regard to the supply of fuel to the Prefect for the purpose of carrying out tours of inspection in connection with the preparation of electoral lists, it is important that every possible effort be made to supply such fuel in order that the Prefect may control and assist the compilation of the lists and ensure that there is no unnecessary delay in their completion.
3. With regard to para. 3 of the letter from the Ministry, this Sub-Commission, in its reply, has today reiterated the procedure already agreed upon with the Ministry for the establishment of these special provincial Commissions (as set out in our Directive AG/45/1/LG dated 3 Sept 45). It should be wellknown to the Ministry that D.L. No. 149 of 26 April 1945 is not in operation in AMG Territory.
4. It is to be noted that the fortnightly report on the preparation of electoral lists dated 24 Sept 45 from the Prefect of VICENZA contained the following statement:

"At least for the present moment H. 6 of Art. 2 of D.M. 24 October 44 cannot be applied to this Province, as the Provincial Committee for the sanctions against fascism cannot be appointed, as disposed by D.L. No. 149 of 26 April 1945, which by order of AMG has not entered into force in this Province yet".
5. For your information we attach hereto a further copy of this Sub-Commission's Directive abovementioned which fully sets out the procedure for the establishment of the special commissions. We are also enclosing a copy of a letter which was sent to you on 13 Oct 45. This letter advises the name of the President of the Provincial Commission for VICENZA and indicates the approval of the appointment by Allied Commission. An Italian translation of the letter is enclosed for delivery to the Prefect. It is to be noted that it is the duty of the Prefect to inform the President of the Provincial Commission of his appointment and to arrange for the Commission to commence work at once.
6. Please advise this Sub-Commission immediately as to the progress made in the establishment of the Provincial Commission for VICENZA and inform us of the names of the 2 members formally appointed by the Provincial Commissioner.

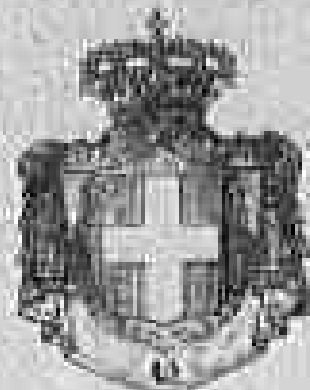

After consulting the Minister of Grace and Justice and the High Commissioner for Sanctions against Fascism, by Decree of the President of the Council of Ministers dated 1st October 1945, in compliance with art. 3 of D.L.L. 4th January 1945, n.2, Dr..... has been appointed President of the Provincial Commission for Sanctions against those who, for fascist reasons or by taking advantage of the political situation created by Fascism, have committed grave facts which, although they are not real crimes, are against all rules of political uprightness.

This matter, already dealt with by art 8 of D.L.L. 27th July 1944, n. ~~145~~¹⁴⁸, is also referred to in art. 1 and 2 of D.L.L. 26th April 1945, ~~155~~¹⁵⁸ 149

It is known that the regular and rapid accomplishment of the tasks commanded to the said Commissions is one of the indispensable preliminaries of the work for the compilation of the electoral lists, since all those who had a bad political conduct or held important offices in the now dissolved fascist party have to be excluded from the lists.

The authorities of the Allied Military Government - it is they who will make the above-mentioned decree executive in your Province - will take direct care that the provision be notified to the President of the Court of Appeals so that, in accordance with the law, the said commissions be completed with the appointment of the Justices of the Peace.

Will you please verify that, in compliance with the specific instruction on electoral service, the decisions of the Commission be immediately communicated to the Sindaci and that the latter comply with them striking out the names of disqualified citizens.

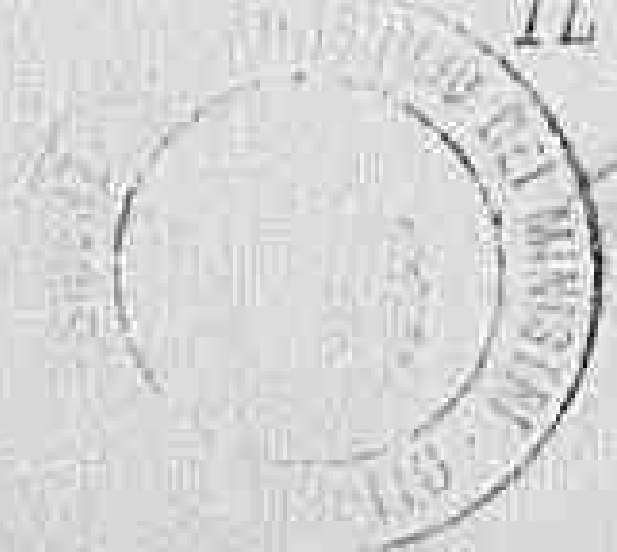

1. On Major Williams' recent visit to this province, there was some discussion at an interview with the PC and the Prefect as to the procedure for depriving certain classes of Fascists of their right to vote. As to the exact point under discussion, see the Schedule to Executive Memorandum No.5, para 4 (b). This paragraph refers to the special Provincial Commission which has to be set up for this purpose under Article 8 of DLL 159 of 27 July 1944, which Decree provides that such Commissions are all to be appointed centrally by the President of the Council of Ministers.

2. The Prefect, however, was under the impression that Article 8 of the above-quoted DLL had been replaced by another Decree under which the Commission is appointed by the First President of the Court of Appeal; and he said he was taking steps to request the First President to make the necessary appointments for Verona Province. At Major Williams' request, the Prefect caused to be produced the Gazzetta Ufficiale of 28 April 1945 No. 51, which contains DLL 26 April 1945 No. 149: this the Prefect said was the new Decree in question.

3. On Major Williams' return, the point raised by the Prefect has been further examined. The position is that DLL 26 April 1945 No.149 has NOT been put into effect in Military Government Territory. Article 8 of DLL 27 July 1944 No. 159, therefore, continues in full force and effect in Venezie Region in general and the province of Verona in particular.

4. May the Prefect of Verona please be advised of the true position and told that he should take no further steps for the appointment of this particular Commission, and should cancel any request he may have made to the First President of the Court of Appeal.

5. This Sub Commission is taking steps to urge the Presidency of the Council of Ministers to appoint the necessary Commissions as quickly as possible, as required by Article 8 of DLL 159.

SUBJECT: Preparation of electoral lists.

3 September 1945

TO : Distribution as below.

1. Para 19 of the Schedule attached to Executive Memorandum No. 5 of 1 July 1945 refers to the work of Provincial Commissions established under Article 8 of DLL 159 of 27 July 1944. The Ministerial Decree of 24 October 1944, in setting forth the rules concerning the compilation of electoral lists, provides in Article 2, para 11, for the exclusion from the electoral lists of those found guilty of Fascist activity under the Law.

2. By virtue of Article 8 of DLL 159 of 27 July 1944, as modified by Article 2 of DLL 2 of 4 January 1945, both of which have been duly implemented and are in effect in AMG Territory, the presiding officer of the Commission is a magistrate appointed by the President of the Council of Ministers after consultation with the Minister of Pardon and Justice and the High Commissioner for Sanctions Against Fascism. The Italian Government is at present selecting the Presidents of the said Commissions for each province, whose names will be published in the Gazzetta Ufficiale and duly implemented so that they are to be effective in AMG Territory. You will be notified of these names as soon as they are appointed.

3. Inasmuch as said DLL 159 and DLL 2 do not specifically indicate who should actually appoint the other 2 members of the Provincial Commissions, but merely indicate that they shall be selected by lot from popular judges referred to in Article 4 of said Decree, it has been agreed with the Italian Government that the following procedure for the appointment of the remaining 3 judges shall prevail:

(a) The Provincial Commissioner should request the First President of the Court of Appeals to nominate the members:

(b) the Provincial Commissioner should then by formal order appoint those persons as members of the said Commission from the date of the order.

4. This order referred to in the foregoing paragraph need not be printed. It can be mimeographed and handed to the necessary officials and authorities. A copy of this order in both English and Italian is appended hereto for use of Provincial Commissioners.

5. Pending receipt of the names of the President of each Provincial Commission, please instruct the Presidents of the Courts of Appeals of each province to nominate 2 popular judges, who should then be formally appointed by Provincial Commissioners. Names of those appointed for each province should be sent to this HQ for transmission to the Italian Government.
